We are pleased to present to you the 2007-2008 Annual Report for The Center for Grieving Children.

Our 20th Anniversary year has been filled with celebrations and new challenges. Just over a year ago we concluded our *Making Room for Hope Campaign* to provide The Center with a permanent home - a long cherished dream for our volunteers, families, staff and board - and hosted Governor John E. Baldacci and scores of other dignitaries, benefactors, and friends at the official dedication at our beautiful facility at 555 Forest Avenue. At our 11th Annual Auction and Gala in February, we presented 20 year volunteers Fred and Marilyn Durst with the inaugural *Bill Hemmen's Award*, named for our founder and given in recognition of the tremendous gifts of love and support that Fred and Marilyn bestowed upon The Center's children and families for the two decades this organization has been in existence. Our capital campaign co-chairs Mike Dubyak and Gary Robinson received the first *President's Award* in recognition of their commitment to and leadership for our very successful Making Room for Hope Campaign.

The Center not only has given out awards this past year, we also have received several tributes as well. Executive Director Anne Lynch traveled to New York City last spring where she was presented with the prestigious *a little hope foundation* National Advocacy Award in recognition of her advocacy efforts as a founding member and out-going President of the National Alliance for Grieving Children and for her visionary role in establishing The Center's *Multicultural Peer Support Program* to work with immigrant and refugee children re-located to Portland from areas in the world ravaged by war. Linda Kelly was honored by the *Maine Children's Alliance* with the 2007 Giraffe Award for her enduring passion and dedication to children in Maine in her role as The Center's Program Director. In October, long time volunteer Paul Attardo was presented with a coveted *6 Who Care Award* given by the United Way of Greater Portland, TD Banknorth and WCSH Channel 6 for the many services he has provided as Team Coordinator, facilitator and International Training Institute presenter, to children, teens and families at The Center and through a related program at the Long Creek Youth Development Center. All of us associated with The Center are proud to see the exemplary work of our staff and volunteers being honored by such respected organizations.

Amid these and many other causes for celebrations at The Center, we have seen an increase in the demand for support services from families wishing to attend one of our many bereavement or Tender Living Care groups, from drop-in visitors struggling to cope with an overwhelming situation, from telephone callers seeking advice on how to address an illness or death, and from community members requiring crisis support in their schools or workplaces. We have seen an increase in the number of families who not only need our services but who also require additional support beyond the scope of what The Center typically provides. Given the economic downturn, additional support services from other agencies have become more difficult for our families to access. Now more than ever it is important that we honor the commitment that we, our volunteers and our donors have undertaken to enable children, teens and families to attend The Center free of charge for as long as they need.

Love Really Counts, Hearts Really Matter

Volunteers are at the heart of our mission. Without their generosity and support we could not serve so many people in our community each year. This has always been true for The Center for Grieving Children and as we celebrate our 20th Anniversary it is heartening to look at the range of services that we provide for hundreds of people here in Maine and elsewhere.



Center Based Services

During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008 our volunteers provided **21,682** service hours including program delivery, capital campaign and special events assistance, office work, and board service. Last year we served more than **4,000** children, teens and adults through our mission and none of it would be possible without the generosity of our financial supporters or the tireless energy of our volunteers.

Last year our **Bereavement Peer Support Program** served **136** children, **66** adults and more than **101** families through weekly peer support groups. That was accomplished by **9,357** service hours being delivered by volunteers to those grieving the death of a family member or friend. Our new home at 555 Forest Avenue allowed us to bring on site our Bereaved Parent Support Group which had previously been administered in partnership with Maine Medical Center at the Dana Center.

Our **Tender Living Care Program*** which provides phone support and weekly peer support groups for children, teens and their families coping with a serious or life threatening illness served **116** children and **74** adults from **54** families utilizing more than **2,730** volunteer hours. *The TLC Program offers 8 week duration support groups, many families attend more than one eight week session - our numbers indicate repeating families for service hours.



Our **Multicultural Peer Support Program** continued to serve those children and their families who have relocated to Portland from war-torn countries having experienced multiple and/or traumatic loss. Last year we delivered services to **32** elementary and middle school pupils through more than **3,500** volunteer service hours.

