

Priorities Action Statement

Brown Treecreeper (eastern subspecies) (*Climacteris picumnus victoriae*)

Action Title	Priority
Conduct ecological research to determine habitat and resource requirements, threats and conservation issues.	3
Undertake surveys for threatened woodland birds in new and existing conservation reserves containing suitable habitat to assess the species' conservation status and identify key breeding and foraging habitat.	3
Identify key habitats or areas for protection and enhanced management through incentives.	1
Develop habitat identification, management and enhancement guidelines for woodland birds.	2
Implement sympathetic habitat management in conservation reserves, council reserves and crown reserves where the species occurs.	3
Increase understanding of woodland birds through promotion of the DEC website and other educational material.	2
Develop an Expression of Interest targeted towards private landowners to locate new sites and from this negotiate, develop and implement conservation management agreements for high priority sites.	2
