Family: Acanthaceae  
 Prefers full sun and well-drained soil.  
 Protect crowns in first winter after planting.  
 Nice specimen plant for the back of the border. Frost sensitive.  
 Zone: 6a-11b

The roots are poisonous. Does well in shady perennial borders or wild gardens. Excellent cut flowers.

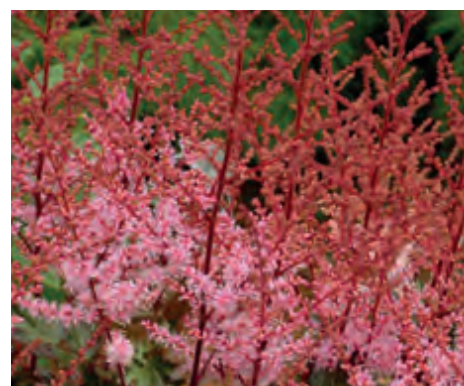

Attracts butterflies and bees.

Creates a bold massive clump and is an excellent foliage plant for the waterside or in damp soils.

Family: Apiaceae

Prefers full sun and moist but well drained organic soil.

For the perennial border or along streams. Very effective when naturalized under light, open trees. Attracts bees.

Family: Saxifragaceae

Prefers partial shade, deep and moist soil.

Intolerant to excessive summer heat or drought.

Evergreen clump forming plants with thick leathery rounded foliage and spikes of tiny cup-shaped flowers, flowers early spring.
