Message from the President



Recently, I ran a marathon for the first time. I have not been a runner for much of my life, but the participation of my son Luke '20 in cross country and track sparked my interest, and I began training just as the pandemic started. I ran a few half-marathons on my own during the pandemic, then decided that if I was ever going to run a full marathon, now was the time.

So it was that in the wee hours of the morning on September 19th, I toed the line for the San Francisco Marathon along with several thousand others. The first 16 miles or so of the race went very well – I was running faster and feeling better than I thought I would. At mile 16, I was joined by longtime Bellarmine track and cross country coach Patrick McCrystle (*pictured at left*), who ran the next ten miles with me. He provided great encouragement and was happy just to talk and let me listen, so I could spare my breath. Things were going great! Then at about mile 20, I felt a cramp in one hamstring. A few steps later, the other leg cramped as well.

The next three miles were rough – we slowed significantly, and I was pretty uncomfortable. But what a gift it was to have Coach McCrystle by my side. Regularly, he offered words of encouragement. He said things like, “you’re doing great;” “hang in there;” “this is amazing, keep it up.” Every word was needed and gave me strength to keep going. At the refueling stations, he would run ahead and get me water, electrolytes, or food – whatever I needed – and have it ready for me, doling out food or drink to me. By mile 23, I had recovered enough that we were able to pick the pace back up, and then Patrick dropped off at mile 26, so that I could run the last .2 miles on my own.

What a remarkable gift it was to receive that kind of encouragement – it was deeply moving, motivating, and enabled me to accomplish something that I could not have done on my own.

At times over the past year, it has felt like Bellarmine has been taking on a marathon – a challenging, long endeavor with many obstacles along the way. But with each new hill that we faced, or when we couldn’t get there on our own, we had our faculty, students, families, and alumni there to lend their support. It truly was a group effort, and we could not have done it without you!

The articles in this magazine all point towards our gratitude. We have leaned on all of our supporters throughout this past year more than ever, and you have shown your generosity and faith in Bellarmine yet again. Though the last year was incredibly challenging, we came through it well, and could not have done it without your support. Thank you very much!

From the Principal's Office

Having all our students and employees return to campus this year has been fantastic. The many months apart taught us to not take for granted all that we are blessed with here at Bellarmine. We have also learned that we must be intentional about caring for ourselves and for those around us. We have implemented a no-cell phone policy during the school day that asks students to connect and build relationships with one another while they are on campus. Our new schedule now enables students to focus on fewer classes each day, and it provides them with time during the day to connect and build community. These slower paced days have afforded us time to reflect upon all that is happening in the world and our responsibility to be active contributors to the world around us.

Every six years, our Province, Jesuits West, asks us to undergo a Sponsorship Review which includes a written self-study and a visit by the Provincial's Assistants for Secondary Education along with educators from other Jesuit schools in our Province. This review is an opportunity to engage in dialogue with our community about our Catholic, Jesuit tradition. While our original review was scheduled to occur in March 2020, we were blessed to have seven fellow Jesuit educators visit our campus this September for our Sponsorship Review. Their visit reaffirmed the work we are doing here at Bellarmine, and the ways in which we are living out our Catholic, Jesuit identity. They encouraged us to continue to provide ongoing spiritual growth opportunities for our employees as well as remaining committed to the diversity, equity and inclusion work that is taking place throughout our community. They celebrated the strength of the Bellarmine community as we worked together to support the students and one another throughout the pandemic. The entire Sponsorship Review process was an important reminder of what our Mission calls us to do here at Bellarmine.

It is in this spirit that I want to celebrate the tremendous work of our students. Recently, Francis Nguyen '24 partnered with "Love the Poor," a local non-profit, to raise \$15,000 to assist individuals struggling in Vietnam due to COVID-19. Aditya Indla '22 earned two leadership awards this year for his tremendous advocacy work. He was recognized as the Campaign for Tobacco-Free Kids National Youth Advocate of the Year and the American Cancer Society's Action Network Emerging Leader. Students like Francis and Aditya inspire younger Bells to make a difference in their communities, and on this year's Freshman Day of Service, 178 freshmen participated in one of several group service projects: removing invasive species at Our City Forest's Nursery, picking up trash with the South Bay Clean Creeks Coalition, picking up trash at Alum Rock Park, packing 300 healthy snack bags for the Boys and Girls Club of Silicon Valley, or participating in Bread for the World's Racial Wealth Gap Simulation and hunger advocacy action. Our students truly are Men for and with Others.

