First stop will be the Henry Covered Bridge on our way into Bennington. Then we will visit the Park-McCullough House, an 1864 Victorian country house in the Second Empire Style. Built by Attorney Trenor Park, the House was designed by Hendry Dudley, who designed many Albany properties. Then we will visit the Robert Frost Stone House Museum at Bennington College.

For lunch we will visit the Publyck House



Restaurant for a three course Luncheon. Lunch choices are: Roast Turkey Dinner, Homemade Layered Meatloaf, Baked New England Cod or Pasta Primavera.

In the afternoon we will visit The Bennington Monument and the Old First Church. On our way home we will visit the Silk Road Covered Bridge.

The bus will depart from the lower lot at the Pruyn House at 8:30 am and return about 5:30 pm.
