NEW WLU FOUNDATION RECOGNITION AWARDS FOR PHILANTHROPY

The WLU Foundation presented its first-ever Lifetime Impact of Philanthropy Award along with six Impact of Philanthropy Awards during Homecoming 2021.

“The distinguished Lifetime Impact of Philanthropy Award honors **Gary and Flip West** and their total commitment to our university,” said Angie Zambito-Hill, executive director of the WLU Foundation.

“It’s not often that you find donors who make such a tremendous impact on a university.”

“Additionally, we are honoring six Impact of Philanthropy Award donors who have generously given \$25,000 or more during fiscal year 2021, allowing us to advance priority projects for WLU.”

The new awards were distributed during the Recognition Banquet that took place on Oct. 15 in the renovated Wall of Honor alcove in the Paul N. Elbin Library.

The Wests are residents of Wheeling and Naples, Fla. and both are alumni and avid fans of Hilltopper Athletics.

“It’s not often that you find donors who make such a tremendous impact on a university. The Wests directly help students through scholarships, they have enhanced facilities through updates, and funded major construction projects. They are our constant friends and advocates,” said Zambito-Hill.

WLU’s Gary E. West College of Business bears Mr. West’s name in recognition of his major gift to the West College of Business Scholarship Program and he remains involved in other ways, including speaking and sharing his business expertise with students.

Other major gifts the couple are responsible for include the West Family Stadium and the West Family Athletic Complex.

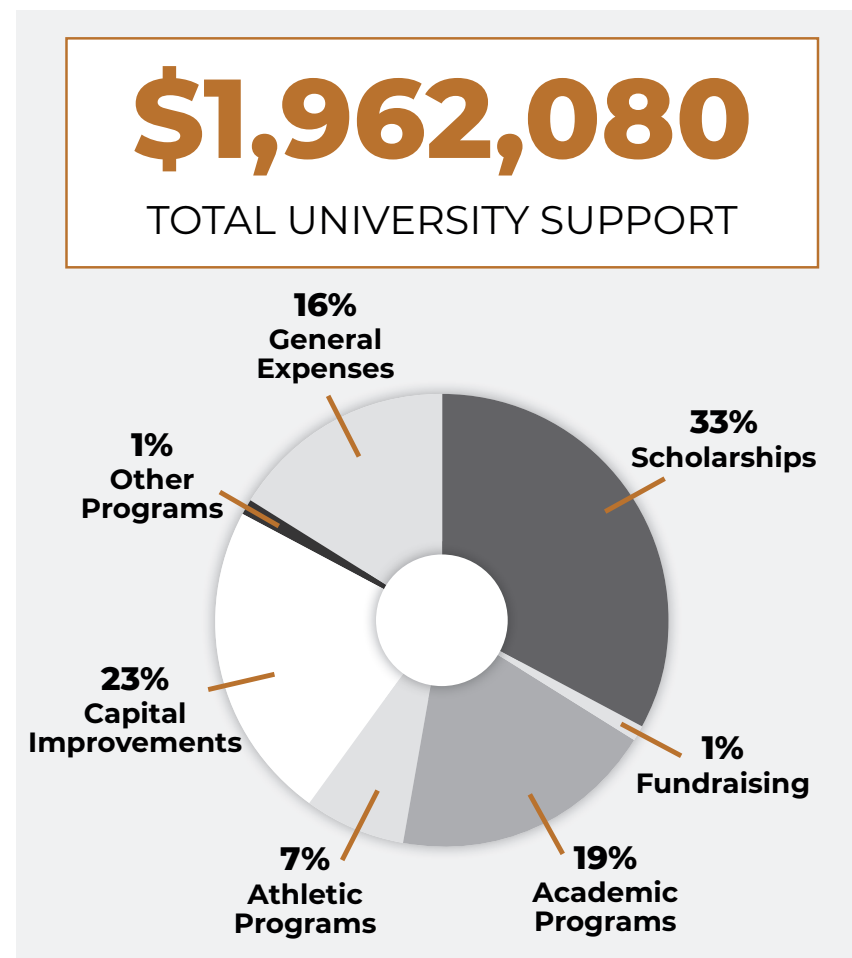

NEW MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP MAKES STUDENT SING FOR JOY

A new music scholarship is making one West Liberty University student sing for joy.

Josephine “Josie” Jarrett of Benwood, W.Va. is the first recipient of the Judith Bartell Paesani Vocal Music Scholarship.

A music education major, Jarrett is the daughter of Melinda Gilmore of Benwood and Phillip Jarrett of Moundsville. A graduate of John Marshall High School, she plans to teach music and theater in the future.

“It is an honor to receive this scholarship and I’m very thankful to be the first. I will make sure it is justified,” said Jarrett, who is a member of the West Liberty University Singers. Jarrett also is an alumna of WLU, having earned a degree in theater in 2020.

