By building a flagship building to embody the new face of our Hospital and by opening our doors to the academic community, we are pursuing medical excellence with more determination than ever and adopting a brand new approach to our patient relationships. Because tomorrow, *Le Nouvel Américain* – the New American Hospital of Paris – will be much more than a hospital. For each of you, it will be your true partner in health. Many benefactors have already generously committed to supporting our capital campaign, *Le Nouvel Américain 2018-2023*, and we are deeply grateful to them. We hope that you, too, will be inspired to add your name to the history and future of your Hospital, so that **together we can build the New American Hospital of Paris.**

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Building *Le Nouvel Américain* – the New American Hospital of Paris – Together

To address tomorrow's health-related challenges, the American Hospital of Paris is reinventing itself through an unprecedented architectural transformation plan. With an overall budget of 150 million euros, the aim is to increase the Hospital's current surface area by more than one-third. The project revolves around the construction of two new buildings and the complete revamping of existing infrastructure.

Our ambition? To fulfill our promise of becoming a true partner in health for all patients by providing support over the course of their lives, at every step of the way. This "new American Hospital" has been planned down to the smallest detail in order to seamlessly adapt to the Hospital's comprehensive offering, beyond the sole framework of treatment. That offering now integrates predictive, preventive, rehabilitation and follow-up medicine.

NEW FLAGSHIP BUILDING, THE NERVE CENTER OF THE NEW AMERICAN HOSPITAL

The four-story, 100,000-square-foot (10,000-sq.-meter) building designed by Jean-Michel Wilmotte, whose construction is slated to begin in October 2023, will welcome its first patients in January 2026. Symbolizing our Hospital's renewal and ability to adapt, it will house new predictive, preventive and rehabilitation medicine units as well as operating rooms, lounge areas and patient services.

ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN CONSISTENT WITH A MODERN CITY

The new building was designed to blend into its highly residential urban landscape while fully asserting the American Hospital's local presence and history. Its generous volumes, combined with interplays of light and transparency and upscale interior and exterior features, set it apart. The building's L-shape, scale and materials harmoniously mirror the historic building, creating continuity between past and present. Through elegantly redesigned, airier and more functional spaces, its world-class hospitality amenities reflect the medical excellence and unparalleled patient experience guaranteed by *Le Nouvel Américain*.

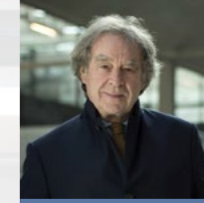
MEDICAL CARE IN A SOOTHING ENVIRONMENT

The flagship building – the heart and soul of the American Hospital of Paris – will be dedicated to outpatient care. Access to the building will be facilitated by valet parking and a three-level underground parking garage with 264 spaces. On the ground level, a vast lobby will ensure optimal conditions for patient and visitor reception while procuring an immediate

feeling of peacefulness. In this welcoming atmosphere, patients will find the admissions department, the billing department, the Patient Managers' office and, of course, our Concierge service. At the heart of the project, the large tree-studded Grand Atrium captures natural light thanks to a series of cascading terraces that accompany patients and guests throughout their visit. This atrium, along with the tea room, the restaurant by chef Yannick Alléno, the shops and the lounge areas all help to create a feeling of leisurely well-being for patients, who are often prone to anxiety.

