


The freshwater fish diversity found in Barton Creek

The Barton Creek watershed hosts a wide diversity of fishes. Historically, 41 species have been recorded throughout its waters. More recent surveys detected a total of 28 species, indicating a decline in overall species richness. Here are some of the fishes you may find:

Longear Sunfish (*Lepomis megalotis*)




Western Mosquitofish (*Gambusia affinis*)

Guadalupe Bass (*Micropterus treculii*)








