- e What has changed about your thinking?
- f What changed your mind?
- g What questions does that raise?
- h What question would a sceptic ask?
- i What evidence do you have?
- j What is the weak point in your argument?
- k Who would agree with you? - Who would disagree with you?
- l What do you still need to know?
- m What else?
- n What is missing?
- o Where do you go from here?
- p What part of the problem is left?
- q What are you certain about? Why?
- r What do you understand least?
- s Can you summarize what X said?
- t Is Y's summary accurate, if not, what is inaccurate?
