Cutler Bay Plant List

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 3, Article VII of the Town of Cutler Bay's Land Development Regulations, as amended by Ordinance No. 22-10, the Town Manager, through the Community Development Department establishes the Cutler Bay Plant List. The list below details species of plants, separated by planting classification, which the Town has determined qualify as native species as well as species indigenous to Rockland Hammock and Pine Rockland habitats for purposes of compliance with the Town's Landscaping Regulations.

This document will be amended from time to time to provide additional information in accordance with the Code. Such additional information and/or regulations supplement the Land Development Regulations as provided by the adopted language of the Town Code.

For minimum plant sizes required by the Town of Cutler Bay, please refer to Section 3-103 of the Land Development Regulations for standard sizing requirements; however, any species-specific minimum planting requirements provided herein supersede standard plant sizes provided in that section.
