Approved Nature Strip Plantings List

This document provides an approved list of plant species that have been approved and deemed appropriate to use as nature strip plantings. They are typically low growing and robust species. Council will accept select plants listed in the document 'Indigenous Plants of Baw Baw Shire' under the 'Grasses/Sedges/Rushes' and 'Herbs/Orchids/Lilies/Ground-covers' sections. Additionally, Council will also accept the species listed under Groundcovers (Native and Exotic) and Tussock Grasses (Native).