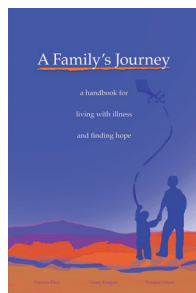
Community Based Services

For many people The Center for Grieving Children is the first place they call when loss or illness affects their families and loved ones. In addition to The Center based peer support programs we offer we also serve hundreds of families in person, on the telephone and via the web by providing consultations, program descriptions, support materials, referrals and direct phone support to children, teens and families, schools and other agencies.

Last year our **Bereavement Peer Support Program** handled **458** calls and provided **1,549** services to community members dealing with loss and grief.

Our **Tender Living Care Program** supported **145** calls and provided **543** services to those requesting information and support on dealing with a family member with a serious or life threatening illness.

Our new book **A Family's Journey** - a handbook for living with illness and finding hope, was distributed to more than **500** families throughout Maine, New England and beyond - a second printing of this book will enable us to reach even more families with this powerful resource. Thank you to the Maine Community Foundation Hospice Fund for their generous support for this book.



Our **Community Outreach and Education** program responded to **11** crisis requests and provided **49** presentations to families, schools, workplaces, agencies and other centers in addition we made responded to more than **275** calls for service and sent information or made presentations that reached more than **4,200** individuals in schools, workplaces and community settings.

Maine, New England and beyond

Our International Training Institute conducted its 6th Training Institute and throughout the year we provided training and support to establish one new center in Maine in partnership with the Maine State Suicide Prevention Task Force and one new center in New Hampshire. We also provided training for other community agencies from Maine, Nova Scotia, Alabama, Tennessee, Connecticut, Philadelphia, and Massachusetts.

The Center for Grieving Children provided Outreach and Professional Training to more than **50** schools and community agencies, including new and established grief support programs. **1,708** adults and more than **2,500** children were reached directly by our Community Outreach and Education Program that provides support during times of crisis in schools, workplaces and communities.

Our reputation over the last **20** years means that frequently we are called upon to consult and assist with organizations around the country. Last year our staff and volunteers participated in America's Camp and provided support and services to more than **275** children who attend the annual camp for those who lost a loved one in the events of 9/11 or lost a parent in the line of duty.

