Are Kashmiris unfit for democracy? The Governor's refusal to allow

SKince Independence, Jammu Kashmir has led a troubled and contentious existence. Pakistan has never tired of making trouble here, start detach the State from India. It hardly needs recaling that hardcore Islamic groups in the Valley are aided and abetted by Islamabad to keep the State simmering These external provocations have been compounded by many internal errors of judgment or ham-handed actions fomenting popular discontent. Democracy, the cornerstone of India's political basis since 1952, has only fittully survived in a State riddled by myriad omplexities. For many decades after elections began in the rest of India, voers of Jammu \& Kashmir rarely got an opportunity to exercise their franchise as candidates' nomination papers were routinely rejected to ensure hand-picked nominees of Delhi were elected unopposed and presided over the State's des-
tiny. Also, Governments in Srinagar were periodically toppled on Delhi's orders tiny. Also, Governments in Srinagar were periodically
and puppet politicians installed as Chief Ministers.

Many rued the growing alienation of Kashmiris from the mainstream of Indian politics and society but the Centre, citing national security reasons, firmly kep the lid on. A combination of these factors along with the rise of Islamic radicalism in the 1980s saw the eruption of terrorism in the State in a big way after 1989. The Centre's iron-fisted response to this led to the forced migration of Kashmiri Pandits from the Valley. Rigged elections and frequent spells of direct Central rule removed the remaining safety valves and the gulf of mistrust between Delhi and Srinagar continued to widen, spurred by occasional excesses by security forces and frequent terrorist outrages. But instead of reaching out to the Kashmir people including politicians loyal to India, Delhi carried on playing a double game Only once at the initititive of then Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vaipayee was a sin cere attempt made to address the festering sores in a spirit of insanivat or humanity. But that too was short-lived and the State was pushed back into the dark abyss from which it had tried furtively to emerge.

Actions like what we witnessed late last Wednesday night are typical of the cavalier manner in which Jammu \& Kashmir has been handled by Delhi The appointment of a has-been politician with no experience of Kashmir affairs as the State's Governor was bad enough, especially after the enforced demise the BJP. ${ }^{2}$ Coalt al parties, National Conterence and PDP, to bury differences and form a nevelly Government amounted to a criminal error of judgment. To cover up the folly
the Governor has been compelled to fall back on the unconvincing plea of nation. the Governor has been compelled to tall back on the unconvincing plea of nation-

to changing political realities with alacrity. The premature dissolution of the Assembly is a flagrant violation of existing constitutional norms, clearly laic down after the SR Bommai judgment. It reinforces the impression that Jammu \& Kashmir cannot be allowed to have genuine democracy if the party ruling at the Centre is kept out of power. Both the State and the country as a whole must be ready to pay a heavy price for this chicanery thereby risking furthei alienation of the Kashmiri people.

The world grew more inter-connected and communities become more setted, irist pastoral and later urbanised, but our desire to explore not to mention gred led us to explore th not to mentinged led us to explore the habitats of inaccessible peoples in remote geographies usually at a terrible cost to those being 'discovered', who are sometimes dubiously referred to as 'primitive' and/or savage'. The latest example of this desire for exotica was manifest in the ill-advised journey of John Allen Chau, an American national, who ventured illegally into the highly restricted and protected North Sentinel Island of the Andamans and Nicobar group apparently motivated by a wish to establish contact with the Sentinelese tribe which inhabits it and has established a self-sustaining eco-system for itself bereft of any contact with the "modern" world. He paid for his misguided effort with his life as he was reportedly welcomed with bows and arrows, killed and ultimately buried in the sand on a beach. There is some talk of his being in touch with a preacher and being on a mission to proselytise. The issue Not only will the island's tribal inhabitants strongly resist any interference from modern humans as they have in the past, there is also the danger that any outside contact with them may cause an outbreak of diseases to which they have no immunity and might wipe them out. Even the flu bug can be fatal for he Sentinelese
Unfortunate as his death is, Chau should never have been anywhere near North Sentinel Island. He had no business bribing local fishermen to drop him off at the island at night, exposing not only himself but those who conveyed him there and the inhabitants of the island, to danger. Even since the 1960 s, any attempt to estabish and/or maintain contact with the Sentinelese has been met with fierce resistance. In 2006, a siminiar incident had taken place when two fishermen unknowingly strayed on to the island; they too were attacked and killed. The Sentinelese, perhaps even more than the Jarawas, are an insular tribal community and have been living their lives on their own terms for at least 60,000 years. Their isolated and sustainable way of Ife, hunting and gathering food from the pristine forests and shores of their island, has kept them going without any unsolicited help from outsiders. The very fact that they survived the tsunami of 2004 despite being directly in its path and rejecting any form of help from the Indian authorities is further proof that they are best left alone. As it is, the Sentinelese have been hovering on the brink of extinction. Though there is no confirmed head count, their population was estimated to be 40 in 2014. Any contact with the outside world herefore, means a threat to not only the inhabitants, but also to their fragile ecosys tem and survival. Memories of the atrocities on the vulnerable Jarawas when allegedly civilised human beings made contact with them are still fresh in our minds. The withdrawal of special tourist permits from Sentinel and other islands was erroneous as certain things are best left the way nature intends them to be.

The clock is ticking
Fighting pollution must be a concerted effort by every citizen. Otherwise, it shall remain a matter of academic and media discourse

around this time, we hear lot of noise about around this time, we hear lot of onise about smog and pol-
Ution. Suddenly the aura of Delhi gets diminished and is portrayed as one of the worst cities to tive in. Government agenties, doctios, environmentaists, NGOS, activists and a host of other players, including many foreign universities, suddenly get vocal and bring to the fore myriad of troubles that plague India's capital and her surrounding regions.

Yes, the probbems abound - and there is a funny repetihear or see much by way of action And who is to blame for hear or see much by way of action. And who is to blame tor
this? Many would like to put the onus on the Government. However, the fact is that this is a massive challenge and requires concerted and sustained intervention by each one of us. Else, it shall remain only a matter of academic and media discourse and will lead us into a smoke of perennially lingering threats.
This is why the Air Ouality Life Index (AQL) developed by the University of Chicago's Milton Friedman Protessor in Economics Michael Greenstone and his team at Energy Policy Institute (EPIC) calculates the effect of a ir quality on life expectancy. And according to this Index, each one of us living in Delhi could be sacificining 10 years of our ives to the apathy of the Government and other stakenolders. "The AQLL is an index that translates particulate air pollution into its inpact on life expectancy. In Delhi,
pollution concentration in 2016 averaged 113 microgram perc cubic metre Based on the research life expectancy would be bore than 10 years Songer for people of Dethi of the Wordd Heath Organisation (WHO) standards had been met," said Ken Lee, Executive Director of EPIC India. WHO prescribes the safe limit of annual mean PM 2.5 to 10 micrograms per cubic metre.

For India, the limit was raised to 40 micrograms per cubic with a diameter of less than 25 micrometres in in Delhi was 114 micrograms per cubic metre in 2016 , which is 1.6 times more than 70 micrograms per cubic metre in 1998, the study said. On November 22 morring, the PM2.5 levels were at an

filit and terrorism" The study pointed out that over the past two decades, the concentration of fine particulates increased by 69 per cent on an average across India, reducing the life expectancy of a typical Indian citizen by 4.3 years compared to 0.2 years in 1998. All this is scary. What have we done to ward off these present dangers?
