**Artist/Artwork Eligibility:** Artists are required to be currently enrolled part or full time students at San Joaquin Delta College <u>or</u> University of the Pacific. Artwork should present a visual expression of and reaction to issues of female empowerment, including but not limited to activism, education, pay equity, violence against women, sexual harassment, gender stereotyping, intersectionality, non traditional roles and women's leadership. Local, national and world perspectives, both historical and current, are all accepted.

**Artist Statements and Bios** Please provide a half-page artist statement and bio with the delivery of your artwork. **Artwork Presentation Requirements:** Flat artwork on paper and photographs must be matted and ready to hang (see school representative for further information). Framed artwork or on canvas must be wired for hanging. Artwork dimensions may not exceed 4ft. in any direction. Film and video works are not accepted. Maximum of 5 works submitted per artist.

#### Cash Awards: 1st Place \$200 / 2<sup>nd</sup> Place \$150 / 3<sup>rd</sup> Place \$100

Works for the art show and the awards will be selected by representatives from AAUW, SJDC and UOP, and will be based on originality, creativity, technical skill and relevance to the theme.