Seeing student activities like band, robotics, athletics, and theatre arts return to campus has been so energizing. While so many are still struggling after the isolation and fear brought on by the pandemic, the Bellarmine community has been a source of strength and energy for so many. As we enter the holiday season, I want to thank you for the many ways you support the Bellarmine community.

Hall of Fame

Bellarmino College Preparatory inducted four distinguished alumni at its Hall of Fame ceremony the evening of August 28, 2021.

The individuals honored, and their respective categories, are **Jeb Ivey**, Class of 1999 (Athletics); **Tomás Durán**, Class of 1992 (Business); **Jim Beall**, Class of 1970 (Public Service); and **Dr. Andrew Schechtman**, Class of 1985 (Science & Medicine).

Jeb Ivey '99 was one of the most outstanding basketball players to come through Bellarmine, and he enjoyed an extremely successful 16-year professional career in Europe. He retired from basketball in 2019, having played more than 500 career games, scored over 6,000 points, and dished out more than 1,500 assists. Jeb's longevity is a testament to his humility, resiliency, and openness to growth, and it led him to develop an obligation to give back. As a result, Jeb has spent more than a decade as a coach, passing along his knowledge and experience to players ranging in age from elementary school all the way up to the professional ranks, both domestically and abroad.

Tomás Durán '92 has devoted his career to creating opportunities and space for people from low-income communities to grow wealth for themselves and their families. He currently works for Community Health Councils, Inc. in their Social Change Institute, partnering with community leaders to build equitable systems. Tomás is also a partner at Concerned Capital, a social benefit corporation dedicated to helping private companies create and save jobs in Southern California.

Longtime public servant Jim Beall '70 has used his status in California politics to advocate for underrepresented members of society, starting when he became the youngest person ever elected to San Jose City Council. As a member of the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors, he launched the county's Children's Health Initiative, aiming to achieve affordable and comprehensive health coverage for 154,000 low-income children while reducing public medical costs. As a California Assemblyman, Jim worked tirelessly to make programs more efficient and effective. In the State Senate, Jim worked to improve regional transportation, increase educational funding, and support foster youth.

Dr. Andrew Schechtman '85 serves as Associate Director of the Stanford Health Care - O'Connor Hospital Family Medicine Residency Program. Dr. Schechtman worked with Project USA in North and South Dakota on American Indian reservations in 1997 and 1998, before traveling abroad to assist with Hurricane Mitch Relief Effort in Guatemala. He spent two years working with Doctors Without Borders treating families in war-torn regions of Uganda and Liberia in 2002 and 2003. Most recently, he took a year-long clinical sabbatical with his family to the Amazonian jungles of Peru in 2017 to serve the local population.

The Hall of Fame inductions occurred on the Bellarmine campus, with the awards ceremony in the Main Stage Theatre of the Sobrato Center for Humanities and the Arts, followed by an outdoor dinner reception on the Leo J. and Mary G. Lucas Quad.

Several Bellarmine seniors are among the National Merit® Scholarship Corporation's (NMSC®) Semifinalists in the 67th annual National Merit Scholarship Program.

As noted by the NMSC® in its September 15 announcement, "These academically talented seniors have an opportunity to continue in the competition for some 7,500 National Merit Scholarships worth nearly \$30 million that will be offered next spring."

To be considered for a Merit Scholarship® award, Semifinalists must fulfill several requirements to advance to the Finalist level of the competition. About 95 percent of the 16,000 Semifinalists are expected to attain Finalist standing, and approximately half of the Finalists will win a National Merit Scholarship, earning the Merit Scholar® title.

More than 250 guests gathered on the Bellarmine campus the evening of September 23 to pay tribute to longtime faculty member Steve Pinkston who retired last year after devoting four decades to the school.

The program, held in the Main Stage Theatre of the Sobrato Center for Humanities and the Arts, included remarks by Sam Liccardo '87, mayor of San Jose; John "J" Hilton '92, emcee; JP Scandalios '85, former student of Mr. Pinkston; Dr. Tony Williams, founding pastor emeritus, Maranatha Christian Center; Tracy "Trey" Pruitt '92, former BSU member; Eli Wankel '22, current BSU president; Sonia Arriola, strategic advisor to the president; and a blessing by Fr. Dick Cobb, S.J.

