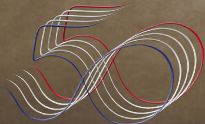

Known for her ability to create “an exceptionally still moment” (UKHA Magazine), City Music Foundation Artist Gwenllian Llŷr will share the stage with her own pupil – and rising star – Sigal Nachshen. Together they will perform a range of solos and duos, championing some of the fantastic works written by female composers, from the mellifluous melodies of Henriette Renie, to the vibrant soundscape of Pearl Chertok’s Around the Clock suite. You may even hear one of Gwenllian’s own compositions – a varied programme to inspire the next generation of harpists!

## Alexander Rider

With interests encompassing period performance to the newest music, Alexander freelances with major ensembles throughout the UK. These include the BBC Concert, BBC Symphony, BBC Philharmonic and BBC Scottish Symphony Orchestras, the City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra, the London Sinfonietta, London Chamber Orchestra, English Touring Opera, Brighton Philharmonic, Chroma and (on the Erard) he appears with groups including the Gabrieli Consort and the Academy of Ancient Music. Alexander is noted for his affinity with French music at the turn of the last century, and for his work on original instruments of the period. He has recorded music and conducted extensive research into players of the time, delving into rich and often hidden histories. Since May 2023, he has been very proud to work with Camac in the field of artistic relations.

Gyda'i ddidordeb yn cwmpasu perfformiadau o gyfnodau penodol a cherddoriaeth newydd, mae Alexander yn chwarae'n hunan gyfrannol gyda phrif ensemblau ledled y DU. Mae'r rhain yn cynnwys Cerddorfa Gyngerdd y BBC, Cerddorfa Symffoni'r BBC, Cerddorfa Philharmonig y BBC, Cerddorfa Symffoni Albanaid y BBC, Cerddorfa Symffoni Dinas Birmingham, Sinfonieta Llundain, Cerddorfa Siambur Llundain, English Touring Opera, Cerddorfa Philharmonig Brighton, Chroma ac (ar yr Erard) mae'n ymddangos gyda grwpiau'n cynnwys y Gabrieli Consort a'r Academy of Ancient Music. Mae Alexander yn nodedig am ei gyswllt â cherddoriaeth Ffrengig ar droad y ganrif ddiwethaf, ac am ei waith ar offerynnau gwreiddiol y cyfnod hwnnw. Mae wedi recordio cerddoriaeth ac wedi cynnal ymchwili helaeth i chwaraewyr y cyfnod hwnnw, gan dwrio i mewn i hanesion cyfoethog a rhai sydd yn aml yn gudd. Ers Mai 2023, mae wedi bod yn falch iawn i weithio gyda Camac ym maes cysylltiadau artistig.

## Amanda Whiting

Welsh harpist Amanda Whiting has very quickly established herself as an essential part of the UK jazz scene. With her classical training, she has carved out her own unique sound following in the paths forged by Ashby and Coltrane. Touring extensively with her own band as well as previously with Matthew Halsall, Chip Wickham, DJ Yoda and Rebecca Vasmant, she endlessly delivers immense beauty and depth from the stage. Her Cheltenham Jazz set 2023 was BBC Radio 6's Cerys Matthews' "highlight of the festival...Extraordinary. An astonishing musical mind". Add to that three incredibly successful albums ("highly recommended" by Jamie Cullum, BBC Radio 2) for the legendary Jazzman record label and a nomination for Instrumentalist of the Year at the Jazz FM awards and you get a picture of a hugely important talent. In November 2023, Amanda released two albums: a remix album of Lost in Abstraction out on Albert's Favourites and a collaboration with Don Leisure on her new label First Word Records. Her new solo album "The Liminality of Her" will be out in March 2024. Amanda currently teaches jazz harp at the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama, Cardiff and the

Royal Birmingham Conservatoire. As a composer, she has 23 pieces on the Trinity Music College Exam syllabus, as well as having a prestigious Harp Column Studio.

