More grads this year

There will be 2,383 students graduating from Concordia University this year—an increase of 49 students over the previous year.

Graduates will receive degrees and diplomas at six convocations from June 5 to 12, at which four prominent Canadians will receive honorary doctorates. Rev. Bernard Lonergan, regarded by

Rev. Bernard Lonergan, regarded by many as the finest philosophic mind of the 20th century, will return to his *alma mater* to receive an honorary doctorate at the Loyola Faculty of Arts & Science convocation June 5 at 2:15 p.m. on the Loyola Campus.

Rev. Lonergan, a Quebec native who now lives in the Jesuit Community at Boston College, became the focal point of world philosophical thought after the publication of his master work *Insight* in the late 1950s.

Norman McLaren, the celebrated Canadian filmmaker with the National Film Board, will receive an honorary doctorate at the Faculty of Fine Arts convocation June 7 at 8:15 p.m. at the Alumni Auditorium in the Henry F. Hall Building.

Guy Desbarats, prominent Canadian architect and assistant deputy minister of Public Works, will receive an honorary doctorate at the Faculty of Engineering convocation June 8 at 8:15 p.m. at the Alumni Auditorium.

Charles S. Carter, a retired Bell Canada executive who was instrumental in establishing the university's modular studies program, will receive an honorary doctorate at the Faculty of Science convocation June 9 at 8:15 p.m. at the Alumni Auditorium.

In numbers of graduates, the Loyola Faculty of Arts & Science registered the biggest gains, jumping from 601 students last year to 681 this year.

The next highest increase was in the Faculty of Commerce and Administration, which will graduate 671 students (an increase of 65) at the faculty convocation at Loyola Campus June 11 at 2:15 p.m.

Concordia twins graduate

Twenty-one years of close and constant twinship comes to an end this year as Patricia and Sharon Fitzgerald graduate with honours at the Loyola Arts & Science convocation June 5.

Inter-campus registration up this summer

Although statistics for Concordia's 1977 summer session are not yet available, the unofficial view is that enrolment has increased slightly over last year's summer session. No one is prepared to comment until the first set of official figures is released within the next few weeks.

The University's six faculties are all offering courses this summer with the majority available through arts an I scient faculties. Courses in Engineering, while open to all students, are offered primarily for the benefit of January entrants and evening BEng and BCompSc students. Offerings in Commerce have changed little from previous years. Fine Arts is offering a few new courses, the most innovative of which is a full course in Musical theatre being taught by Assistant Dean Gerry Gross. It will culminate in presentations of a mime show and of the musical The Apple Tree sometime this summer.

The 1977 Undergraduate Summer Calendar and Timetable is both the star and the scapegoat of the summer session. The bright, cheery looking book was prepared by the Calendar Office and is the firs' publication ever to list all undergraduate university summer courses.

Bruce Smart, Associate Registrar, believes that the book should receive much of the credit for the sharp increase in inter-campus registration. The Registration Office expected fewer than 200 students to take courses off their home campus, but "between 500 and 1000 students are switching campuses"

The pressing deadline against which the book was produced accounts for some of its deficiences. Several people have claimed that the calandar is difficult to follow and Smart admits that the registration segment, which was written by his office, is extremely confusing. He explained to FYI that when it was realized just how difficult the section was to follow, a pamphlet explaining registration in a simpler manner was prepared for bewildered students.

The time factor also accounted for the exclusion of summer graduate courses from the calendar. The resultant delay in publicizing Concordia's summer graduate offerings has Associate Dean of Arts Muriel Armstrong worried that low enrolment this summer will affect next year's graduate

Concordia to submit brief on Bill 1

A Concordia University brief to the legislative committee studying arguments on Bill 1, the controversial language charter, is at the point of completion.

It is understood that the university brief will call for greater latitude in the use of English in the education field and in other areas of Quebec life, than Bill 1 now envisions.

University authorities said that accompanying the brief will be a request that a university delegation be permitted to meet with the legislative committee studying arguments on the proposed charter for the French language.

Now they have come to the end of their close association. Is it frightening?