Many words of praise were shared about the guest of honor, including "Mr. Pinkston has a big heart, and a focused heart." "Steve's ministry has always been about action, not just words." "Mr. Pinkston, you were my first example of a man for others." "A man who has been a moral beacon and guiding light to hundreds, if not thousands ..."

Following the program, guests enjoyed an outdoor dinner reception on the Leo J. and Mary G. Lucas Quad catered by Bellarmine's Chef Jeremy Soulia and the Liccardo Kitchen staff.

The evening included a moving tribute video honoring Mr. Pinkston, as well as a video that provided information about The Pinkston Fellowship (*see sidebar*), which is helping to promote diversity in teaching and for which proceeds of the event were designated. Special thanks to Andie and John Matthew Sobrato '06 for their generous \$50,000 matching gift opportunity, which was exceeded as a result of the event.

MONICA COLLINS joined the Bellarmine community during the 2020-2021 academic year as the school's first faculty member under the newly established Steve Pinkston Fellowship. Now enjoying her second year, Ms. Collins is teaching English 1 (ninth grade analytical reading and writing) as well as African-American Literature for eleventh graders.

"The most impressive part of the Bellarmine community is how many resources are available to the students," Ms. Collins conveyed about her Bellarmine journey thus far. "They are supported in so many ways and our focus on student support and providing resources is incredibly impressive. They are so willing to reach out and help and that is very indicative to the warmth of the community."

The first-generation child of immigrant parents — her mother is Salvadoran and her father is Dominican — Ms. Collins was born in San Diego and raised in San Jose. She received her Bachelor's in English with an emphasis on sociocultural linguistics from UC Santa Barbara and went on to Santa Clara University for its Master of Arts in Teaching and Teaching Credential (MATTC) program.

"Becoming the first Pinkston Fellow is such an honor as I am carrying on a legacy critical to Bellarmine's continued sociocultural development," noted Ms. Collins recently. "The Fellowship provides opportunity for Bellarmine to grow and bring in new ideas and opinions that will expand their worldview while giving future Fellows the chance to join a community that may not have been entirely open to them otherwise. The Fellowship allows for new voices to join the legacy of Bellarmine and bring pride to the campus as it changes alongside the times."

While the future looks bright for Ms. Collins, she has hopes for education in general. "My hope for education is that we move away from the trap of doing things simply because 'that's the way we've always done it.' The world is changing, and we need to change with it. Continuing with current curriculum and educational practices to remain faithful to tradition might no longer suit the students currently sitting in the classroom with us as their world looks much different from those of faces past ... My hope is that education continues to adapt and change alongside our students because that is the best way to serve and honor them."

Faculty/Staff Community Service



As preparations were underway to welcome students back to campus for the new academic year, Bellarmine faculty and staff on August 11 gathered in prayer and in service to others.

In addition to a faculty and staff meeting, a morning Mass was held in Leontyne Chapel with Fr. Mario Prietto, S.J. superior of the Bellarmine Jesuit Community, as president. A special welcome was extended to new faculty and staff members who joined Bellarmine last school year and this year.

Following the liturgy, faculty and staff engaged in service opportunities that ranged from assembling snack packs on behalf of Second Harvest Silicon Valley for students participating in Bachrodt Elementary's after-school programs, to preparing bag lunches for those served by Loaves and Fishes Family Kitchen. Additional service included delivering water and hygiene kits to many unhoused individuals at Columbus Park, working with Our City Forest's nursery, volunteering at the Guadalupe River Park Conservancy Heritage Rose Garden, setting-up classrooms in the renovated James A. Carney Science Center, and working in the Bellarmine Garden.

The faculty and staff day of service is organized annually by the staff of Bellarmine's Christian Service Program (CSP) with Anne Maloney as director. This is the department that coordinates a wide range of volunteer opportunities for students with various local nonprofit agencies throughout the school year.

Thanks to all the participants, organizers, and various nonprofit agencies on this special day in which the Bellarmine community again exemplified being "for and with others."

