WellStar School of Nursing Clinical Requirements

Submit to Immunitrax

 Current physical within the month before entry. Must use School of Nursing Physical Exam Requirements Form and must be signed by a Physician or Nurse Practioner. (updated every 13 months)

<u>PPD/immunization:</u> Negative PPD must be within a month of entry and must be updated annually. If there is a history of a positive PPD, you must have either a negative chest x-ray or negative Quantiferon report updated annually.

<u>Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis booster immunization</u>: Tdap is required. A two year time period is recommended between tetanus/diphtheria (Td) and tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis (Tdap).

<u>Varicella (Chicken Pox)</u>: Proof of 2 vaccinations or laboratory evidence of immunity, (reactive) Titer. If you are in the process of getting the immunization please show documentation.

<u>Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)</u>: Proof of 2 vaccinations or laboratory evidence of immunity, (reactive) Titer. If you are in the process of getting the immunization please show documentation.

Hepatitis B Series (HBV): Laboratory evidence of immunity, (reactive anti Hep B) Titer. Documentation of appropriate immunization, i.e., 3 injections at prescribed intervals to include reactive Hep B titer, documentation that the series is in progress will be accepted when you first enter the program. If you are not immune a second series will be required.

Flu Vaccination: Proof of a current flu vaccination due October 1 for fall and upon entry for spring.

- 2.) A signed copy (front and back) of current CPR card American Heart Association BLS for <u>Healthcare</u> Providers Course only – NO EXCEPTIONS
- 3.) Copy (front and back) of current health insurance card

- 4.) Complete Criminal Background Check & Drug Test using Advantage Students. Submit a copy of your Custody Control Form when completed.
- 5.) Licensure if you are currently licensed by any board in the State of Georgia, the WellStar School of Nursing must have a copy of your license.

Health Records are due upon entry, and must be current and up to date from the beginning to the end of each semester. These records are required by our clinical agencies prior to Kennesaw State University nursing students attending clinical. <u>You will NOT be allowed into the clinical site without this documentation</u>. Use the WellStar School of Nursing Health Form to record the above information. Fill in all blanks on the form, and do not write, "See attached". *Be aware that clinical agencies may request a copy of any or all student health records in certain situations. From time to time a Kennesaw State University Health Care Provider will review all information provided to the WellStar School of Nursing. Students are required to keep copies of all medical forms and submit copies when requested with their clinical paperwork.
