
INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The BCI Contrarius Global Balanced Feeder Fund aims, over the long-term, to earn a higher total rate of return than an absolute return. The Fund Benchmark is a composite index consisting of 60% MSCI World Index, including net income reinvested and 40% J.P. Morgan Global Government Bond Index, including reinvested coupons ("60/40 Index").

INVESTMENT POLICY

The portfolio will, apart from assets in liquid form, invest solely in Fixed Fee Class shares of Contrarius Global Balanced Fund, a sub-fund of Contrarius ICAV, domiciled in Ireland. Contrarius Global Balanced Fund is an actively managed flexible asset allocation fund that may invest in global equities and equity related securities, investment grade fixed-income securities, commodity-linked instruments and cash. It has the flexibility of reducing its exposure to global equities through stock market hedging. It may vary its net exposure to global equities between 0% and 75%. To the extent that the assets in the portfolio are exposed to exchange rate risk, the manager may enter into financial transactions for the exclusive purpose of hedging such exchange rate risk subject to the conditions and limits as stipulated by the Act.


Moderate - High Risk