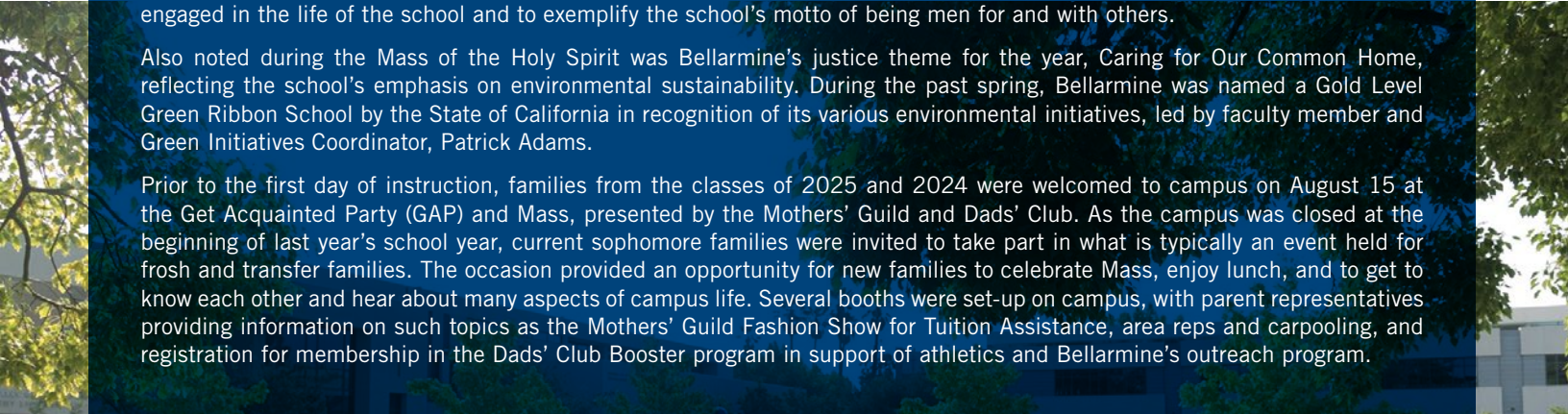


As is tradition at Jesuit schools, Bellarmine College Preparatory began the new academic year the morning of August 16 by celebrating Mass of the Holy Spirit.

Fr. Mario Prietto, S.J., superior of the Bellarmine Jesuit Community, was the president, with many of his brother Jesuits as co-Celebrants. Bellarmine's president, Chris Meyercord '88, delivered the reflection that encouraged students to become fully engaged in the life of the school and to exemplify the school's motto of being men for and with others.

Also noted during the Mass of the Holy Spirit was Bellarmine's justice theme for the year, Caring for Our Common Home, reflecting the school's emphasis on environmental sustainability. During the past spring, Bellarmine was named a Gold Level Green Ribbon School by the State of California in recognition of its various environmental initiatives, led by faculty member and Green Initiatives Coordinator, Patrick Adams.

Prior to the first day of instruction, families from the classes of 2025 and 2024 were welcomed to campus on August 15 at the Get Acquainted Party (GAP) and Mass, presented by the Mothers' Guild and Dads' Club. The occasion provided an opportunity for new families to celebrate Mass, enjoy lunch, and to get to know each other and hear about many aspects of campus life. Several booths were set-up on campus, with parent representatives providing information on such topics as the Mothers' Guild Fashion Show for Tuition Assistance, area reps and carpooling, and registration for membership in the Dads' Club Booster program in support of athletics and Bellarmine's outreach program.

