

Coelogyne fragrans



Native of: Papua New Guinea

Habitat: An epiphyte in forest at around 200-2000m.

Description: A medium sized plant with long lasting fragrant 5cm flowers with up to four on short spikes from new growths.

Cultivation Guidance: At school we grow this warm (min.15°C) wet in the summer dryish in winter.

Flowering season: May

Flask to flowering approx: 4yrs.
