


2024 Formulary Changes

Formulary Management

The formulary drug list contains the generic or brand medications that are covered by your plan.

Members may log onto Caremark.com to view the most updated formulary

Quarterly, CVS conducts a review of the standard formulary. During this process, drugs may be added or removed from the coverage list.



Members

- Impacted members and physicians will receive notification.
 - 30-45 days in advance of the change
- Specialty patients impacted by a formulary change will receive live phone calls
 - 15-30 days in advance of the change





Tier Changes




What is a tier change?

- o A tier change is when a product changes preferred/non-preferred status.
- Members can experience both positive or negative tier changes.
- Negatively impact members will be notified of a tier change.

What is the difference between preferred and non-preferred?

- Preferred brand-name medications are prescription drugs included on your plan's formulary drug list that have lower coinsurance/copays than non-preferred brand-name medications.
 - Generally, the lowest cost alternative options to consider are generics.
- Non-preferred brand-name medications are prescription drugs that are not included on your plan's
 formulary drug list and generally have higher coinsurance/copays than preferred brand-name medications.
 - Alternative options to consider are preferred brand-name or generic medications.





Generics save you up to 80%

We offer many generic options to help keep your medication as affordable as possible.

Generic medications work just like brand-name equals

A generic has the same active ingredients, strength and dosage as its brand name equal. It provides the same quality and performance. Generics don't have high development costs.² That's why they cost you less.

Generics are safe

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) requires generics to be as safe and effective as brand name equals. Both types of medication must meet the same FDA standards.²

Here's how to save with generics

Current prescriptions: Ask your provider or pharmacist if you can replace your brand name medication with a generic.

New prescriptions: Ask your provider if there's a generic option.



Specialty Pharmacy

Specialty Medications are typically defined by one or more of the following:

- Certain pharmaceuticals, biotech or biological drugs that are dispensed from a specialty pharmacy
- Used in management of chronic, complex, rare or genetic diseases
- o Include: injectable, infused, inhaled or oral medications
- Require unique handling, distribution and or administration
- Require clinical management to optimize safety and adherence

- CVS Specialty can deliver medications to location of the members choice:

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Terms you should know

Deductible An individual or family needs to spend this amount on medications each plan year before coverage starts; may be combined with medical benefits

Copay or coinsurance I The amount you pay for medications once you or your family reaches the deductible and coverage starts; a copay is a flat amount and coinsurance is a percentage of the cost of the medication

Maximum out-of-pocket (MOOP) Once you or your family reach this amount, all medications are covered at 100%

Generic medication I Has the same active ingredients as the brand-name medication; usually your lowest cost option

Preferred brand medication | Medication that will cost less under your benefit plan

Non-preferred brand medication | Highest cost option under your benefit plan

Maintenance or long-term medication | Medication you take regularly, like high blood pressure, diabetes, or high cholesterol medications

Acute or short-term medication | Medication you take for a short time, like an antibiotic

Preventive medication Affordable Care Act (ACA) preferred medications are covered at 100%; High deductible health plan (HDHP) preventive medications bypass the deductible, which means they are covered even if you haven't met your yearly deductible yet



Terms and ways to manage your medication

Some medications require you to take additional steps, or receive additional approvals, before they are covered under your plan. These could include:

Quantity limit A limit on the amount of medications your plan will cover. You can continue to fill prescriptions after you've reached the limit, but you'll be responsible for any additional costs.

Step therapy I For many conditions, more than one therapeutically equivalent medication option is available and your plan may choose one medication as the preferred option. Step therapy means you need to try the preferred option first. If it works for you, you can continue to take it and may save money. If not, non-preferred medications will be covered.

Prior authorization I This means we need more information on why your doctor has prescribed a specific medication for you. CVS Caremark reviews this information and determines whether or not your medication will be covered by your plan.

Dispense as written If your doctor indicates "dispense as written" on your prescription, your pharmacy can't substitute a generic for a brand name medication and you may have to pay more for the brand.

Appeals If we deny your or your doctor's request for coverage of a non-covered medication, you have the right to appeal that decision.

- Find more information on these topics in your Summary Plan Description (SPD).
- Use the Check Drug Costs & Coverage tool at Caremark.com to find out what medications are covered, if there are extra requirements for coverage, and how much they will cost.
- Remember: Medications are only covered when you fill your prescriptions at a network pharmacy. Find pharmacies near you with the *Pharmacy Locator* at Caremark.com.