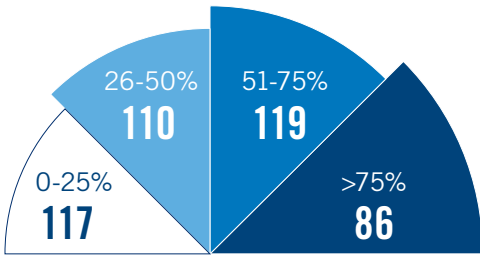

TUITION ASSISTANCE 2020-2021



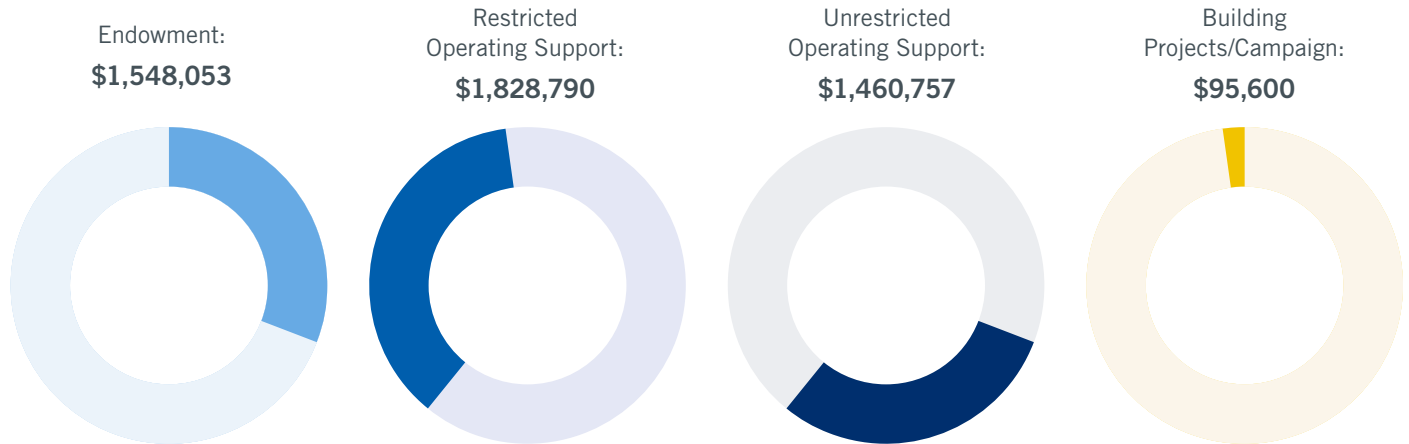

Bellarmine's Tuition Assistance Program is vital to maintaining the school's diversity, as well as ensuring that all qualified candidates may enroll and continue their studies at Bellarmine, regardless of their financial circumstances. During the 2020-2021 school year, Bellarmine awarded \$5.481 million in tuition assistance to nearly one quarter of our students. The funds needed to provide such unparalleled support are the result of contributions to the Direct Tuition Assistance Fund, and partially from the Tuition Assistance Endowment. The adjacent graphic depicts how these funds were awarded, based on a percentage of tuition covered. Tuition for the 2020-2021 school year was \$23,475.

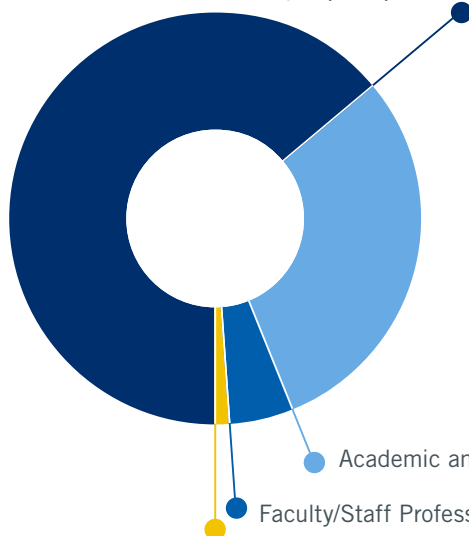
Annual Giving Gift Revenue: Fiscal Year 2020-2021

