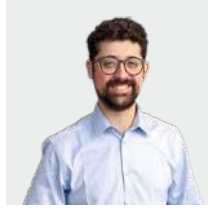

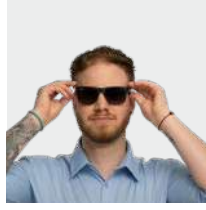

2023 – Plants of the Year

Year of the Salvia

Every year the marketing campaign 'Plant of the Year' from the international organisation Fleuroselect nominates a flower of the year with the intention to raise awareness of specific crops and to show the wide range of varieties to the consumer.



Salvia farinacea Victoria

The annual 'Victoria' convinces with a strong, deep blue flower color. The dense, well-branched plants are up to 24" (60 cm) high and bring an excellent effect to any garden. This nonstop bloomer delights every gardener until the first frost in winter.



Salvia splendens Salvano

The annual 'Salvano' is the perfect plant for beds and borders with a plant height around 12" (30 cm) and basal branching. The vivid red flowers on dense spikes shine from afar. Due to the weather tolerance the garden performance is excellent.



Salvia x superba Queen

The FastraX perennial 'Queen' is a first year flowering plant that does not require vernalization. The two colors of 'Dwarf Blue Queen' with a height of 16" (40 cm) and 'Rose Queen' with a height of 24" (60 cm) can be perfectly combined in beds and borders.

Year of the Rudbeckia

Each year the american organisation National Garden Bureau select a 'Year of the' crop. The plants are chosen because they are popular, easy-to-grow, widely adaptable, genetically diverse and versatile. The ever-popular Rudbeckia produces a mass of different colored flowers that are humming with pollinators in the summer garden.



Rudbeckia hirta Amarillo Gold

The Fleuroselect Gold Medal and AAS winner 'Amarillo Gold' inspires with huge, bright flowers on short stems. The compact plants are perfect for the pot and bedding plant sector and also very well suited as cut flower for summer bouquets. An impressive highlight in every garden.



Rudbeckia hirta Pawnee Spirit

The sun-loving novelty 'Pawnee Spirit' produces impressive golden yellow flowers up to 6" (15 cm) diameter with a dark centered color. The early and uniform flowering plants attracts many beneficial insects. The rain tolerance establishes the outstanding garden performance.



Rudbeckia fulgida Goldsturm

The vigorous perennial 'Goldsturm' with a height of around 28" (70 cm) can be perfectly used as border, pot or container plant. The masses of long-lived yellow flowers with dark centers attracts numerous bees and other pollinators.

Raw

Purity in all Shapes

Seed, in its raw form, comes in all kinds of shapes. All raw seed lots are cleaned and processed using multiple mechanical procedures to obtain highly pure, homogenous seed products.



Detailed

Significant Improvement of Sowing

Detailed seeds are offered for seed forms having a tail, which makes the sowing more difficult. For some flower cultures such as Tagetes (Marigolds) the tail of the seed is mechanically removed, which significantly improves its sowability.



Coating

Seed Placement & Sowability

Thin coatings are used to monitor sowing efficiency. Colored seeds offer a high contrast and thus are easy to spot on dark soil. In contrast, thicker coatings (Encrustings) increase the flowability.

Some plant species produce seeds that have a very flat or irregular shape. These seeds are of poor flowability and can severely impede automatic sowing processes. Encrusting the seeds to give a rounder shape and smoother surface can help solving this challenge.



Pelleting

Easy Sowing & Controlling of Seeds per Cell

Some types of plants produce extremely small sized seeds, which makes automated sowing nearly impossible. These seeds are pelleted to increase their size by approximately 5 to 20 fold. Pellets allow plug growers to easily sow and control the number of seeds per cell.

This makes producing some species such as Lobelia or Portulaca easier by guaranteeing a bushy plant with just one pellet.

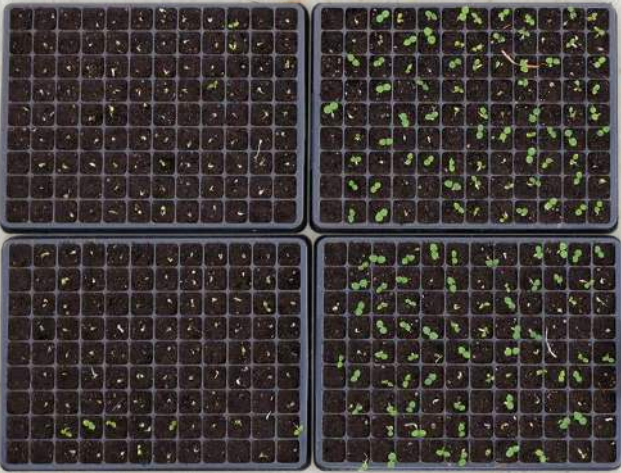

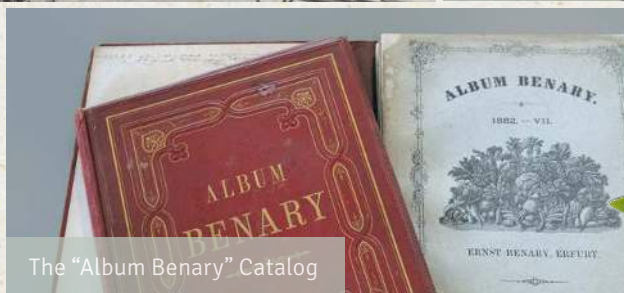

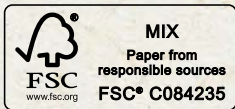


Benary Building in Erfurt
