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Project: Bust to the Memory of Huseyn Javid (1882-1941)

Brief description: Huseyn Javid (1882-1941) was a prominent Azerbaijani poet and playwright of the early 20th century. He was one of the founders of progressive romanticism in the contemporary Azerbaijani literature and a strong opponent of the repressive totalitarian Soviet regime. Javid was convicted for anti-Soviet sentiments and was sent to exile in 1937. Javid fell victim to Stalin's political repressions which is also known as the Red Terror.

Placement of the commemorative work: Per request of the Old Georgetown Board the USACC has revised the proposed bust placement location to the left of the entryway vestibule and at the right corner of the existing fence. However, as the USACC proceeded seeking further concept approval by the remaining government agencies via the District Department of Transportation representatives, a Washington Gas representative pointed out that there is a conflict with the existing Washington Gas facilities that are too close to the desired placement location of the pedestal. Hence, the USACC is asking the Old Georgetown Board committee to reconsider the original proposal for location placement between the two window wells, as that seems to be the only location that would not endanger any gas facilities. Please see page 11 for drawing plans for each placement location option with the Washington Gas facilities marked.

No additional light fixtures will be installed (please see images on page 6 showing night view with street lighting).

Installation of the pedestal and bust: The pedestal would be installed into the ground. Two steel rebars would be installed within (inside) the pedestal granite piece (see diagram on <u>page 9</u>). These steel rebars would be placed into a footing, which would be a concrete block that would be submerged fully into the ground, 10in deep. The bust would also have two steel rebars placed inside the structure. These rebars would be placed into the holes of the pedestal (see diagram on <u>page 9</u>). Sealant would be used to keep the bust in place on the pedestal.


Cement block for footing – width 1.14ft, depth 1.14ft, height 10in

Materials – Bronze without coating (bust), Jet Mist Granite, black (pedestal), steel (rebars), cement (footing block)


General scheme of the property location




