THIS MATTER comes before the Court on Plaintiff Freedom to Drive Inc.'s ("FTD") and Defendant Colorado Air Quality Control Commission's ("Commission") (collectively, the "Parties") Joint Motion to Hold Case in Abeyance ("Joint Motion").

The Court having considered the Joint Motion and any response thereto, hereby ORDERS that Parties' Motion is GRANTED.

This Court ORDERS this case be held in abeyance until such time as the matters identified in the Joint Motion as "federal litigation" are resolved.
