PER CURIAM:

Melvin appeals the district court's order granting Defendant's motion for summary judgment on Melvin's claims under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 2000e to 2000e-17, and dismissing without prejudice his state law claim.