"A little," said Sharon. "Yes, it is," said Patricia. "But we are two personalities and it is time to let them grow."


slight increase from 158 graduates last year to 168 this year.

Computer Centre upgrades resources

The Concordia computer will be upgraded this summer, Ivan Fuchs, director of the Computer Centre, announced recently.

Delivery of the new dual CPU (Central Processing Unit) Cyber 172 in August will replace the older CDC (Control Data Corporation) 6400.

All this will be done within the existing Computer Centre budget, Fuchs said in a statement to users.

The present computer is a sound one, he said, but recent studies have shown it was short of memory and central processor resources.

"We expect the dual CPU Cyber 172 to provide a performance improvement 50 per cent greater than our present computer," said the statement.

Bernard Lonergan to receive degree

A world-famous Canadian Jesuit will return to his alma mater June 5 to receive an honorary degree.

The Rev. Dr. Bernard J.F. Lonergan, often regarded as the finest philoscriphic mind of the 20th Century, will receive the honorary doctorate of laws at the Loyola Campus.

The honorary doctorate of laws will be granted at th. Arts and Science convocation at 2:30 p.m. at Loyola.

Dr. Lonergan, whose book "Insight" reshaped Christian thought, now resides in the Jesuit community in Boston College, Chestnut Hill, Massachusetts.

In 1970, Newseek magazine said of his book:

"[It] has become a philosophic classic comparable to Hume's "Inquiry Into Human Understanding" and Lonergan's students have returned home to universities in Western Europe and the U.S. to spread his influence far beyond the confines of the Catholic Church."

Dr. Lonergan, 71, was born in Buckingham, Quebec, and went to Loyola High School and then to Loyola College. He received his B.A. at the University of London and his licentiate and doctorate of sacred theology at Gregorian University in Rome.

Since 1940, Dr. Lonergan has taught philosophy at Immaculée Conception, Montreal; Jesuit Seminary, Toronto; Gregorian University, Rome; Regis College, Toronto; Harvard University, Cambridge, Mass. and since 1975 has been the Visiting Distinguished Professor at Boston College.

Time magazine said in 1965:

"Lonergan is a lonely figure inside the Church and an ignored one outside it. The unfashionable Thomistic starting point of his vision repels non-Catholic thinkers grappling with the same issues; yet his unconventional revision of Aquinas outrages doctrinaire Thomists. He has steered clear of ecclesiastical controversy, except once to blister an Italian theologian whose criticism Lonergan believed made him out to be a heretic." Later when the Canadian hierarchy

asked his opinion of the Pope's birth control encyclical, Lonergan dismissed the anti-birth control argument noting that it rested on Aristotelian, not modern biology and hence was irrelevant.

Said Newsweek, in 1970:

"By insisting that all real human knowledge is 'self-appropriation' he reveals an unexpected kinship with Oriental paths to enlightenment. Yet like Anglo-Saxon empiricists, he demands validation for judgements and like the classical European metaphysicians, he insists that reality is ultimately intelligible."

Norman McLaren honored with degree

Distinguished Canadian filmmaker and animator Norman McLaren will receive an honorary degree at the Fine Arts convocation at the Sir George Williams Campus.

The honorary doctorate of laws will be granted at the June 7 convocation at 8:15 p.m. in the Alumni Auditorium in the Henry F. Hall Building.

Born in Scotland in 1914, Mr. McLaren began filmmaking while still at school. He made his first animated cartoon, "Camera Goes Whoopie," in 1935.

It was at this time that Mr. McLaren was discovered by John Grierson, who was later to leave England and join the Canadian National Film Board during World War II.

Mr. Grierson put Mr. McLaren on the staff of the British GPO (general Post Office) Film Unit in 1937 and by 1942 Mr. McLaren had completed over a dozen short documentaries and cartoons.

Mr McLaren joined Mr. Grierson at the National Film Board in 1941, where he worked on experimental animation in film.

After the war Mr. McLaren moved into evolving techniques of filmmaking, a prominent feature of which was his pattern of ignoring frame boundaries.

Mr. McLaren has made extensive use of pixillation (the animation of live images of actors and objects) as in the "Two bagatelles" (1952) and 'Neighbours" (1953).

