- Be professional and courteous in dealing with students, families, faculty and staff, and the general public.
- Affirm the identity, mission, and vision statements, and the foundational documents principles of Central Christian School.

- Full time or part time position for school year (dependent upon teaching responsibilities)

Responsibilities

- Teach Social Studies course curriculum as assigned.
- Teach Elective courses as assigned.
- Communicate with students and parents about grades and assignments to help students be successful.
- Keep grades and class assignments up-to-date in FACTS Gradebook and Google Classroom.
- Student supervision as scheduled or assigned (ie. study hall, morning, lunch, recess, afternoon, hallway/common areas, or other student supervision as needed)
- School Committee participation as requested or assigned as needed.
- Attend all CCS In-service meetings, all school meetings, and grade level meetings as scheduled.
- Attend Chapel. Take attendance.
- Volunteer two times a year at school activities (athletic gate, ushering, etc.)
- Create and lead an eight-day High School Mini-Term course or a three-day Middle School Mini-Term course
- Other duties as assigned or requested.