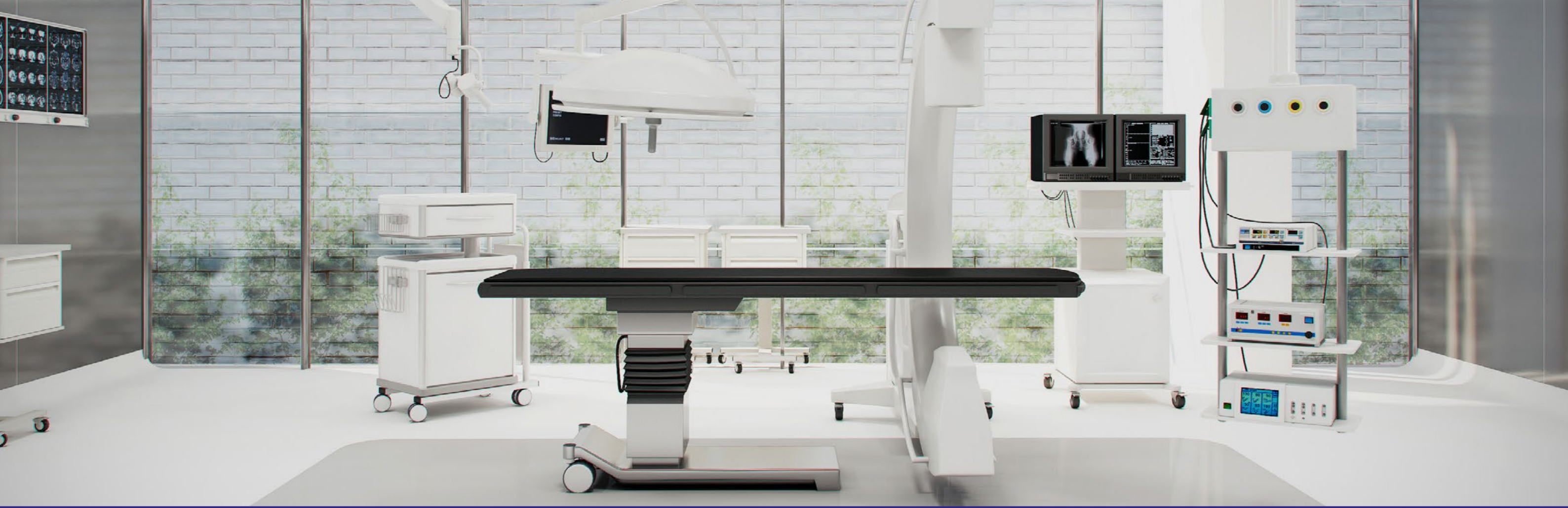


The future main lobby

A future operating room

Laying the Groundwork for Tomorrow's Medicine and Surgery

With *Le Nouvel Américain*, the Hospital will become a “partner in health,” offering the best care available combined with effective treatment, patient well-being and the long-term preservation of good health. The flagship building will showcase this new approach with specialized centers dedicated to the most innovative practices and equipped with the latest technology.

LATEST-GENERATION OPERATING ROOMS

Recent advances in surgical and anesthetic techniques, such as minimally invasive and interventional radiology procedures, reduce potential complications and operating times but require appropriate infrastructure. The future American Hospital of Paris will feature 11 operating rooms outfitted with cutting-edge equipment, including three hybrid rooms and two endoscopy rooms, to accommodate

both image-guided and robot-assisted operations. All operating rooms will be grouped together at a single location on the second floor, allowing teams to take advantage of the natural light filtering through the glass blocks. Next to the operating rooms, a postoperative monitoring room and the outpatient surgery unit will be installed to facilitate the continuous forward movement of patients.

PROMOTE SCREENING FOR EARLY DIAGNOSIS: CHECK-UP CENTER

The success of our Check-Up Center, created in 1991, reflects our patients' desire to take care of their health throughout their whole life. Occupying the entire first floor, the future center will offer differentiated and personalized checkups tailored to each individual's personal and family history, and will employ the most advanced screening and diagnostic technologies.

The comprehensive checkup program will include screening for risk factors, early diagnosis of medical conditions, preventive care, and remote patient monitoring to correct any potential anomalies detected. With three times more space, the Check-Up Center will be able to welcome twice as many patients and perform 13,000 health checkups per year.

HELP SENIORS STAY HEALTHY AND INDEPENDENT: ROBUST LIFE CENTER

The provision of long-term care for people with a physical impairment or a neurocognitive disorder is a major public health issue that will concern more than four million seniors by 2050. Our center, the only one of its kind in the Paris region, will help to identify physical and mental vulnerabilities in patients aged 60 or older, take appropriate remediation steps, and prevent or delay the need for long-term care. Our model is based on the World Health Organization's ICOPE

program and assesses six key areas: mobility, cognition, hearing, vision, psychological well-being and vitality.