Mae'r delynores Gymreig Amanda Whiting wedi sefydlu ei hun yn gyflym iawn fel rhan annatod o fyd jazz y DU. Gyda'i hyfforddiant clasurol, mae wedi creu ei sain unigryw ei hun gan ddilyn y llwybrau a grëwyd gan Ashby a Coltrane. Trwy deithio'n eang gyda'i band ei hun yn ogystal, yn flaenorol, â Matthew Halsall, Chip Wickham, DJ Yoda a Rebecca Vasmant, mae'n traddodi prydfwrthwch a dyfnder eithriadol yn barhaol o'r llwyfan. Roedd ei set Jazz Cheltenham 2023 yn ôl Cerys Matthews ar Radio 6 y BBC yn "uchafbwynt yr wyf! ...Anhygoel. Meddwl cerddorol rhyfeddol." Gellir ychwanegu at hyn dri albwm llwyddiannus dros ben ("argymhellir yn fawr" gan Jamie Cullum, BBC Radio 2) ar label recordiau chwedlonol Jazzman ac enwbiad ar gyfer Offerynnwr y Flwyddyn yng ngwobrau Jazz FM ac o hynny fe gewch lun o ddawn hynod o bwysig. Yn Nhachwedd 2023, rhyddhaodd Amanda ddau albwm: albwm ailgymysgedd o Lost in Abstraction allan ar Albert's Favourites a chydweithriad gyda Don Leisure ar ei label newydd First Word Records. Bydd ei halbwm unigol newydd "The Liminality of Her" allan ym Mawrth 2024. Ar hyn o bryd mae Amanda yn addysgu telyn jazz yng Ngholeg Brenhinol Cerdd a Drama Cymru yng Nghaerdydd ac yn y Royal Birmingham Conservatoire. Fe cyfansoddwr mae ganddi 23 darn ar faes llafur arholiadau Trinity Music College, yn ogystal â chael Harp Column Studio mawreddog.

## Ben Creighton Griffiths

Benjamin Creighton Griffiths is an internationally touring jazz and classical harpist based in Wales. Originally classically trained, he now specialises in jazz both as a soloist and with his bands – the Transatlantic Hot Club and Chube. His career has taken him across the world including to Canada, the Caribbean, Hong Kong, India, Brazil, and across Europe and has seen him collaborate with excellent musicians in both the classical and jazz worlds. As well as a performer he is a composer, most recently developing a concert schedule for his own Concerto for Jazz Harp & Symphony Orchestra.

Mae Benjamin Creighton Griffiths yn delynor jazz a chlasurol sy'n teithio'n rhyngwladol ond yn byw yng Nghymru. Yn wreiddiol cafodd hyfforddiant clasurol a nawr mae'n arbenigo mewn jazz fel unawdydd a chydai'ndiaid - y Transatlantic Hot Club a Chube. Mae ei yrfa wedi ei gymryd ar draws y byd yn cynnwys Canada, y Caribi, Hong Kong, India, Brasil, ac ar draws Ewrop ac wedi ei weld yn cydweithio gyda cherddorion ardderchog yn y byd jazz a chlasurol fel ei gilydd. Mae hefyd yn gyfansoddwr ac yn fwyaf diweddar mae wedi datblygu amserlen gyngerdd ar gyfer ei Concerto for Jazz Harp & Symphony Orchestra ei hun.



## Catrin Finch

Catrin Finch is one of the world's greatest harp players, and one of her generation's most versatile and gifted musicians. A natural musical adventurer, Catrin's career includes both solo performances with the world's top orchestras and, more recently, sensational award-winning collaborations and recordings with some of the greatest global musicians including Cimarron (Colombia), Toumani Diabate (Mali), Seckou Keita (Sengal) and Ireland's Aoife Ní Bhriain. Catrin is currently Head of Harp at the Royal Academy of Music, London.

Mae Catrin Finch yn un o delynorion mwyaf y byd ac yn un o gerddorion mwyaf dawns ac amryddawn ei chenchediaeth. Mae'n naturiol yn anturus fel cerddor ac mae ei gyrfa wedi cynnwys perfformiadau unigol gyda cherddorfeidd gorau'r byd ac, yn fwyaf diweddar, cydweithrediad cyffrous sydd wedi ennill gwobrau a recordiadau gyda rhai o gerddorion mwyaf y byd yn cynnwys Cimarron (Colombia), Toumani Diabate (Mali), Seckou Keita (Sengal) ac Aoife Ní Bhriain o'r Iwerddon. Yn gyfredol, Catrin yw Pennaeth Telyn yn y Royal Academy of Music, Llundain.