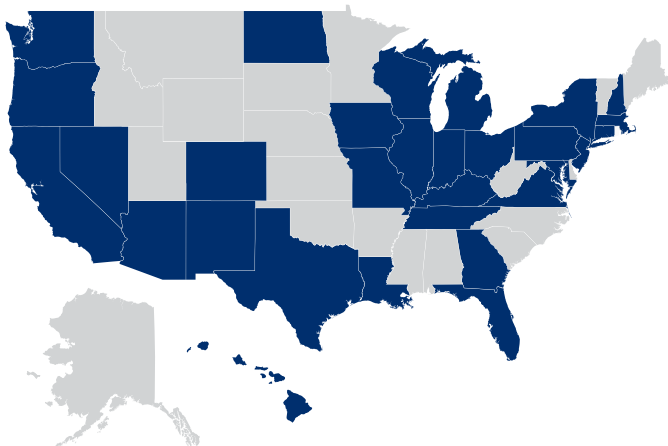

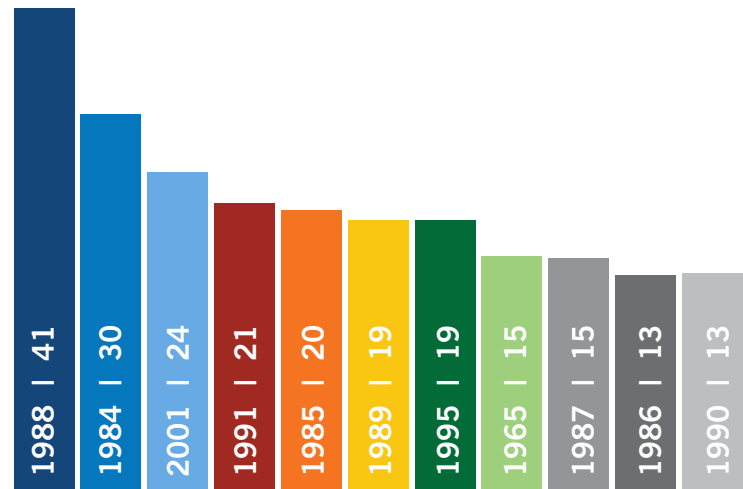

Turn Your Retirement Plan into Your Legacy

Using a Qualified Charitable Distribution to Help You and Bellarmine

The year 2021 will be remembered for a lot of things, and one that jumps to my mind as we head toward the close of this year is the return of required minimum distributions (RMDs) from your Individual Retirement Accounts. Okay, so I think about odd topics. However, keeping RMDs in mind is especially important now since while they were waived for the 2020 tax year, they are back for this year. Even though you may be faced with an RMD situation, you can help Bellarmine and yourself by using a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD).

Internal Revenue Service rules require you to take required minimum distributions each year from your tax-deferred retirement accounts upon attaining a certain age (70½ if you were born before June 30, 1949, or age 72 if you were born after June 30, 1949). These required distributions may push you into a higher tax bracket and/or make you ineligible to take certain tax credits and deductions. A Qualified Charitable Distribution may be a way to minimize the impact of a required minimum distribution on your tax situation.

A Qualified Charitable Distribution is a direct transfer of funds from the custodian of your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) made payable to a qualified charity of your choice. The QCD can be counted toward satisfying your required minimum distribution for the year provided certain rules are met. Subject to those rules, you can accomplish two great goals: first, you are supporting a charity (say, Bellarmine College Preparatory for instance) and all the great work it does. Also, by making a QCD, the amount you provide will not be included in your taxable income. Doing so reduces your adjusted gross income (AGI) and may reduce the tax on your social security or other income as well as retaining your eligibility for other deductions and credits. By reducing your taxable income, you may reap the benefits of other tax credits or deductions that are phased out over higher income levels.

So, what are the basic rules for a QCD? First, to be eligible, you must be 70½ years old. The maximum amount that qualifies for a QCD is \$100,000. Of course, lesser amounts work as well. The funds must come out of your IRA by your RMD deadline date which is generally December 31st. The funds must be transferred directly from your IRA custodian to the qualified charity. The charity must be a 501(c)(3) organization eligible to receive tax-deductible contributions. The IRA custodian can issue a check payable to the charity. (NB: If the distribution check is made payable to you, even if you immediately give it to a charity, there is no QCD, and you will have to include the distribution in your taxable income.) Finally, you may only make a QCD from an IRA. Unfortunately, company plans such as 401(k)s and 403(b)s are not eligible for QCDs.

However, the good news for those of you whose retirement plans are not eligible for QCDs is that you still are able to assist your favorite charity. You can create a legacy and fulfill your charitable goals by naming Bellarmine as the beneficiary of your retirement account. By doing so, you save your individual beneficiaries some tax headaches down the road, plus your generosity provides us with the resources we need to educate and form the young men on our campus.

As always, please check with your estate planning attorney and your tax advisor to make sure such a gift works as an effective strategy for your unique charitable goals and financial situation.

If we can be of assistance in any way, such as providing the language needed to request a QCD distribution from your IRA custodian, please do not hesitate to contact us.

