



# *Fringeleaf Tickseed*

## *Coreopsis integrifolia*



Also known as the Chipola River Daisy, this plant has leaves that are uniquely heart-shaped, almost plastic-like in appearance. While it grows natively in brackish bogs, this plant will grow well in garden soils. An added bonus is that it is tolerant of heat and humidity, and will spread by its rhizome, though it is slow. This plant is endangered in part of its native habitat!

- Perennial
- Grows 3 feet
- Found in low woodlands, stream banks, floodplains