According to WLU Foundation Executive Director Angie Zambito-Hill, “Judy and Andy Paesani established this endowed scholarship fund in December of 2019 with a gift of \$75,000 and we are pleased to make the first disbursement during the 2021- 2022 academic year. Judy and Andy are loyal supporters of West Liberty University who know the value of assisting our students. We are truly grateful.”

“The endowed scholarship fund produced a \$1,000 scholarship this academic year but it will grow to support even more music students in the future,” she added.

Judith Bartell Paesani recalls that she was heavily influenced by her mother’s love of music and singing and this scholarship seemed the perfect way to honor her mother, Aldene Miller Bartell, the wife of one of West Liberty’s iconic leaders.

“I recall singing and enjoying music with my mother at home when I was young. It was always a fun way to pass an evening, especially while my father was away,” recalls Judy. Her father was WLU’s legendary football coach Joseph Bartell and he took the car to away games since at that time, there was no school transportation provided to athletes and coaches.

Judy and Andy are both WLU alumni and are pleased to see the scholarship help music students at the university they love, while at the same time honoring her mother.

Her mother, Aldene Miller Bartell, studied piano as a youngster and loved to sing. While a teenager she even played the piano for silent movies. Judy recalls that her mother formed a vocal trio when she first arrived on campus from Fairview, W.Va., her hometown.

Dr. Joseph A. Bartell served at West Liberty in many capacities from 1933 to 1971, including football coach, athletic director, dean of men and dean of students. He was inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame as a charter member in 1981.

Judy earned her bachelor’s degree from WLU’s College of Education and went on to earn a master’s from the University of Connecticut. Andy earned his bachelor’s degree, also from the College of Education, and went on to earn both a master’s and doctoral degree from the University of Iowa.

Judy’s mom was an elementary school teacher and eventually went back to college to finish her degree at WLU, in part at Judy’s urging.

“I’m sure that she would be very happy to know that this scholarship is being used to keep the music playing,” said Zambito-Hill.

CELEBRATED: COACH BOB ROE MEMORIAL GAME

West Liberty University celebrated one of its all-time greats on Sept. 18 when the Hilltoppers' home football game against No. 8-ranked Notre Dame (Ohio) was designated as the "Coach Bob Roe Memorial Game."

Many of the late coach's former players were on hand at West Family Stadium to honor the memory of the man who transformed West Liberty into a nationally-ranked grid power during the early 1970s.

Already a legendary Ohio Valley high school coach before moving up to the collegiate ranks, Roe led the Hilltopper football program to back-to-back NAIA national semifinal berths in 1970 and 1971, highlighting his stellar 9-year run at the West Liberty helm from 1965-73.

Roe's Hilltoppers exploded onto the national scene in 1970, going unbeaten in West Virginia Conference play to earn the school's first NAIA playoff bid. They came within a touchdown of playing for a national title, battling Wofford (S.C.) to the wire in a 12-6 setback.

Coach Roe had West Liberty right back in the national spotlight in 1971 with another unbeaten regular season. Not even a loss to eventual national champion West Alabama in an NAIA semifinal game hosted by the Hilltoppers at Steubenville's Harding Stadium could dim the luster of that two-year run.

Roe hung up the college clipboard following the 1973 season, leaving the hilltop with a sparkling 50-24-6 record – one of the highest winning percentages in nearly a century of Hilltopper football.

A charter member of the West Liberty Hall of Fame in 1981, Roe is also enshrined in the West Virginia Sports Hall of Fame, the OVAC Hall of Fame, the City of Wheeling Hall of Fame, the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Hall of Fame and the Bethany College Hall of Fame.

"During his nine seasons at West Liberty, Coach Roe influenced, inspired and guided more than 300 players, assistant coaches, trainers and student managers," said former Hilltopper griddier Rod Reese, one of the driving forces behind the Coach Bob Roe Memorial Game. "In respect and gratitude for the incredible impact he had on our lives, we are proud to honor his memory."

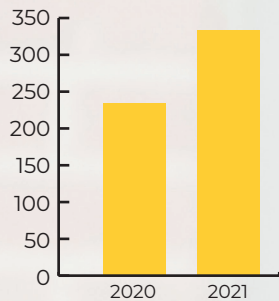
The WLU Foundation worked closely with the Coach Bob Roe Football Committee in support of the "Coach Bob Roe Memorial Game." After a get-together in the lower parking lot adjacent to West Family Stadium, a moment of silence was observed prior to the game in memory of Coach Roe and his former players who have passed. The Bob Roe Football Alumni group received an ovation from the crowd when they were asked to stand and be recognized at the end of the first quarter. The day concluded with a post-game celebration from 6:30 to 10 p.m. at the West Sports Bar.

