The My Little Paris workspace in an old carousel factory in Montmartre has a "dream room," vegetal wall, and rooftop terrace overlooking Sacré-Coeur. In a relaxed apartment on the edge of the Canal Saint Martin, an aquamarine wall complements a matching Smeg fridge and coffee mugs, all in the same vibrant, yet soft hue. Bird cages, vinyl records, colorful kimonos, vintage photographs, flashy African wax cushions, and contemporary art all coexist harmoniously.

More than forty spaces—each brimming with Parisian life—provide Instagram-ready inspiration for interior decoration, and are rich with ideas for sparking creativity.

My Little Paris (mylittleparis.com) is the source for the most unusual and interesting things to do in Paris, from single-table restaurants to clandestine poetry clubs. Their team of writers, creatives, scouts, photographers, developers, videographers, engineers, account managers, and an illustrator share one common goal: to surprise. They published My Little Paris: The Best Kept Parisian Secrets in 2011.


Combining foolproof growing tips for popular houseplants with thirty tutorials for home decoration, crafts, and natural health and beauty products, this book takes the green trend to the next level.




This is the first volume to trace the history of equestrian sports, including individual and team results across the sport's three official Olympic disciplines: dressage, eventing, and jumping.

This important reference documents the history of competitive horse-riding from 1912—when the sport first appeared at the modern Olympic Games in Stockholm—to the present. It brings together for equestrian enthusiasts a complete document of all the results of competitions since 1912, including the Olympics, the European Championships, and the FEI World Equestrian Games. The volume is organized by decade, with both individual and team achievements listed, across the sport's three official disciplines: show jumping, dressage, and eventing. Featuring groundbreaking riders such as Bill Steinkraus, Charlotte Dujardin, and Kevin Staut, and exciting events in the history of the sport, this volume recounts the history of equestrian excellence through fascinating stories and record-breaking events.

This entirely original book is the first of its kind, and is replete with previously unpublished information about the sport, riveting stories, archival photographs and text, key facts and figures, and memorable anecdotes. Portraits of riders—both male and female—and some of the sport's most remarkable horses complete the volume, which acts as a key and original point of reference and an essential addition to the collection of any equestrian lover.

Marie de Pellegars is a horse-rider and journalist, and has worked in the field of equestrian reporting, most notably for *Grand Prix Magazine*. Benoît Capdebarthes is a rider and riding instructor, and is passionate about the history of equestrian sports. This volume is being published in partnership with the International Equestrian Federation.







Francis Hammond's photographs have been published in numerous titles with Flammarion including A Day with Claude Monet in Giverny (2017), A Parisian Cabainet of Curiosities: Deyrolle (2017), Private Houses of France (2014), and Versailles: A Private Invitation (2011/2018).





The Art of the Garden

Château de Chaumont-sur-Loire

This in-depth presentation of the art of the garden from historical styles to contemporary materials—is an essential reference for garden aficionados.

All of the major world gardening traditions—Japanese, Chinese, Korean, English, and French—converge with the most contemporary garden designs across eighty acres at the Domaine de Château de Chaumont-sur-Loire. The historic grounds—once strolled by Catherine de' Médicis—were conceived for splendor in every season and to offer striking vistas from every turn. The chateau's permanent gardens feature exquisite examples of traditional and contemporary design, and draw upon the five senses—light and shade, sound, fragrance, taste, and texture.

Once a preferred retreat for kings and members of the nobility, the fifteenth-century UNESCO World Heritage site has been lauded for its exquisite gardens for centuries and, since 1992, Chaumont has hosted the prestigious International Garden Festival. The annual festival features exhibitions devoted to landscape art and to advances in science, technology, and artistic gardening techniques that blend poetry and inventiveness. Installations by artists such as Andy Goldsworthy, Jannis Kounellis, and Sheila Hicks are interspersed with floral plantings in monochrome or gradated hues, vegetable and herb plots, or mirror gardens featuring water elements. A world-class center for botanical arts and heritage, the Domaine and its château provide a wealth of inspiration for the home and professional gardener alike.

For the past decade, Chantal Colleu-Dumond has served as director of the Domaine de Chaumont-sur-Loire. She published Talk About Contemporary Gardens (Flammarion, 2013). Eric Sander's photographs have been published in Smithsonian, Time, Life, Newsweek, and in numerous books including French Château Living, The Architecture of Diplomacy, Jacques Garcia: Twenty Years of Passion, and A Day at Château de Fontainebleau.





Consecrating Cartier's new collection of high jewelry and precious objects, this volume, with its one hundred original and innovative pieces, is a celebration of an integral aspect of the iconic brand: color. Brimming both with striking contrasts and more delicate tones, the jeweler's palette positions itself in the midst of an intimate conversation between the art world and reality in all of its cultural diversity, thus allowing for the jeweler to expand his or her creative horizons unhindered. Through the exploration of continents and seasons, the juxtaposition of tradition with modernity, and the play on connotations associated both with stones and other more noble materials, Cartier continues to follow in the footsteps paved by its founding brothers, and to create breathtaking and unique pieces.

