## ORDINANCE NO. 357

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING BICYCLING, SKATEBOARDING AND SKATING AT THE DRAIN CIVIC CENTER AND GRANT LEVINS PAVILION, AMENDING THE DRAIN OFFENSES CODE (ORDINANCE #259), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF DRAIN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section One.</u> The Drain Offenses Code is amended to add Section 4.482, to provide as follows:

No person shall ride a bicycle or ride or use roller skates, roller blades or a skateboard, in any of the following locations:

- (1) on the access road to Grant Levins Pavilion or inside Grant Levins Pavilion;
- (2) on the access road to the Drain Civic Center, on the sidewalk around the Drain Civic Center, or on the entrances to or exits from the Drain Civic Center.

<u>Section Two.</u> The Drain Offenses Code Section 4.990 (6) is amended to add Section 4.482 to its list of penalties for violation of specific code sections.

<u>Section Three.</u> The matters contained herein concern the public welfare and safety and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
