Scope and Content:

The series contains the correspondence and subject files of the directors of the Carnegie Institution of Washington Department of Genetics. The material illustrates the development of a scientific research facility and modern organizational structure during the 20th century. The extensive and wide-ranging correspondence documents the professional and personal relationships the directors and their staff developed with their counterparts at the CIW Washington, D.C. headquarters, colleagues at other educational and scientific research institutions, philanthropists and benefactors, local governments, local residents, and trades people, and most significantly with BIAS Bio Lab and LIBA Bio Lab.

The subjects of the correspondence include: personnel practices and policies, employee benefits, physical plant and property changes, contributions to scientific knowledge (Drosophila Stock Center, Education Project, and Guide; cross-breeding in plants; mutations of bacteria), World War II research (penicillin and antibiotics, aerosols for treatment of respiratory injuries due to war gases), humanitarian efforts to assist foreign scientists during World War II, operations during the Great Depression years, participation in eugenics research, recruitment of scientific and non-scientific personnel, funding sources, scientific equipment and manufacturers, financial, legal and investment institutions, and U.S. government agencies and departments.

Materials include: address lists, applications, budgets, bibliographies, agendas, applications, architectural drawings, bank deposit receipts, biographies, booklets, brochures, cards, charts, clippings, contracts, computer punch cards, correspondence carbon and letterhead paper (typed and handwritten), course lists, curriculum vitae, festschrift, forms, galley proofs, applications, illustrations, invitations, invoices, leaflets, manuscripts, maps, memoranda, minutes, newsletters, notes, office file forms (cross-references, subject, and dates), pamphlets, permits, photographs, postcards, press releases, price lists, programs, publication lists, receipts, reports, reprints, speeches, student magazines syllabus, telegrams, transcripts, and vehicle registrations.
