Soil: Well-drained, organically rich


- Bloom Color: Purplish pink

 - Also may be grown in containers

- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Evergreen, variegated strappy leaves brighten up shady areas

Bloom: Yellow/Green to Cream/Tan


- Gold and pale gray/green variegated leaves and pink on the new foliage during cool weather in the spring and fall.
- Hardy into the single digits.
- Often short lived perennials, lasting 2 or 3 seasons.
- Euphorbia sap may cause rash, care should be taken to keep it off your skin.
- Drought tolerant
- Classified as poisonous

• Bloom: Pink petals, yellow stamens


Distinctive characteristics:

 Soils must not be allowed to dry out


- Neutral to slightly alkaline soils

 Periwinkle-blue flowers accented by lighter centers and reddish veins


- Mounding habit great in beds or containers


















- Bloom Color: Light green
- Distinctive characteristics:
 - Red berries in the fall
 - Grows well in moist conditions along streams or ponds.
 - Combine with hostas which will continue to fill the space in summer when these plants go dormant.
 - An interesting native spring wildflower for the shady woodland garden, wild garden or native plant garden.

Perennial - Evergreen - Late Spring-Mid-Summer


















- Soil: Well-drained, rich, mildly acidic
- Bloom Color: White, fragrant
- Distinctive characteristics:
 - A prostrate plant that reaches only 2-3" tall, but will spread by trailing stems to 12" wide or more.
 - Evergreen ground cover with interesting foliage, flowers and fruitscarlet berries.
 - Plant in woodland/shade gardens, under trees, part shade areas of border fronts, rock gardens, around small ponds.



 - Drought tolerant



















- Bloom Color: Orange-red rays with orange brown center cone

 - Loves heat and humidity

- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Exceptionally drought tolerant
 - Heat, humidity tolerant evergreen
 - Low growing, good for mass planting and erosion control in poor soils in hot, sunny areas

- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Exceptionally drought tolerant
 - Heat, humidity tolerant evergreen



Bloom Color: Lavender-purple

- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Showy cut flower
 - Vertical accent in garden
 - Tolerant of heat and humidity
 - Drought tolerant

- Bloom Color: White
- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Compact plant
 - Called obedient plants because each individual flower will, upon being pushed in any one direction, temporarily remain in the new position as if it were hinged.
 - Showy flower; abundant blooms over long summer period; pure white flowers do not fade to brown as they age
 - Spreads by rhizomes. This cultivar is less aggressive than that of species plants.




- Bloom Color: Golden yellow

 - Mounding habit






Bloom Color: White

Foliage Color: Lime with red veins


- Grown for colorful, evergreen leaves year-round
- Lime colored foliage in a large, tight mound. White summer flower. Leaf vein reddens in fall.
- Heat tolerant

Biennial (Grown as Annual) - Summer-Frost














- **Bloom Color:** Bright yellow rays and purplish-brown center disks
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Drought tolerant
 - Produces huge flowerheads (6-9" diameter)

Perennial - Bulb - Mid-summer










- Soil: Well-drained, organically rich, dry
- Bloom Color: White, cream, white tinged with purple (depends upon variety)
- Distinctive characteristics:
 - Grows well in pots with great drainage in the full sun.
 - The foliage comes early with the pineapple-like blooms following and thriving well into fall
 - Long lasting cut flower

- Soil: Well-drained, acidic, sandy
- Bloom Color: Blue violetpurple
- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Good cut flower
 - Great massed in rock gardens or sunny dry slopes
 - Grows in low compact clumps
 - Drought tolerant



Aromatic Aster

Symphyotrichum oblongifolium Perennial - Mid-Summer-Fall


















- Soil: Well-drained, clay, sandy, add compost
- Bloom Color: Purple, blue
- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Good cut flower
 - Leaf fragrant when crushed
 - Ground cover, open meadow
 - Drought tolerant

Perennial - Late Summer-Fall










- **Soil:** Well-drained, consistently moist, fertile, humus-rich
- Bloom: White petals, yellow stamens
- Distinctive characteristics:
 - Best in part shade





- Distinctive characteristics:
 - Valued because of their unique flowers, ability to flower in shade and late summer to fall bloom time.
 - Plants gradually spread by stolons to form colonies.
 - Borders, woodland gardens, shade gardens or naturalized areas.