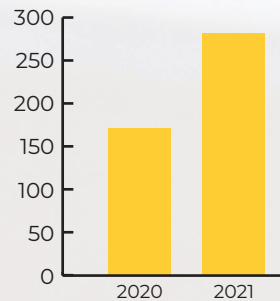

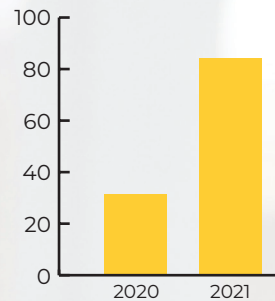

MCMILLEN FUND BECOMES ENDOWED CHAIR

Several years ago, the family of the late Professor Kenneth B. "Mac" McMillen established a scholarship to honor Ken and his contribution to the college over a long career. Those who were privileged to sit in one of his classes will remember Mac as a generous man, who would go out of his way to answer questions, use personal anecdotes to illustrate lessons, and to allow wide ranging discussions. I remember being in class during the week the Berlin Wall began to go up. This was particularly poignant because Mrs. McMillen was what we referred to as a "war bride," a native of Germany who married an American GI. I remember meeting Mrs. McMillen when she agreed to give German lessons to a few of us in their home. She was a very gracious host and teacher.

The original Scholarship was changed with the consent of the family to create a fund which would provide a stipend to a faculty member to be selected by a committee as being outstanding in the field of political science on an annual basis. As interest in the project grew, a suggestion was made that a better method of honoring Mac would be to create the first endowed faculty position in the history of West Liberty University.

Of course, this is a very ambitious project which will require a large sum if it is to be sustainable. We are hoping to create a fund in excess of a million dollars for the purpose annually earning a sum of money sufficient to provide a portion or all of the salary of a professorship named in a field called American Studies. The fund is on the way to success after several generous gifts.

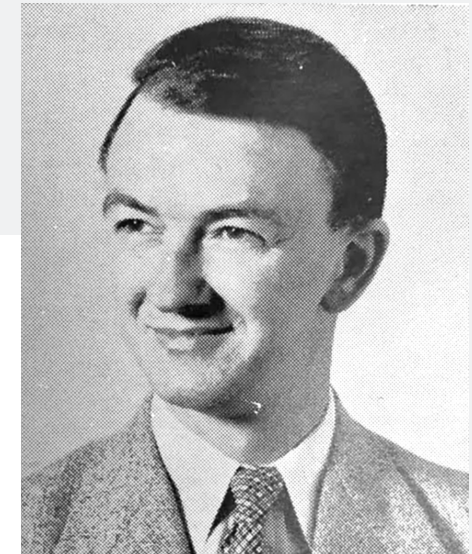

One might ask why I have taken on the project of helping to promote this fund honoring a past professor. It is because he was a humble, non-assuming teacher who would go out of his way to help someone who asked for help. One example is his effort to help me be admitted to the College of Law at the Ohio State University. With my track record of less than outstanding grades, I am certain that his letter of recommendation gained my acceptance in 1965.

A better example is in a letter read by Dr. Jeremy Lawrence at the 2021 induction ceremony for the Wall of Honor posthumous recipient Dr. Todd Bullard. The Bullard family sent a letter containing the following:

"He (Bullard) wrote in a private family history in 2001 that two professors at West Liberty had great influence on him. Dr. Bertha Leaman, who had graduated from the University of Chicago, taught history and demanded high quality work, and Kenneth McMillen, who taught political

science. Bullard wrote that McMillen "loved to argue with students, and tolerated a student (me) who knew less than he thought he knew." McMillen took Bullard to Morgantown to meet Dr. Carl Frasure, then chairman of political science at WVU, in 1953. Two years later, after Army service in Germany, Bullard entered a graduate program at WVU, putting him on a path of lifelong scholarship."

UNRESTRICTED GIFTS

Donations made to the West Liberty University Foundation, Inc. support the WLU Foundation Scholarship Program and areas of greatest need, which are identified by the WLU Foundation Need Request Proposal Process.

TYPES OF FUNDS

NAMED ENDOWED FUND

A named endowed fund can be established to provide scholarships, support a professorship or chair in a particular academic area, or support another purpose based on the interest of the donor. An endowment requires that the principal remain intact in perpetuity, or for a defined period of time, or until sufficient assets have been accumulated to achieve a designated purpose. West Liberty University Foundation, Inc. requires a minimum initial gift of \$25,000 to establish an endowed fund. Named endowed funds are listed on an annual basis in certain WLU Foundation publications.

TEMPORARILY ENDOWED FUND

A temporarily endowed fund with a balance of less than \$25,000 may be established with the understanding that the donor(s) or governing body intends to fund at minimum \$25,000 level and that no income generated by the gift principal will be distributed until the \$25,000 minimum principal balance has been achieved. If not fully funded within five years, the temporarily endowed fund will be considered part of the Foundation's general endowment.

NON-ENDOWED FUND

A non-endowed fund is a fund held by the foundation designated for a specific use over a shortened period of time, e.g.; Organization accounts; Study Abroad; Capital Projects, etc.