## Deborah Henson-Conant

Deborah Henson-Conant ("DHC") is an ambassador to the world of music and imagination – a Grammy-nominated electric harp virtuoso with a wicked sense of humour, a gutsy set of vocal chords and a theatrical flair. She's intimate, inventive, spontaneous and bigger-than-life – and she pulls sounds from the 32 strings of her custom-built electric harp that you'd never expect to hear from the instrument Saint Peter hands out at the Pearly Gates: Blues. Jazz. Latin. Flamenco. She uses a foot-pedal to capture musical phrases on the fly and loop them together, building a pulse of sound and rhythms she improvises over, and tells stories of her own improbable life as she strides the stage strapped onto her harp like a musical centaur. Poetic dissonance, movement, story and song – she pulls it all from the world's most cutting-edge harp, built for her by the Camac company and named after her, the "DHC." She's opened for Ray Charles at Tanglewood, toured with the Boston Pops as a featured soloist, and with guitar legend Steve Vai as a rock harpist. Her music special "Invention & Alchemy" appeared on PBS Stations throughout the USA and she performs her own solo shows in theatres and concert halls around the world.

Mae Deborah Henson-Conant ("DHC") yn llysgennad i fyd cerddoriaeth a dychymyg - mae'n athrylith ar y delyn drydan ac wedi eu henwebu ar gyfer Grammy a chanddi synnwr digrifwch drygonus, ynghyd â chortynnau lleisiol cryf a dawn theatrig. Mae hi'n agos atoch, yn ddyfeisgar, yn ddigymell ac yn bersonaliaeth fywiog - ac mae'n tynnu sain allan o'r 32 tant sydd yn ei thelyn, a adeiladwyd yn arbennig iddi, na fydded chi'n disgwyl eu clywed o'r offeryn yn nwylo Sant Pedr wrth y Pyrh Perlog; Blws. Jazz. Lladin. Fflamenco. Mae'n defnyddio pedal troed i ddal cymalau cerdd hedfanog a'i cysylltu â'i gilydd, gan adeiladu curiad o sain a rhythmau byrfyfyr, a hefyd yn dweud hanesion o'i bywyd annhebygol wrth iddi frasnagu ar y llwyfan a'i thelyn ar ei chorff fel rhyw ddyfnarch (centaur) cerddorol. Anghyseineidd barddonol, symudiadau,

storiau a chaneuon - mae'n tynnu'r hyn oll o delyn fwyaf blaengar y byd a adeiladwyd ar ei chyfer gan gwmi Camac a'i henwi ar ei hól - y "DHC." Mae hi wedi agor sioe i Ray Charles yn Tanglewood, wedi teithio gyda'r Boston Pops fel unawdydd a gyda'r gitarydd chwedlonol, Steve Vai fel telynores roc. Mae ei rhaglen gerddoriaeth arbennig, "Invention & Alchemy", wedi ymddangos ar orsafoedd PBS ledled yr UDA ac mae hi'n perfformio ei sioeau unigol ei hun mewn theatrau a neuaddau cyngerdd o amgylch y byd.

## Elinor Bennett

Elinor Bennett is a highly-acclaimed international concert harpist, rooted in the traditional music, language and culture of Wales, who became prominent from an early age by winning many prizes in the National Eisteddfodau. Her first degree was in Law at the University College of Wales, Aberystwyth, but her career changed course on winning a scholarship from the Countess of Munster Musical Trust, to study at the Royal Academy of Music, London. Elinor played with all the major British orchestras, and worked with some of the world's finest conductors and composers, including Benjamin Britten. She has made many recordings, ranging from a definitive selection of 20th century harp classics to collections of traditional music and Welsh folk songs on the triple harp. Elinor was awarded a Churchill Scholarship to travel to Australia to study Music Therapy and, on her return, was instrumental in promoting its use for people and children with intellectual disabilities. Many leading composers have written works for Elinor, and amongst her ex-pupils are distinguished harpists including Catrin Finch and Sioned Williams. She directed harp studies at Bangor University for many years and has been Visiting Professor of Harp at the Royal Academy of Music and the Guildhall School of Music, London. Elinor is Trustee and founder member of Canolfan Gerdd William Mathias Music Centre. The recipient of many Honorary Fellowships in the UK, she was awarded an OBE for services to music and an Honorary Doctorate in Music by the University of Wales. Elinor is Director of the Wales International Harp Festival and has been Special Guest at harp festivals and competitions in many countries in Europe, North America, and the Far East.

