Here lies a vast selection of primarily tender perennials in Zone 7 that behave like annuals. They grow quickly. bloom for a considerable length of the season lasting until hard frost. The characteristic structure of the flower consists of the corolla or tubular part of the flower consisting of two lips of unequal length, lower one usually spreading. The calyx or covering is often quite distinctive, having two-lips. Salvias are an important source of nectar for hummingbirds and butterflies. They are a decorative necessity for a border in need of color in August through early November. Quite simply, they are essential.





This is one of the most indispensable ground covers around. It forms a 6-inch-tall mat of glossy leaves that always seem to look neat and fresh without being too vigorous. 





## Crassula capitella Campfire (1 qt)

Branching succulent with fleshy propeller-like leaves that mature from light green to bright red. 12-14"

## Crassula pellucida variegata (1 gt)

Petite trailing succulent, grows 2" tall with trailing stems to 12". Colorful, heart shaped foliage in shades of rose, pink, cream and green.

## Echeveria (1 gt)

### E. nudolosa

Narrow rosette, green foliage with burgundy margins. 10-12"

## E. runyonii Topsy Turvy

A fast growing rosette-forming succulent with pale blue-gray leaves that curve upwards. 10-12"

## E. secunda

A succulent that forms attractive clumps under 6" tall of small, tight rosettes of short blue gray leaves and in late spring appear flowers on 1' tall arching stems with orange/yellow flower at 8".

### E. x Perle von Nurnberg

Bold rosettes of pink grey foliage. 10-12"

### E. x Setosa

Blue rosette with frilled edges. 8-10"

## Furcraea foetida (8" pot)

Sedum makinoi Oaon

Upright, thick sword shaped leaves. Variegated green and cream-colored leaves. 10-12"

## Graptoveria Fred Ives (1 gt)

Produces lovely rosettes that are glazed with translucent pink and purple highlights. Coral-colored flowers appear in spring. 12-18"

## Kalanchoe Silver Gray (1 gt)

Silvery gray leaves with toothed margins at the tips also have a rosy tint. Small, urn-shaped pink flowers appear in spring. Use in containers, beds, borders, and mixed dish gardens. Full sun. 6"

## **Orostachys Hardy Duncecap** (1 gt)

Sedum x SunSparkler Lime Zinger

This is an interesting plant that forms mats of small, fleshy, grey-green rosettes. Older stems send out shoots that bear a small rosette on the tip that then roots itself. Long spikes of ivory flowers will cover most of the plant in late summer to early fall. This succulent has a cascading/ trailing form.

## Sedum (1 qt)

S. makinoi Ogon

Tiny leaved plant grows to only 2" tall but with a 12" spread in one season. Drapes over the edge of a pot. Yellow foliage in sun or shade.

## S. makinoi Variegata

Leaved plant grows to only 2" tall but with a 12" spread in one season. Drapes over the edge of a pot. Variegated white and green.

## S. r. Blue Spruce

A drought tolerant ground cover with small, succulent blue leaves reminiscent of the needles of a blue Spruce. Yellow flowers accent containers, rock and alpine gardens.


## S. x SunSparkler Lime Zinger

Lime green foliage with a crisp, contrasting red edge. Hot pink flower heads last for weeks through late summer into fall, 2" tall with a 24" spread.

## Senecio serpens (Blue Chalk Sticks) (1 gt)

A small succulent that hugs the ground, branching from the base and rooting along the stems. The prostrate stems hold short powdery blue-green finger-like fleshy leaves. Small white flowers bloom in summer, 10-12"

Rectangular Windowsill Garden