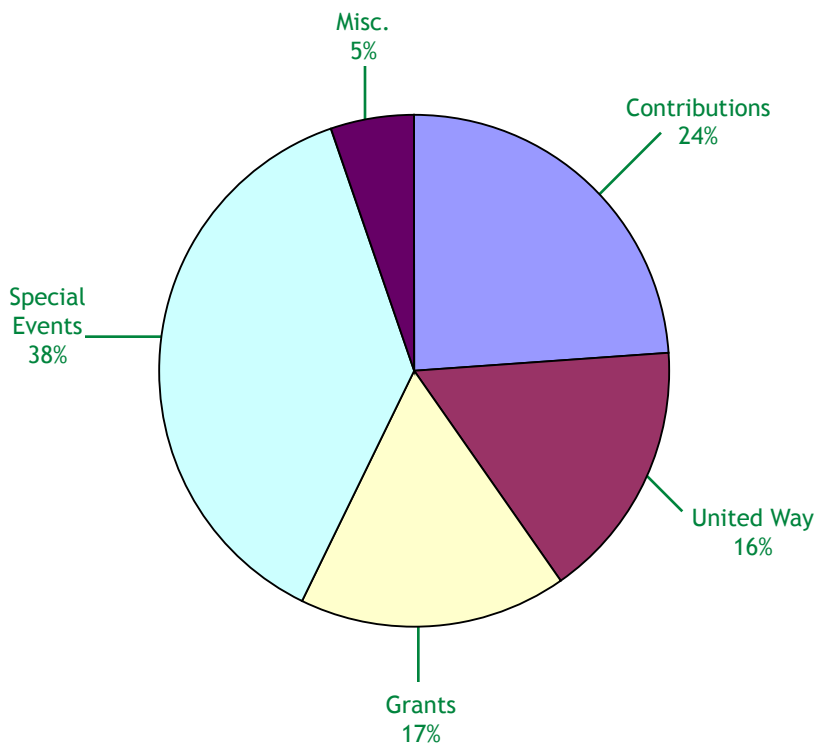

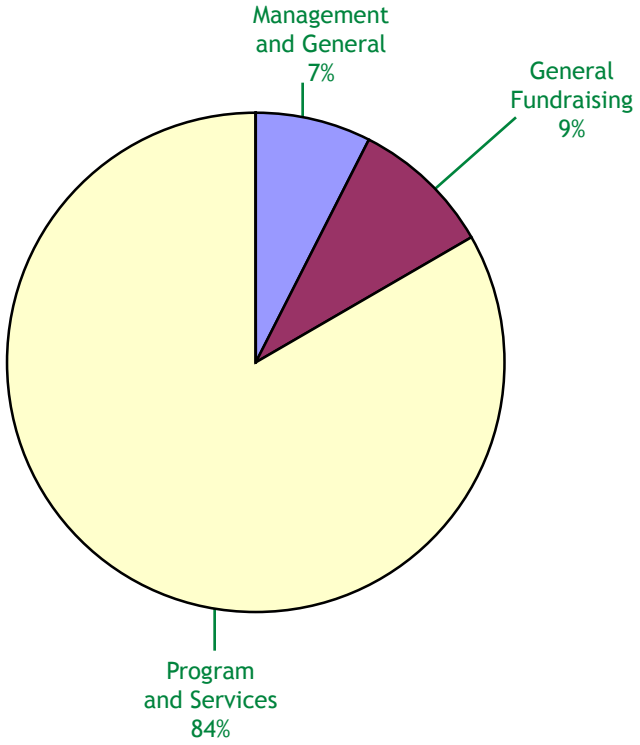
2007-2008 Financial Statistics

Erin & Korey Ryan have been attending The Center since their father, Kevin, died unexpectedly back in 2007. They have both made great friends at The Center and have been able to help other children through the grief journey. The following is a testimonial from their Mom, Kim.

After Kevin died The Center became the most important resource in my life I knew about The Center because I had heard people in the community talk about it and it had helped many families, but I was soon to find out just how amazing The Center really is!

Following Kevin's death, I found myself in completely unfamiliar territory - I had no idea what my kids needed. They were 8 and 11 - and their entire lives were turned upside down over night. It is not something you ever think you will experience, so you are truly flying blind. I knew I needed The Center's help. From the very first time I called The Center, the amazing staff and volunteers provided me with resources and guidance. They helped me to be prepared for what my children were experiencing, they actually helped me anticipate their needs. They provided resources to their schools and their counselors making sure that everyone was working together to support my kids.

Within weeks we began to attend a weekly support group. On our way home from our first meeting, I asked the kids what they thought - both of them said "we are not different here Mommy - it feels good not to be different." They look forward to Thursday nights - although I can't actually tell you what goes on in their groups (my kids take the confidentiality rule VERY seriously) I can tell you that it has turned tears into smiles and laughter! One of the special rooms at The Center is called "the volcano room" ... it is a special place where the kids can physically express their feelings in a safe way. It is always my kids favorite part of the night!

The Center also helped us create some wonderful new traditions for the holidays that have helped us keep their Dad a part of our lives - and we can truly celebrate him and keep his love alive.

It has now been a year since our loss - and we still go to The Center every Thursday night. The kids look forward to being "normal" for an hour.... and I look forward to the hour of connecting with other parents whose kids are going through similar situations. We share our experiences and help each other get through the tough times.

I really can't put into words what The Center has meant to my family - so I thought I would share with you an e-mail my 9 year old sent out to get sponsors for The Center's Annual Pet and People Walk. It was her first time participating - and she felt very strongly that she wanted to be able to give back to The Center because they have given so much to her. After hearing what she wrote, I think you will understand why she was the top fundraiser at The Pet Walk....

