No. 1086. San Juan del Río, Querétaro. Aug. 25. Plant stunted; leaves 1- or 2-jugate; flowers white; tubers roundish to 2 by 2 by 1.5 cm.

184763. *SOLANUM PINNATISECTUM* Dun.

No. 1088. Near Querétaro, Querétaro State. Aug. 26. Tubers with dark brown-purple skin and large raised lenticels.

184764. *SOLANUM PINNATISECTUM* Dun.

No. 1093. León, Guanajuato. Aug. 30. Plants 6- to 8-jugate; flowers white, stellate; tubers with large protruding lenticels, older tubers flushed with blue-purple pigment.
