Aerangis macrocentra



Native of: Madagascar

Habitat: Epiphyte in forests in Central Madagascar at around 1400m.

Description: a small plant with 10cm leaves and 2cm white flowers with up to 25 flowers on a stem.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it hot (min18°C) in low light but its habitat suggests it will grow cooler and brighter.

Flowering season: Autumn

Flask to flowering approx: 1-2 years.
