$B D=$ Flower buds begin to appear on many plumeria.
FL = Flowering season begins.

1. This is only a rough guideline.

M any people are able to have flowers
on some plants as early as M arch.
2. Be cautious about bringing plants out of dormancy before the last frost. This may be as late as the end of $M$ arch in Texas, Louisiana, and Florida.
3. Beon the lookout for pests and disease ALL year. Infestations of spider mites have been found on dormant plants during winter storage in a garage.
4. The blooming season is dependent upon many factors. For example:
a. Variety of plant and age.
b. Soil mix.
c. Fertilization schedule.
d. Light intensity.
e. W inter storage methodology