Hi! I am walking in the Pet Walk to honor my Dad. It is raising money for The Center for Grieving Children. Korey and I go there every Thursday night. I like going there because it is teaching me that I am not different - I am not the only one who has lost their Dad and that I can feel good even though I don't have a Dad. They make you feel complete again - even though you are missing someone important. They are teaching me that it is OK to be happy.

A Tribute to Bill Hemmens

Bill Hemmens (1945-1998) founded The Center back in 1988

When Bill Hemmens decided to found The Center for Grieving Children one of the first people he spoke to and enlist support from was The Reverend Jacob Watson. Here, Linda Kelly, Program Director and Jacob reflect on those early days and reflect on Bill and the challenges of The Center's early inception and long term success.

"Bill called me in the summer of '87 and asked to come over. I was in the garden reading *The Winds of War* and I distinctly remember thinking after Bill had enthused about the need to create The Center that it would be nice to put the war down and join with him on doing something positive for the community" reflected Jacob.

"Bill's dream had very little to do with anything about social work or counseling or even with grief and a lot more to do with wanting to have a place where kids like his young niece Erin, could go to express their feelings". Bill had recently lost his only sister Mary leaving him and his then 9 year old niece struggling to come to terms with the enormity of their individual losses.

Many people know that Bill changed his life to get The Center up and running, quitting his job and at one point borrowing against his life insurance to keep the doors open. Jacob agreed to design and implement the training program for volunteers - which despite being put together fairly quickly, has proved invaluable and prescient and forms the experiential nucleus of what is still used to train our volunteers today.

"The idea did more than strike a note in the community - it struck a chord. Bill worked on finding space and resources to get The Center up and running and in 1988 we opened our doors in borrowed space at Mercy Hospital to 4 families with 12 volunteers supporting them. - We never doubted the wisdom of the vision or the purpose of our mission - although we did struggle in those early days with the practical business of running The Center."

"It was clear that we were onto something - counseling can have impact - but the dynamics are one to one. With the peer support model you experience the expressive and supportive power of a group - which can be tremendously transforming - we were fortunate too that we were child driven not content driven. This allowed each child to forge their own journey through loss in their own way, on their own terms. True, this provided some challenges for some volunteers but this was the real value of what we were trying to do and still do today 20 years later."

A conversation with Gail Cinelli

Gail served as the Executive Director at The Center from 1990-2001

In the 1980's, Gail worked as a Hemophilia Nurse Coordinator at Maine Medical Center. She worked with families of boys and men who had hemophilia, which is a blood clotting disorder. Some of the patients who she worked with developed the AIDS virus from contaminated blood. When searching for support systems for these families in crisis, she met Jacob Watson and heard about The Center For Grieving Children.

Gail recalled the day that the AIDS quilt came to Portland for the first time. "I walked into the gymnasium at Chestnut Street Church, saw the quilt spread out on the floor, looked down to see the squares from those I knew and the grief in my heart set loose." A few months later, she resigned from her job to spend more time with her family and to learn to take care of herself. It came a time when Gail was ready to go back to work. She saw the ad in the Portland Press Herald for a Program Coordinator for The Center for Grieving Children. She said to herself, "I really want to volunteer there, but I need to work, and I've been a coordinator for the last five years...so I applied and was fortunate to be hired as the first paid staff person at The Center."

Gail describes The Center as being a place of open hearts, honoring children, providing a safe place to share feelings of grief and loss, and a safe place for children, their families and volunteers. She also noted that a participant in "the littles" said this very simply in a picture that she drew of a heart that said "love really counts." This says it all, love does count and when people walk through the doors at The Center, they feel that love.

The Center has both stayed the same and changed over the past twenty years. According to Gail, "the principals, values, and vision have remained a constant and The Center has changed with the growth opportunities and the growing needs of the community." Looking back, The Center certainly has a lot to celebrate in its twenty years of service. Looking forward, the question of what is next comes to mind.

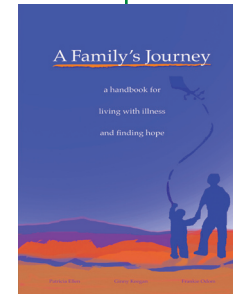