Mae Elinor Bennett yn delynores gyngerdd ryngwladol uchel ei pharch, a'i gwreiddiau yng ngherddoriaeth draddodiadol, iaith a diwylliant Cymru ac a ddaeth i'r amlwg pan oedd yn ifanc trwy ennill llawer o wobrau yn yr Eisteddfodau Cenedlaethol. Roedd ei gradd gyntaf yn y Gyfraith yng Ngholeg Prifysgol Cymru, Aberystwyth, ond newidiodd cwrs ei gyrfa pan enillodd ysgoloriaeth gan y Countess of Munster Musical Trust, i astudio yn y Royal Academy of Music, Llundain. Chwaraeodd Elinor gyda holl brif gerddorfeidd Prydain a gweithio gyda rhai o arweinyddion a chyfansoddwyr gorau'r byd yn cynnwys Benjamin Britten. ## Gwenllian Llŷr

Welsh harpist Gwenllian Llŷr is gaining international recognition for her charismatic and engaging performances. Gwenllian was twice a prize-winner at the USA International Harp Competition in Bloomington where she was highly praised for her musicianship. She has also won many prizes more locally, including the Len Lickorish Memorial Prize for a String Player of Promise at the Royal Over-Seas League AMC 2018, as well as becoming an Artist with City Music Foundation in 2017. Gwenllian's career has already taken her across the globe, with performances in prestigious venues such as St. David's Hall, Buckingham Palace, Carnegie Hall and the Royal Albert Hall, and alongside renowned artists such as jazz legend Al Jarreau, pianist Imogen Cooper, and international opera singer Bryn Terfel. Following the successful release of her debut solo album, *Dusk to Dawn*, in which her playing was hailed as "magnificent" and "powerful", Gwenllian is currently working on the release of her new CD alongside Ty Cerdd. A graduate of the Royal Academy of Music, The Juilliard School and the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama, Gwenllian is currently based in London where she is enjoying a busy and varied freelance career. Her love of the harp extends beyond the stage: Gwenllian's private teaching studio is thriving, with students winning prizes in national and international competitions and gaining membership to prestigious schools and orchestral courses. In addition, Gwenllian's published works are gaining popularity, and she looks forward to finding more time to share more of her works in the coming years.

Founder of the 'How To Harp' online harp school, she is deeply passionate about teaching and dedicated to empowering students worldwide. With a career rooted in both performance and education, Heather finds joy in guiding harpists to overcome learning obstacles and has a particular interest in supporting the development of musical identity and creativity with all her students.

## Isabelle Moretti

Since the start of her distinguished career, Isabelle Moretti has been an ambassador for the French harp throughout the world. In her hands, the instrument fully reveals its immense - sometimes even unsuspected - expressive potential. Beauty of sound, perfection of style, depth of eloquence: the words of the composer Philippe Hersant encapsulate the qualities of an artist throughout her vast repertoire, from the 18th century to the music of today. In present times, Isabelle Moretti is also acutely committed to ecology. She feels Pierre Rabhi's words as if they were her own: The earth, a silent being of which we are one of the living expressions, harbours eternal values formed of what is most lacking: the right cadence, the flavour of the seasons, and patience. Isabelle Moretti can only conceive of her mission as a musician in close connection with her deepest convictions. Her poetic tale *Parole de terre* ("Word of the Earth"), also inspired by Rabhi's writings, is a vibrant illustration of this. Isabelle Moretti's need to share music also manifests itself through special collaborations with colleagues of particular affinity, such as Magali Mosnier, Juliette Hurel, the Quatuor Ebène, Dame Felicity Lott, and the oboist and conductor François Leleux with whom she had the

pleasure of playing Mozart's celebrated Concerto for Flute and Harp. Isabelle fulfils her passion for teaching through her positions as Professor at the Conservatoire National Supérieur de la Musique et de la Danse in Paris and Visiting Professor at the Royal Academy of Music in London. She also loves to travel the world and meet young people from all cultures through her numerous masterclasses.

In the twenty years since then, Jakez has taken Camac to ever-new heights of excellence.
