235428. Lysimachia sikokiana Miq. Primulaceae.

Col. No. 471. Muroto-zaki, in broadleaved evergreen forest, Kochi-ken. Subshrub, about 15 inches high; flowers axillary, yellow, hanging; fruits whitish; stems to 2 inches long.

235429. MAESA JAPONICA Mor. & Zoll. Myrsinaceae.

Col. No. 470. In broadleaved evergreen forest, Murotozaki, Kochi-ken, Shikoku. Evergreen shrub to 3 feet high; flowers inconspicuous; fruits small, yellowish when ripe.

235430. Meliosma rigida Sieb. & Zucc. Sabiaceae.

Col. No. 476. Muroto-zaki, in broadleaved, evergreen forest, Kochi-ken' Shikoku. Evergreen tree; leaves broad, oblanceolate, shining, rugose above; flowers small; fruit round, yellow red; rare in cultivation.

\*\* 235431. NEOLITSEA Sp. Lauraceae.

Col. No. 519. On Zozusan, Kotohira, Shikoku. Evergreen tree to 50 feet high; leaves elliptic; flowers yellowish, in dense clusters along branches; fruit bright red, 2 to 3 in a cluster; related to Cinnamomum.

235432. Podocarpus nagi (Thunb.) Pilger. Taxaceae.

Col. No. 474. In broadleaved evergreen forest, Murotozaki, Kochi-ken, Shikoku. Dioecious, evergreen tree; leaves ovate, lanceolate, shining, dark green; seeds round, purple when ripe.

235433. Quercus wrightii Nakai Fagaceae.

Oak

Col. No. 479. Along seacoast, Muroto-zaki, Kochi-ken, Shikoku. Shrublike evergreen tree; leaves ovate, minutely serrate, pubescent beneath.

235434. Raphiolepis umbellata (Thunb.) Makino Malaceae.
Yeddo-hawthorn.

Col. No. 487. 'Mertensii'. Along seacoast, Muroto-zaki, Kochi-ken, Shi-koku. Dense evergreen shrub; leaves roundish, thick; flowers white, in May; fruits purple.

235435. Rosa wichuriana var. poteriifolia Koidz. Rosaceae. Rose.

Col. No. 478. In sand along seacoast, Muroto-zaki, Kochi-ken, Shikoku. Plant prostrate, restricted habit; leaves small, shiny; flowers white, 1.5 inches across, fruits red, ovoid; makes good ground cover.

235436. TERNSTROEMIA MOKOF Nakai Theaceae.

Col. No. 520. In garden of Toraya Inn, Kotohira, Shikoku. Small, dioecious, evergreen tree; leaves oblanceolate, dark green; flowers whitish; fruits orange; seeds red.

235437. VIBURNUM EROSUM Thunb. Caprifoliaceae.

Col. No. 496. On serpentine hills, above Kochi City, Kochi-ken, Shikoku. Deciduous shrub to 8 feet high; fruit in loose cyme, red.
