Remarks

The thin, translucent colonies of this species make it inconspicuous on the coral rubble specimens examined for this study. However, *Chorizopora brongniartii* is easily distinguished from other species of *Chorizopora* (e.g. Gordon, 1984) by the smooth or transversely wrinkled, but non-spinous, frontal walls of its autozooids.

Distribution

Chorizopora brongniartii is widely distributed in both temperate and tropical shelf seas; in Vanuatu it was found on small pieces of coral rubble in Port Vila Harbour.
