



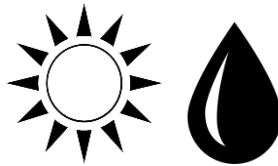
Dune Marsh-Elder

Iva imbricata



This plant provides for bank stabilization in coastal sandy areas. They are often pioneers in newly disturbed areas, allowing sand to build up. Individuals form a shrub and can tolerate drought once established. Flowers and fruit do not stand out, as both are green, blending in with the leaves.

- Perennial
- Grows 2-3 feet
- Found in beach dunes