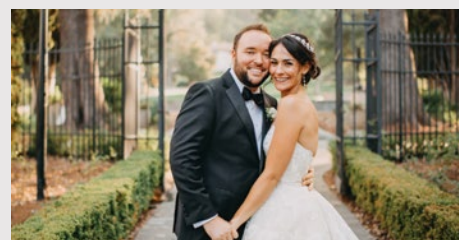

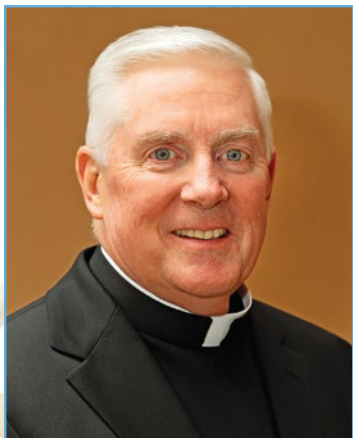
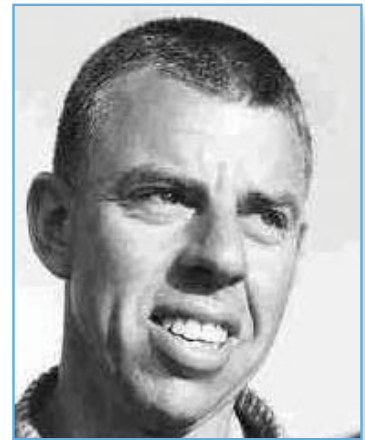

In Memoriam



Fr. Joseph W. Morris, S.J. (October 17, 1925-August 26, 2021) Former Bellarmine faculty member and administrator Fr. Joe Morris passed away at the age of 95. Fr. Morris, who had celebrated his 75th anniversary as a Jesuit, was born in Los Angeles. He attended Loyola University (now Loyola Marymount) and served in the Navy from 1944 to 1946. He entered the Jesuit novitiate at Los Gatos in August 1946 to begin studies for the priesthood. He studied philosophy at Gonzaga University and theology at Santa Clara University. Before his theology studies, Fr. Morris taught English at Bellarmine from 1953 to 1956, and returned to Bellarmine in 1961 as a teacher and also serving as director of admissions for seven years. After leaving high school work in 1976, he began 35 years of pastoral ministry at a series of locations, the last of which was in a ministry of prayer at Sacred Heart Jesuit Center in Los Gatos.

Francis “Conn” Findlay ’48 (April 24, 1930- April 8, 2021) An American Olympic rower and sailor, Conn passed away 16 days shy of his 91st birthday. The athlete earned four Olympic medals in two sports: rowing and sailing. He also was part of the America’s Cup sailing crews that won in 1974 and 1977 and is among the very few who have won both the America’s Cup and an Olympic medal. He is reportedly one of only two people to win the America’s Cup and an Olympic gold medal in rowing. Born in Stockton, Conn studied at USC and earned an MBA from UC Berkeley. Conn was rowing coach at Stanford and oversaw construction of the original Stanford boathouse on its campus. He was inducted into the Stanford Athletics Hall of Fame in 2005.



Fr. Robert Walsh, S.J. (August 30, 1950-October 24, 2020) A fifth-generation Californian, Fr. Walsh joined the Society of Jesus after graduating from Saint Ignatius High School in 1968. He earned his bachelor’s degree from Gonzaga University, his Master of Divinity degree in theology and ministry from the Jesuit School of Theology in Berkeley, and his master’s degree in private school administration from USF. Fr. Walsh served as a priest, teacher, novice director, campus minister, and administrator, including at St. Ignatius High School as campus minister in the 1980s and at Bellarmine from 1990-1992 as a faculty member and assistant principal. Among his numerous ministries, Fr. Walsh also served as principal and president of Loyola High in Los Angeles, president of St. Ignatius College Preparatory in San Francisco, and as chancellor at LMU. As noted in his obituary, “Robert touched many, many lives in his 40 years as an ordained priest and was well loved by all who knew him. He will be greatly missed.”

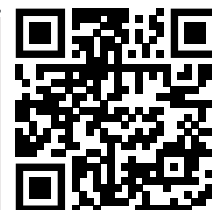

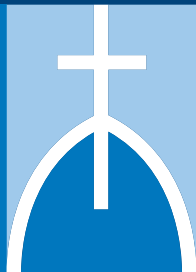