ENHANCE WELL-BEING: WELLNESS CENTER

Inaugurated in 2018, the Wellness Center offers supportive care to women undergoing breast cancer treatment. Options include individual sessions with a dietician, acupuncturist, osteopath, sexologist, and/or psycho-oncologist, as well as group workshops offering sophrology, meditation, pink pilates, and yoga. Thanks to new premises in the flagship building, this program will be expanded to include many additional patients receiving treatment for other types of cancer or chronic conditions.

DEVELOP POST-THERAPEUTIC SUPPORT: REHABILITATION CENTER

Engaging in appropriate physical activity plays a key role in a patient's effective recovery, especially in cases

of cardiovascular, osteoarticular and neurological conditions. Exercise can also help prevent the recurrence of certain cancers. To increase the chance of recovery, each patient will have access to a state-of-the-art rehabilitation program equipped with the most advanced equipment available.

BECOME A CENTER OF EXCELLENCE FOR ELITE ATHLETES

The American Hospital of Paris has provided care to professional athletes, soccer players in particular, for many years, and we maintain close relationships with sports clubs and federations. The future building will house a center dedicated to elite athletes.



Modernize Existing Infrastructure

While our new flagship building will embody the new face of the American Hospital of Paris, the Memorial Building will undergo a complete renovation and modernization in sync with the Hospital's new ambitions so it, too, can confidently embrace the 21st century. *Le Nouvel Américain* therefore also includes a major renovation project to ensure unparalleled levels of comfort and privacy for all patients.

- **48 PATIENT ROOMS** have been renovated since 2020, with Jean-Michel Wilmotte in charge of their interior design. Hospitalized patients now enjoy the benefits of unrivaled hospitality standards with regard to style, comfort, functionality and technological equipment.
- **THE NEW EMERGENCY CARE CENTER (ECC)** welcomed its first patients in October 2022. Now housed in a larger space, the center was completely renovated with a focus on ensuring personalized service and privacy for patients and their families, reducing wait times, improving flow and creating separate circulation paths for gurney-bound and mobile patients. Open 24/7, the center ensures continuity of care, regardless of the illness and level of urgency.
- **THE OUTPATIENT DEPARTMENT** will soon undergo an extensive redesign to ensure high-quality and fully confidential consultations with doctors and a comfortable environment for patients while they wait. Covering all medical specialties, the center is a chief showcase for our Hospital, with 200,000 consultations conducted each year.



New State-of-the-Art Medical Imaging Center

Designed to blend harmoniously with the existing architectural features and landscaped surroundings, the imaging center is bathed in natural light thanks to a central atrium that opens onto the garden. Stone, glass and aluminum resonate with the signature materials of the Eisenhower Pavilion.

Inaugurated in 2021 and featuring latest-generation machines, our new Medical Imaging Center is one of the most well-equipped in the greater Paris area.

Located under the Hospital's gardens, the center spans a surface area of more than 19,000 sq. feet (1,800 sq. meters) and houses:

- **SCANNER DEPARTMENT:** two scanner rooms, six patient preparation rooms, one meeting room
- **MRI DEPARTMENT:** two MRI rooms
- **NUCLEAR MEDICINE DEPARTMENT:** one area for consultations, four gamma cameras, one area with two PET scan rooms and 12 patient preparation rooms

Designed to significantly increase the Hospital's diagnostic capacity, the center will also facilitate the development of innovative treatments and enable us to further reinforce our expertise in neurological, cardiac, orthopedic and cancer imaging.

Promote Medical Excellence

In addition to an ambitious architectural project, *Le Nouvel Américain* includes an investment strategy aimed at promoting our institution's medical excellence. To become one of Europe's best international hospitals, the American Hospital of Paris must meet three major challenges: increase the visibility of its very high level of expertise, engage in a process of continuous innovation every day, and earn recognition as a private teaching hospital at the forefront of training and research.

Build Recognized Centers of Excellence

The American Hospital of Paris has undeniable assets that have already established it as an institution of excellence. Eminent doctors accredited by a system used nowhere else in Europe, experienced and attentive nursing staff, comprehensive state-of-the-art diagnostic and testing services, the Check-Up Center, and the Emergency Care Center all demonstrate a capacity for mobilization and responsiveness that is unparalleled in France. By drawing on our existing strengths, we intend to turn our medical and surgical units into centers of expertise and excellence, renowned both in France and abroad.

