To the Commission:

Enclosed find materials relating to a series of radio commercials broadcast in New Hampshire on behalf of Louis Wyman's Senate candidacy. I am apprising you of this because of your role in assuring fair elections and in particular your role in monitoring campaign fundraising.

Acting on advice of counsel, we have requested that radio stations not air three commercials prepared for Mr. Wyman because they are falacious, malicious and libelous. We have warned them that with knowledge of the falsity of the material they become liable with the author for their use. Supporting documentation refuting the claims was sent to each radio station for their own protection.

In the "Fair Campaign Practices Pledge" signed by both Mr. Wyman and myself, we each promised to "condemn the use of campaign material of any sort which misrepresents, distorts or otherwise falsifies the facts regarding any candidate" and to "condemn the use of personal vilification...libel, slander or scurrilous attacks on any candidate. I have appealed to Mr. Wyamn to uphold his oath.

I would hope that after evaluating the enclosed material, you would feel able to advise Mr. Wyman that his practices have been unethical and the material should be voluntarily withdrawn.

Dear Mr. Wyman:

As you know, we are legal counsel for John Durkin. You have today started to publish over the radio stations of New Hampshire three political advertisements, all of which are false. The most cursory investigation on the part of yourself or your staff would have disclosed their falsity. They are malicious. We call upon you to cease publication immediately.

One ad recites that John Durkin has received contributions from the Machinists International, the Steel Workers from Pittsburgh, the United Auto Workers from Detroit, the Garment Workers from New York, and the Railway Workers.

This list is immediately followed by the following statement:

"There were a lot of donors to John Durkin whose names were never made public because John Durkin found a loophole in the campaign disclosure law and he exploited it."

This quoted statement could have no reference to anything other than the recitation of the labor unions whose contributions were previously referred to. They are the only contribution referred to in your ad. All of these contributions were required to be reported by the Disclosure of Federal Campaign Funds Statute (2 U.S.C. Sections 431-442), and were so reported. As required by Federal Law, copies of the Federal report were filed with the Secretary of State of the State of New Hampshire. Further, any contributions received during the reporting period covered by

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state law were also reported under the state statutes (RSA Ch.70). There is no loophole involved, and there has been no exploitation by Mr. Durkin. The Federal (#1) and State (#2) reports are attached.

A second ad is also false. In that ad, you refer to three fund raising events during the year 1974. One, a testimonial on June 13 at the Chateau in Manchester. A second on October 6 at the Sheraton-Wayfarer in Bedford, and a third at the home of Jack Dunfey in Rye. Since all of these fund raisers were held prior to the November 1974 election, all of the funds raised and the identity of all persons who made contributions were reported to the Secretary of State, as required by the state law. We enclose herewith a copy of the reports filed by Mr. Durkin with the persons who made contributions at these fund raisers identified thereon by handwritten notation.\*

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This second ad also refers to a party in New York City given by Presidential Candidate Mo Udall. There was no such party. There was a reception in New York City in January of this year at a private home, at which Mr. Durkin and Mo Udall were in attendance. It was not regarded as a Durkin fund raiser like the others noted herein. As required by Federal law, all contributions of over \$100 received in the weeks following were itemized in the report, and a copy of the report is attached hereto. (Exhibit 6) Furthermore, all contributions of \$25.00 or more were reported to Common Cause, above and beyond what is required by State and Federal law, and these reports have been available to you at any time you wished to see them. (Exhibit 6a)

In this second ad, you also refer to a Salute to John Durkin at Yoken's Restaurant in Portsmouth. This was held March 29, 1975, and was also reported, as required by Federal law (Exhibit 7), and reported to Common Cause, as in the case of the New York reception in January. Copies of the reports are attached. (Exhibit 6a)

For all these reasons, the following statement contained in your advertisement was completely false. You said,

"More than \$13,000 was raised at these fund raisers and not one single name, from a single donor, has been reported by Durkin."

\*"Wayfarer" for the October 6 fund raiser (Exhibit 3)

"C" for the June 13 fund raiser (Exhibits 4A & B)

"Rye" for the fund raiser at Dunfey's home (Exhibit 5).

Like the first advertisement, this advertisement is completely false, and we call upon you to cease publication immediately.

A third advertisement is equally obnoxious and false. Here you do not even refer to any specific fund raisers, and you simply say in referring to Mr. Durkin,

"So he gave a testimonial, a cocktail party, and reception, raised \$10,000, made no disclosure of donors' names, because Durkin found a loophole in the law and he used it."

The only fund raisers you could possibly have in mind were those recited above. You identified the three held in 1974 as a "testimonial", a "cocktail party", and a "reception".

We say again that all contributions received at any fund raisers were reported. There was no loophole, and Mr. Durkin went beyond the law in all instances, and reported his receipts to Common Cause where they are available for the public.

If you claim you did not have actual knowledge of the falsity of your statements in these political advertisements, you have it now, and we call upon you to cease publication forthwith. If you claim that you need additional evidence concerning John Durkin's campaign contributions, we invite you to his headquarters at the Carpenter Hotel, where everyday Mr. Durkin posts on the door all contributions received and deposited in his campaign accounts the previous day.

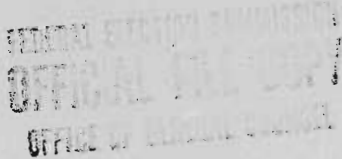


