GAMBIAN RADIO DIRECTOR RELEASED

Alagie Abdoulaye Ceesay, managing director of the Gambian Radio Station Teranga FM, has been released on 13 July.

The managing director of the Gambian Radio Station Teranga FM, **Alagie Abdoulaye Ceesay**, was released on Monday 13 July. He was abducted 12 days ago and he had been missing since then. According to press reports, he was dumped on the streets of the city of Yundum, near the airport at around 11:00pm. Reports would also indicate that his abductors were members of the Gambian security forces and that Alagie Abdoulaye Ceesay was severely tortured during detention.

No further action is requested of the UA Network. Many thanks to all who sent appeals.
