378043. 'Pokot'. Introduced in 1963 from West Pokot District near Kerio Valley. Very stoloniferous, rapid spreader, growth to 100 cm. tall under fertile conditions. Stems coarse but heavy leaf growth. Impressive herbage production and good drought resistance. Late maturity, growth range up to 2,280 m.

378044. SETARIA SPHACELATA (Schum.) Stapf & Hubb. ex Moss Gramineae.

'Nandi'. Short tufted perennial, nonspreading, but many plants provide thick sward. Leaves grow to 50 cm. before coarse stems appear. Seed heads long and cylindrical. Resistance to frost and water logging makes good substitute for rhodesgrass. Herbage quality good under fertile conditions. Tolerates wide range of environment. Can be grown from 1,500 to 2,900 m. with 850 mm. rainfall.
