



Nominate Now for the Sandra Goff Memorial Award

Established in 1980, the Sandra Goff Memorial Award is awarded for recognition of distinguished service to the profession of school psychology in California, and to CASP (one per year.)

Award Criteria

1. Exemplary service to the Association long-term contributions to school psychology in a variety of settings, and influence extending throughout California and beyond.
2. All CASP members are eligible for this recognition including practicing psychologists, coordinators, directors, administrators of psychological services, and others. It is in recognition of distinguished service to the profession of school psychology and recognizes exemplary service to the Association, long-term contributions to school psychology in a variety of settings, and efforts that had effects beyond district boundaries, throughout California and the nation.

Nominations

Nominations must be submitted by letter to CASP. Please include three to five letters of support no more than one page in length. Letters must include one from an individual knowledgeable of the candidate's capabilities and one from an individual who works with the candidate in a professional setting.

Deadline: January 10, 2003

The results of the selection are kept confidential until the award is announced and presented at the opening general session of CASP Convention 2003. Send in your nomination right away. Don't wait until the January 10, 2003 deadline. Send it today! ■
