PM&R physicians, also known as physiatrists, treat a wide variety of medical conditions affecting the brain, spinal cord, nerves, bones, joints, ligaments, muscles and tendons. PM&R physicians evaluate and treat injuries, illnesses and disability, and are experts in designing comprehensive, patient-centered treatment plans. AAPM&R ANNUAL ASSEMBLY

Each year, AAPM&R brings the physiatric community together at the Annual Assembly to advance the specialty. As the premier physiatry-focused event, our members (and other attendees) connect, learn and expand their professional expertise. In 2022, we hosted a hybrid meeting—in-person in Baltimore, Maryland as well as virtually for those who couldn't travel. Whatever way attendees chose to participate, #AAPMR22 was *Leading the Way* and was a "must-attend" event for every physiatrist.








SUBSPECIALTY

The chart represents the various subspecialty certifications held by Annual Assembly attendees.




AGE

At the right is a breakdown of registrants that have age-related information available.