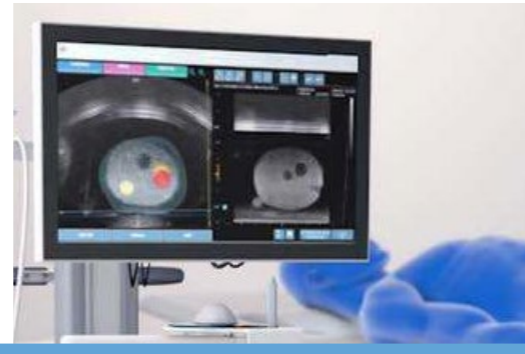
WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S HEALTH

The American Hospital of Paris's Department of Women's and Children's Health has built its reputation on a full range of services that include a maternity center, a center for assisted reproduction technology (treatment of infertility in women and men), a fetal-medicine unit and a neonatal-pediatric care unit. An obstetrician is on call 24/7 and our labor and delivery rooms are connected to an operating room dedicated to emergency cesarean deliveries. Our maternity pathway, unlike any other in France, offers a compassionate, comprehensive approach that ensures emotional security and is tailored to the specific needs of the parents and the infant.



PROSTATE CANCER

To achieve the highest possible recovery rate, we offer image-guided screening for prostate cancer, a system of active surveillance and minimally invasive procedures that totally or significantly reduce side effects such as incontinence and impotence. If necessary, leading experts are available to help patients cope with any complications arising from cancer treatments. Our Hospital also features a latest-generation surgical robot and the Stone Center, dedicated to the diagnosis and treatment of kidney stones.

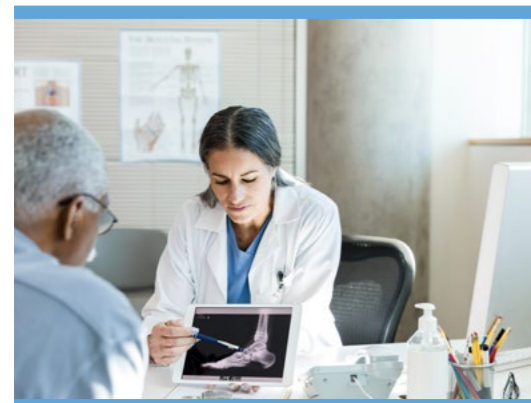


BREAST CANCER

By investing in new technical, technological and human resources, the American Hospital of Paris aims to guarantee comprehensive breast-cancer treatment encompassing risk assessments and individualized prevention by the Women's Risk Institute, rapid early screening, diagnostic micro- and macro-biopsies (One Day Diag), tumor ablation and reparative surgery, drug-based treatments, radiation therapy, breast reconstruction and monitoring, and a wide array of supportive-care options available through our Wellness Center. Each patient benefits from a team of leading experts, a personalized treatment pathway, the presence of a nurse, and the most recent medical and technological innovations.

CARDIOLOGY

Our Cardiology Unit offers medical care and interventional treatments for all heart conditions, including coronary artery disease, hypertension, heart failure and arrhythmia. We have dedicated teams for the treatment of coronary heart disease and heart rhythm disorders such as tachycardia, arrhythmia, and atrial fibrillation. The unit features an interventional room equipped with the latest technology, including 3D mapping.



ORTHOPEDICS

To provide the best medical and surgical treatment for conditions affecting the musculoskeletal system, the American Hospital of Paris has highly qualified experts in four specialty areas: traumatology and the residual effects of traumatology in the upper and lower limbs; treatment of elite athletes; prosthetic surgery with customized hip, knee and shoulder prostheses; and also minimally invasive knee, shoulder and wrist arthroscopy, also known as keyhole surgery.

PLASTIC, RECONSTRUCTIVE AND COSMETIC SURGERY

The American Hospital of Paris performs the full spectrum of routine cosmetic and plastic surgery procedures. We also specialize in facial surgery and in repairing complications resulting from cosmetic surgery and injections.

