

# Aerangis macrocentra



**Native of:** Madagascar

**Habitat:** Epiphyte in forests in Central Madagascar at around 1400m.

**Description:** a small plant with 10cm leaves and 2cm white flowers with up to 25 flowers on a stem.

**Cultivation Guidance:** At school we grow this plant mounted and grow it hot (min18°C) in low light but its habitat suggests it will grow cooler and brighter.

**Flowering season:** Autumn

**Flask to flowering approx:** 1-2 years.