Mr. McLaren's films include "Love on the Wing" (1937), "Dollar Dance" (1943), "Begone Dull Care" (1949), "Rhythmetic" (1956), "Mosaic" (1964) and "Pas de Deux" (1968).



Guy Desbarats to receive honorary degree

Guy Desbarats, noted Canadian architect and assistant deputy minister of Public Works, will receive an honorary degree at the engineering convocation at Sir George Williams Campus.

The honorary doctorate of laws will be granted at 8:15 p.m. at the June 8 convocation in the Alumni Auditorium of the Henry F. Hall Building.

Mr. Desbarats, assistant deputy minister for design and construction, was born in Montreal in 1925 and still maintains an office and home here.

He studied at Collège Ste-Marie, the parent of Concordia's Loyola Campus, and went to receive his degrees in architecture at McGill University.

From 1948-1952, he practised architecture with the firm of Abra, Balharrie & Shore in Ottawa. From 1953-1958, he taught architecture at McGill and helped establish the School of Architecture there.

During this period Mr. Desbarats and Raymond Affleck set up a firm with other architects, which was dissolved in 1970.

In 1964 he was named dean of the School of Architecture at l'Université de Montréal. He was later named president of La Société canadienne de l'information sur la construction.

Mr. Desbarats is a fellow of the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada and a member of the Order of Architects of Quebec. He is also the recipient of the medal of the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada.

Honorary degree goes to Charles Carter

Charles Carter, retired Bell Canada executive and instrumental in establishing an accelerated degree program at Concordia University, will receive an honorary degree at the university's science convocation on the Sir George Williams Campus.

The honorary doctorate of laws will be granted at the June 9 convocation held at 8:15 p.m. in the Alumni Auditorium of the Henry F. Hall Building.

Born in Quincy, Mass. in 1907, Mr. Carter received his secondary education in Boston high schools before receiving his Bachelor of Science from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1928.

After a year as a teaching assistant at M.I.T., Mr. Carter joined the statistical branch of the American Telephone and Telegraph Company.

After completing his training he accepted a statistician's job with Bell Canada.

By the mid-1930's Mr. Carter had completed a series of studies for Bell,

ranging from general economic forecasts to the performance of telephone equipment. In the latter half of the decade, he had initiated his own multiple correlation system in statistical analysis.

During World War II, Bell loaned Mr. Carter to the Canadian Government where he performed statistical work for the department of labor in the field of unemployment.

Before the war ended, Mr. Carter returned to Bell and became increasingly involved in financial statistics and in the introduction of equipment to handle statistical jobs.

In 1946, he became Bell Canada's statistician with a staff of 30. In 1955, his title changed to chief statistician and when he retired in 1972, his staff numbered 190.

Mr. Carter was instrumental in establishing the University's "modular degree program", enabling working students to combine full-time and part-time studies towards a degree without losing touch with their companies.

Senate Proceedings

Senate, just mustering a quorum, moved through last Friday's session with dispatch approving faculty replacements on the Board, the make-up of Senate's committee on 'colleges' and other senate committees including the committee on student appeals.

The new graduate diploma program in accountancy was approved with such speed that the Dean of Graduate Studies, Dr. French, managed to say that it was "a coup" for the university only after the Senate had already approved it. Such is the faith of the professional order of accountants in the University, and Senate's in Dr. French and his colleagues.

Professor Wheeler of Mathematics came to Senate to present his department's case for a new Bachelor of Teaching Mathematics program, the basic principles of which Senate approved, as an avant projet. Prof. Wheeler said that the program would help to establish Concordia Mathematics as a centre of excellence in Quebec's university system. Professor Charles Giguere expressed concern over the name of the of the bachelor's degree—BTM—and Professor Maurice Cohen explained that the designation was translated from the French.

Senate also approved this summer's summer session course offerings, but concern was expressed by one Senator that faculty groups had been rushed into making their summer plans months ago and it had taken till late May for these plans to reach the Senate floor. Professor Whitelaw said he couldn't expalin the delay in this instance but warned that summer sessions in future might have to be planned a year in advance.