All the world revels in color; and since high jewelry and the notion of celebration are inextricably linked, Cartier's collection, with its astonishing rainbow-like palette, as immortalized in this volume, provides us with a new ode to joy, an ode to life in all its glory.

Writer **François Chaille** is passionate about art history, fashion and jewelry, and horology. Throughout his career he has published some fifteen works with Flammarion, with notable examples including *The Book of Ties* (1994), *Cartier Creative Writing* (2000), *Girard Perregaux* (2005), *Audemars Piguet: Master Watchmaker Since* 1875 (2011), and *The Beauty of Time* (2018).





Hubert Le Gall: Fabula

A major monograph dedicated to contemporary French designer, sculptor, and painter Hubert Le Gall.

French artist Hubert Le Gall's work defies classification by genre or artistic movement—he seamlessly blends sculpture with design in a unique style born out of his singular imagination. Over the past twenty years, Le Gall gained international renown through numerous exhibitions and is featured in galleries around the world, from London to Shanghai and from New York to Beirut.

This monograph is a curation of the artist's work by Pamela Mullin, who, over many years, has become one of his most devoted collectors. Their relationship is grounded in the juncture where their common interests and different perspectives as artist and collector combine. Their shared passion for joyful and cultivated yet offbeat creations is evident in this selection of Le Gall's key creations, most of which were photographed in situ at Mullin's seventeenthcentury manor in Saint-Calais, Normandy. These works demonstrate Le Gall's exceptional craftsmanship in his use of noble materials such as bronze, the simultaneously naturalistic and sculptural style of their lines, and their references to art and decorative art history. From the commanding trumeau, created especially for Mullin, to the many decorative gueridon tables, chandeliers, "flower tables," sculptural vases, screens, and other commodes, each one of his creations is at home within the world of the French Classical-style estate. They evoke Le Gall's numerous sources of inspiration, which include the perfection of Pompeian relics, the sophistication of eighteenth-century furnishings, the imaginative freedom of the Art Nouveau movement, but also Pop Art, culminating in pieces that are firmly rooted in the present.

Hubert Le Gall is a contemporary French sculptor and furniture designer; his work is exhibited in galleries around the world.

Pascaline Noack, photographer, has covered the Comédie Française and the Opéra de Paris and contributed to works on decorative arts and gardens. Patt Morrison is a columnist for the Los Angeles Times, and a multi-award winning fiction and non-fiction author, journalist, and radio-television presenter based in California.

Dany Sautot, author and curator specialized in decorative arts and the history of landscapes and gardens, has published several exhibition catalogues, including Baccarat, René Lalique, and 1925.

Art in Cuba Today

A panoramic exploration of Cuba's most extraordinary art world, including exclusive interviews with thirty-five of the island's most influential artists and photography by Camilo Guevara.

Retracing the vibrant history of Cuban art from 1900 onwards, this book provides an overview of Cuban cultural and artistic development across a number of mediums, including painting, drawing, sculpture, installations, and the visual arts. Together, long-time friends and authors Gilbert Brownstone and Camilo Guevara visited and interviewed Cuba's thirty-five most important and internationally acclaimed artists, who talk openly about their education, influences, and the role of art in Cuba.

Art has always been at the heart of the Cuban cultural identity, and the island is home to major artists across the spectrum of artistic disciplines. Yet while culture thrived both in the provinces and in Havana throughout the twentieth century, it was with the advent of the revolution and rise of Fidel Castro that free education and widespread access to the arts became top priorities, giving the underprivileged access to the artistic realm that had once been a domain of the elite.

Both an invitation into the world of the dynamic Caribbean island and an overview of the Cuban artistic heritage, this book is not to be missed by anyone with an interest in contemporary art and culture.

Gilbert Brownstone is an art historian and exhibition curator. In 1999 he created the Brownstone foundation, which promotes social justice through cultural development. Graziella Pogolotti is a historian and Cuban art critic. Camilo Guevara, photographer, teaches at the Havana School of Photography and runs the Che Guevara Studies Center, dedicated to his father.

Master of Imagination



The diverse oeuvre of Gustave Doré—illustrations, paintings, sculpture—combines with biography and critical essays and attests to the artist's enduring impact on contemporary culture.

Proclaimed "the most illustrious of illustrators," Gustave Doré is best known for his engravings, which appeared in editions of the Bible, Danté's Inferno, Poe's The Raven, Don Quixote, and even in Hollywood films, from King Kong to Seven. Yet the extent of his genius remains largely unknown. Here, along with his renowned illustrations, his paintings and sculptures are also examined, bringing to light the rich diversity of his talent.


Doré was master of all media. His work transcended techniques and eras, covering an inexhaustible range of subjects from Europe to the United States to Russia.

Philippe Kaenel is a professor of teaching and research at Lausanne University, and a specialist in the illustration genre and in the works of Gustave Doré. Paul Lang and Edouard Papet are head curators at the Musée des Beaux-Arts in Canada and at the Musée d'Orsay respectively. Côme Fabre was commissioner of the exhibition "L'Ange du bizarre" at the Musée d'Orsay in 2013.