Distinctive Characteristics:


- Resists light frost-blooms into November
- Fragrant blooms
- Heat and humidity tolerant
- · Grows well on fence or trellis
- Drought tolerant once established

Symphyotrichum grandiflorum Perennial - Fall














- Soil: Well-drained, acidic, lean
- Bloom Color: Purple
- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Only grows in the Carolinas and Virginia
 - Beautiful, big purple blooms in mid to late fall
 - Drought tolerant



Crested Leopard Plant

Farfugium japonicum 'Crispata'

Perennial - Fall-Winter











- Soil: Well-drained, moist, rich
- Bloom Color: Yellow, daisy-like
- clusters above foliage
- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Foliage: Large, shiny, gray-green
 - Protect from mid-day sun. Wilts easily
 - Does not tolerate wet conditions
 - Shelter from cold, drying winter winds
 - Rare, much sought after crested form with ruffled edges








Miscellaneous: Annuals, Ferns, Grasses, Vines

Annual - Shrub - Summer












- Bloom Color: White with yellow bracts,
- showy
- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Grown as an annual in Zone 8
 - Makes a great container plant
 - Best color when planted in light shade

Annual – Vine – Early Fall













Bloom Color: Clear blue with white and yellow center

- **Distinctive characteristics:**
 - Grows as a vine or creeper
 - Does well in moist neutral soil.
 - Save seed pods



Asparagus Fern

Asparagus densiflorus Perennial - Fern

• **Soil:** Well-drained, moist, organic

Bloom: White

Distinctive characteristics:

- Noted for its dense fern-like foliage which forms an arching mound
- Member of the asparagus family.
- Tiny, inconspicuous, pea-like, fragrant white flowers bloom in late spring to early summer. Flowers are followed by small red berries which ripen by fall.
- Parts of plant are poisonous if ingested
- Considered a houseplant in our area unless planted in a very protected area.
- Drought tolerant

Asparagus densiflorus 'Myers'

Perennial - Fern














- Soil: Well-drained, moist
- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Has long, tapering cones of tightly packed needles in dense rosettes that are partially upright, giving a very structural and interesting effect.
 - Moderately drought tolerant once established

Perennial -- Fern











- Soil: Well-drained, moist
- **Distinctive Characteristics:**
 - Large evergreen fern with glossy, dark green foliage
 - Tough plant
 - Moderately drought tolerant once established

Perennial - Fern














Distinctive Characteristics:

- Evergreen hardy fern with copper color new growth
- More drought tolerant than most ferns

Perennial -- Fern




















- Bloom: Non-blooming
- Distinctive characteristics:
 - With constant moisture can reach 6' in height.
 - Use in bogs; along creek banks, rain gardens
 - Broad fronds typically turn yellow to brown in autumn.
 - Spores are located in brown, tassel-like, fertile clusters at the tips of the fronds, giving rise to the additional common name of flowering fern for this plant.



Cinnamon Fern

Osmundastrum cinnamomeum

Perennial -- Fern























- **Bloom:** Non-blooming
- Fronds: Bright green to cinnamon color as it matures
- **Distinctive characteristics:**
 - The common name of this plant is in reference to the cinnamon colored fronds when mature.
 - Reproduces thru spores
 - Forms huge clonal colonies in swampy area
 - Use in bogs, along creek banks






Dwarf Fountain Grass

Perennial - Ornamental Grass - Summer-Fall

Bloom Color: White



- Arching, deep green foliage in an upright clump
- Grows to 24" tall.
- Leaves are deep green in summer, orange-bronze in fall, beige in late fall
- Flower spikes showy, silvery to pinkish-white, wheat-like, in late summer
- Brownish spikes persist until late fall or early winter before shattering.
- Drought tolerant






Miscanthus Maiden Grass

Perennial - Ornamental Grass - Summer-Winter












- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Graceful, narrow leaf form of this popular ornamental grass
 - Drought tolerant

Soil: Well-drained


Bloom Color: Reddish-brown tassels in summer, then silvery plumes in fall

- Leaves: Medium green, variegated with yellow horizontal bands
- Distinctive Characteristics:
 - Known as porcupine grass because of upright grass and bands
 - Drought tolerant
 - Winter interest



Madagascar Jasmine

Stephanotis floribunda Perennial – Vine – Spring-Fall









Bloom Color: White, fragrant

Distinctive characteristics:

- Tropical twining woody climber (12-20' tall).
- Thick, oval, glossy deep green evergreen leaves
- Intensely fragrant, narrowtubular, waxy white flowers, in clusters of 3-6
- Bloom summer to fall
- Houseplant in our area





Thunbergia Vine

Thunbergia battiscombei 'Blue Glory'

Perennial - Vine - Summer









• Soil: Well-drained

Bloom Color: Royal blue with yellow throat

Distinctive Characteristics:

- Perennial vine, dies back in winter and emerges from roots in spring
- Beautiful, large royal blue flowers all summer
- Grows on trellises, structures; also, containers



Bloom Color: Light yellow

• Fall Color: Golden

Distinctive Characteristics:

- Spreading, mounding mass of branches. Light yellow tubular flowers from January to April on previous season's growth
- Tolerates: heavy shade