Science courses, conducted and concluded during the last winter term, were approved by Senate Friday. Happily for the students enrolled in these courses because thay had already received their grades would have been worthless which otherwise. The retroactive approval was given after there had been some confusion over what 'slot' courses were all about-a course number attached to a general title in which specific courses may be offered. Professor Whitelaw who is chairman of the University Curriculum Coordinating Committee offered this example: "Zoology 490-'Advanced Topics in Taxidermy'. In a given year, the topic could be 'How to stuff birds' ". Professor Whitelaw explained that UCCC deliberations get pretty dull some-

times and a spot of humour was needed to keep eyelids propped up.

Senate approved the new member ship of the Board of Graduate Studies, of the Computer Science committee and the organization of computer science. Dean Berczi of Commerce, while agreeing with things for the time being, said he looks to a greater role played by Commerce in the near future to reflect their increasing responsibility in computer science.

Board Chairman Alex Duff sat in on Senate to emphasize the concern with which the Board viewed the names given to the senior academic officers of the new faculty structures in Arts and Science. Provosts once, but not four times, was what the Board had in mind and the board had asked Senate to reconsider naming the four top administrators 'provosts'. It would prefer the use of provost to designate the head of the 'college' development in the Faculty and 'divisional dean' to designate the heads of the three divisions. Much discussion was devoted to "selling" the new scheme to the public. If Concordia were really to be different, said Gervaise Bushe, the university shouldn't be frightened away from names that veered from traditional nomenclature.

Professor Whitelaw said that he'd like nice and simple names because it had taken him years to explain the meaning of his own title—Associate Vice Rector—let alone Concordia. And could Senate agree, Prof. Whitelaw asked, on how to pronounce 'provost'?

He urged the group to pronounce 'provost' so that the last syllable rhymed with [FYI'S word] lust as opposed to 'provost' like 'domo' which reminded him of muscular types who made life so miserable for him when he was in the army.

In the end, Senate settled upon one provost (pronounced the Whitelaw way) and three divisional deans which made Board Chairman Duff sufficiently happy to promise Senate that they wouldn't have any more trouble from the Board.

Senate also received the task force report on film in which it is recommended that the unversity investigate the possibility of purchasing a film processing unit, and buy other equipment for the use of students in programs on both campuses.

The report looked into the problems of coordinating Film and Cinema programs on two campuses. The report agreed that there is opportunity for cooperation and that courses should be crosslisted; students, it suggested, should require written permission of their department in order to enrol in courses in the other department; it should be made explicit in the calendar-that certain combinations of courses over the two programs in the Arts and Science and Fine Arts faculties cannot satisfy degree requirements. The report also urged the creation of an inter-faculty curriculum committee. One recommendation, one might think, would go without saying, but here it is: 2nd "we recommend that discussion and cooperation between professors in film production on both campuses continue and develop for the benefit of both programs."

Student Senator Kevin Quinn introduced the report on student eligibility for Senate membership. The key point that got people into a wrangle was that students needn't be in good academic standing to sit on the body. This had a lot of senators shaking their heads. Gervaise Bushe, another student senator, supported the report saying one didn't necessarily have to have a good academic record to make a good senator but Sean McEvenue said being a senator was one of the 'goodies' of student life and should be the preserve of students who were at least in good standing. The evening student representative, Janice Lowenstein, said one had to work pretty hard to fail at Concordia and that for her part she didn't want to be represented by one who worked so hard to represent such a tiny minority. McEvenue also said that a student senator who was just there to be a politician would make the whole business phony because Senate was an extension of a student's academic life. The one had to go with the other.

Professor Whitelaw wanted a one-year residence requirement reinstated but agreed that graduate students should be exempt since some were only around for one year and would miss the opportunity to serve as senators. Good standing was tacked onto the requirements in the end.

Library loan policy came up next. And so did Professor Cohen who pleaded with Head Librarian Filion to "leave the Science and Engineering library alone." After a lengthy exchange in which nothing was resolved, it was agreed that Senate would take library business up in the fall.

Senate decided to put off discussion on academic regulations till the fall and adjourned.