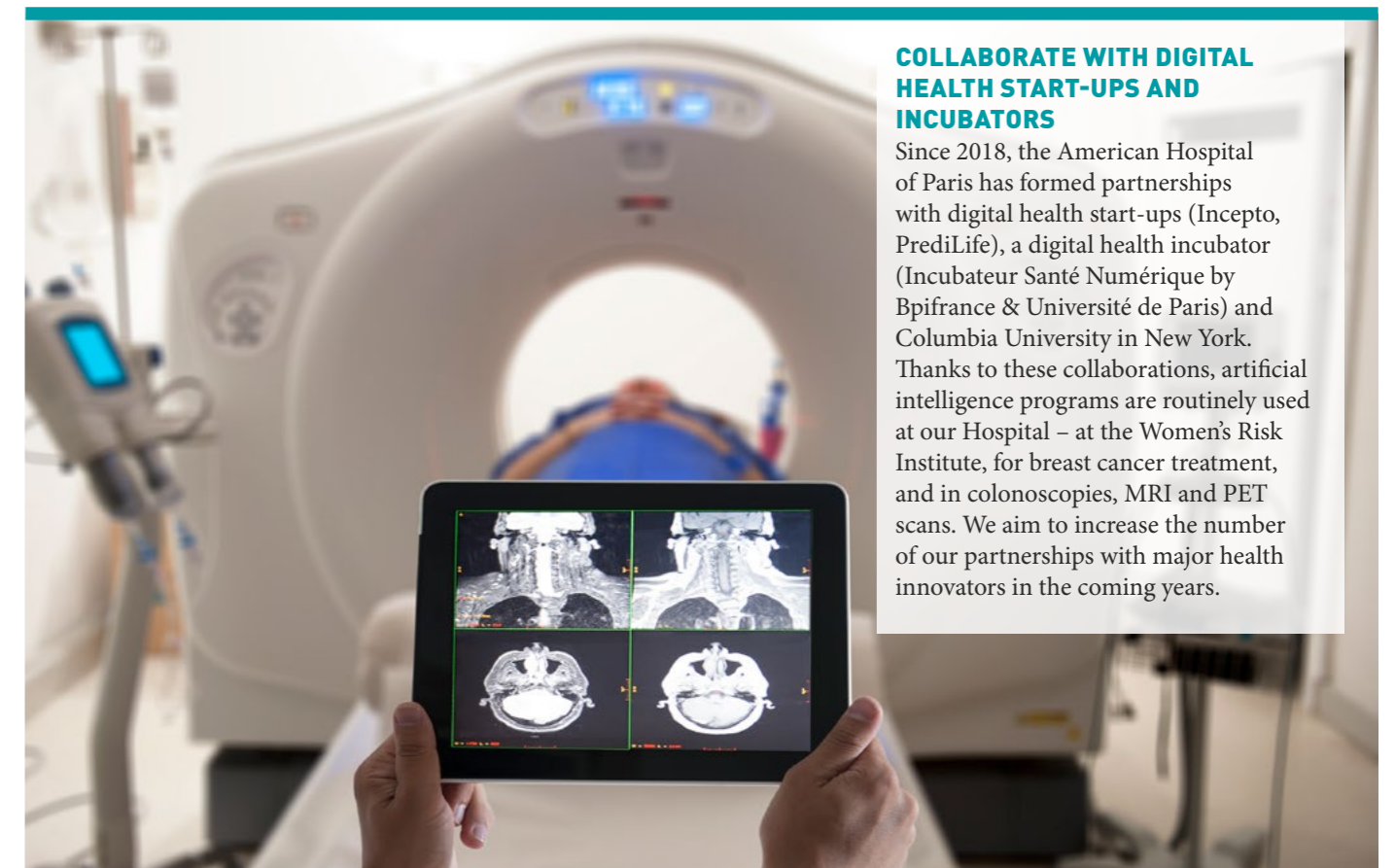


Create the Future of Medicine Now

From the American Hospital of Paris's founding in 1906 to its recent investments in cutting-edge medical imaging, innovation has always been a part of the Hospital's DNA. Today more than ever, our institution is actively accelerating the implementation of innovations that are crucial to the health of people everywhere.

