
I am submitting this information in accordance with section 8-9-403 of act 749. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the location and size of two (2) waste tire sites.

One is located at the Davis Rubber Company, 1600 East 15th street in Little Rock, Arkansas. There are 8 separate tire piles at this location. The size of the entire lot here is approximately three (3) acres. The amount of tires on this site as of January 10, 1992, was 7000 passenger tire and 1500 truck tires.

The second tire pile is located on the Davis Ranch in Northern Pulaski County. A good way to direct you to this site is to look on a county map. The tire pile is located approximately 1/2 mile due south from the point where the Faulkner County and Pulaski County lines meet on U S Highway 107. This pile consist of approximately 3000 whole tires and approximately five (5) million lbs., of waste tire byproducts. The size of the pile is approximately 150 yards by 100 yards. Clean up plans for both tire piles are enclosed on separate sheets.

This is a site that was started in 1977 and no waste tires or waste tire byproducts has been added to this site since 1985.


By July 1, 1992, we will have this waste tire site (pile) broken up into separate tire storage piles meeting requirements per the waste tire regulations number 14.

We intend to clean up this entire site by January 1, 1996. The start of this cleanup will begin by January 1, 1993.

The whole tires will be sorted out from the tire derived byproducts and will be processed to allow their recycling or proper disposal.

The tire derived byproducts will be processed further and sold for one of several tire derived products if possible. If it is not possible for us to sell this material we will dispose of it properly in a landfill approved by the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology.


This is a site that was started in 1947 and no waste tires or waste tire byproducts have been added to this site since 1955.

WHOLE TIRES

All bias ply tires will be used in the manufacturing process of our tire repair materials. We have a rotation of all bias ply tires on a four (4) month basis.

A portion of the steel belted tires on this site will be used in the manufacturing process of our tire repair materials.

All tires not used in our recycling process will be cut to a size that conforms to the waste tire regulations and then disposed of in a landfill that is approved by the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology.

All tires on site are processed and recycled or disposed of on a four (4) month rotation basis.