INVEST IN NEW TECHNOLOGIES AND THE MOST INNOVATIVE EQUIPMENT

Our tradition of continuous innovation at the American Hospital of Paris drives us to promote the development of the most innovative technologies and medical practices in order to enhance diagnosis, treatment, and the patient experience. Using emerging technologies such as artificial intelligence, big data, connected objects, biosensors, biotrackers and virtual reality, the American Hospital of Paris strives to be a testing ground for innovations that will spur human progress.



COLLABORATE WITH DIGITAL HEALTH START-UPS AND INCUBATORS

Since 2018, the American Hospital of Paris has formed partnerships with digital health start-ups (Incepto, PrediLife), a digital health incubator (Incubateur Santé Numérique by Bpifrance & Université de Paris) and Columbia University in New York. Thanks to these collaborations, artificial intelligence programs are routinely used at our Hospital – at the Women's Risk Institute, for breast cancer treatment, and in colonoscopies, MRI and PET scans. We aim to increase the number of our partnerships with major health innovators in the coming years.

Increase Involvement in Research and Training

The American Hospital of Paris is undertaking a major transformation of its business model, with the ultimate goal of being recognized as a private teaching hospital in France. By increasing its doctors' participation in clinical research and teaching activities, our Hospital intends to build a new business model based on the hybridization of academic-focused medicine and private medical practice within a private hospital. All of our efforts in terms of financial and human resources now converge to meet this goal.

DEVELOP CLINICAL RESEARCH

The American Hospital of Paris aims to step up its participation in clinical research projects, focusing on priority areas including innovative cancer drugs, medical devices and minimally invasive interventional alternatives to surgery, as well as disruptive diagnostic imaging. To achieve this goal, we work closely with the clinical research unit of Foch Hospital in the Paris region.

INCREASE EXCHANGES WITH OUR AMERICAN PARTNERS

To develop a range of healthcare options that combine the best of French and American medicine, the American Hospital of Paris is intensifying the partnerships established in 2017 with NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital (NYP), Columbia University and Weill Cornell Medical College. Collaborations have also been initiated with Brigham and Women's Hospital and Harvard Medical School in Boston. These have led to scientific exchanges between French and American physicians in such key fields as breast cancer, urology, maternity, imaging, and orthopedics. We also aim to host more American medical students and train them in French medical practices. An additional goal is to ensure that approximately 30 of our nurses and other caregiving staff take part in immersion training at NYP each year to familiarize themselves with best practices in use in the

United States. Lastly, the annual Harvey Cushing Symposium brings together leading scientists from French and American universities to explore a different key topic.

OPEN THE AMERICAN HOSPITAL OF PARIS TO THE ACADEMIC COMMUNITY

The creation of AHP College is part of an unprecedented strategy designed to open the American Hospital of Paris to the academic community. This consists in hiring more university researchers or trainees, heading promising clinical research projects and promoting their publication, participating in scientific conferences, encouraging teaching and continuing education, and organizing scientific events.

AHP College was created through partnerships between the Simone Veil medical school of Versailles Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines University, the University of Paris medical school, and the clinical research unit of Foch Hospital. An agreement recently signed with Versailles Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines University allows us to assign French university professors who practice medicine in a hospital to our Hospital's various departments, where they can organize integrated learning sessions and supervise students. The agreement also creates opportunities for our staff and physicians to access jobs as professor-researchers and associate professors.

OUR CHALLENGE: TO RAISE 100 MILLION EUROS BY 2023

To complete its architectural transformation and promote medical excellence, the American Hospital of Paris must invest 150 million euros over the coming years. We are firmly committed to raising two-thirds of that amount (100 million euros) by the end of 2023.

A dedicated Campaign Committee comprising esteemed figures from the business world is tackling that challenge, which is unprecedented in the history of our institution. At the end of 2022, the Committee, chaired by Board Member Arnaud Lagardère, had already collected more than €83 million in gifts from our French and foreign benefactors. These initial results offer tangible proof of the enthusiasm our transformation project is generating, and of our progress on the path toward success.
