III. BACKGROUND:

Failure to File Forty-Eight Hour Notifications

The Coloradans for Considine ("the Committee") has failed to file 79 of 168 or 47% of the required Forty-Eight Hour Notifications ("48-Hour Notices") for contributions totalling \$124,491.12 received prior to the 1992 General Election.

The candidate was involved in the 1992 General Election held on November 3, 1992. Prior Notice was sent to the Committee on September 28, 1992 (Attachment 2). The Notice includes a section titled "48 Hour Notices on Contributions". This section reads "Notices are required if the committee receives contributions (including contributions and loans from the candidate's personal funds; and endorsements or guarantees of bank loans) of \$1,000 or more, during the period of October 15 through October 31. The notices must reach the appropriate federal and state filing offices within 48 hours of the committee's receipt of the contribution(s)."

Schedule A of the 30 Day Post-General Report indicates that the Committee failed to file seventy-nine (79) 48-Hour Notices for contributions received during the aforementioned period (Attachment 3). The following is a list of the contributions for which no 48-Hour Notices were filed:

On January 13, 1993, a Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") was sent to the Committee (Attachment 4). The RFAI notes on an informational basis that the Committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48-Hour Notices for "last minute" contributions of \$1,000 or more. The notice requests the Committee to review their procedures for checking contributions received during the aforementioned time period. In addition, the notice states that although the Commission may take legal steps, any response would be taken into consideration.

On February 25, 1993, the Committee responded by letter (Attachment 5). The letter notes that the Committee believes that all 48-hour notices were provided and apologizes if any were inadvertently missed.

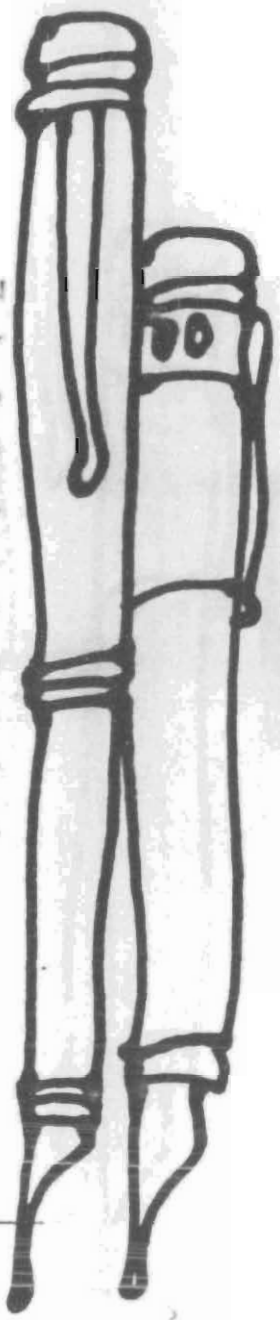

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

An individual or a political committee other than a qualified multi-candidate committee may not make a contribution to a candidate for federal office in excess of \$1,000 per election. The term "contribution" includes any gift, subscription, loan, advance, or deposit of money or anything of value made by any person for the purpose of influencing any election for federal office. (2 U.S.C. §441a(a) and (f); 11 CFR §110.1(b), (e) and (k))

Please note that contributions designated in writing by the contributor for a particular election must be attributed to that election. Contributions not designated in writing by the contributor will be considered made for the next election for that Federal Office (general) (11 CFR §110.1(b)(2)(i) and (ii)).

Any contribution drawn on a joint checking account will be considered made by both individuals only if the check is signed by both or is accompanied by a written document noting the amount attributable to each individual and is signed by each individual. (11 CFR §110.1(k)(1) and (2))

If the contribution(s) in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you should amend your original report with the clarifying information. If the contribution(s) you received exceeds the limits, you

These contributions are then reported on the next report required to be filed by the committee. On January 13, 1994, the Federal Election Commission found that there is reason to believe Coloradans for Considine, Inc. ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The Factual and Legal Analysis, which formed a basis for the Commission's finding, is attached for your information.

You may submit any factual or legal materials that you believe are relevant to the Commission's consideration of this matter. Please submit such materials to the General Counsel's Office within 15 days of your receipt of this letter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath. In the absence of additional information, the Commission may find probable cause to believe that a violation has occurred and proceed with conciliation.

In order to expedite the resolution of this matter, the Commission has also decided to offer to enter into negotiations directed towards reaching a conciliation agreement in settlement of this matter prior to a finding of probable cause to believe. Enclosed is a conciliation agreement that the Commission has approved.

If you are interested in expediting the resolution of this matter by pursuing preprobable cause conciliation and if you agree with the provisions of the enclosed agreement, please sign and return the agreement, along with the civil penalty, to the Commission. In light of the fact that conciliation negotiations, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, are limited to a maximum of 30 days, you should respond to this notification as soon as possible.

Requests for extensions of time will not be routinely granted. Requests must be made in writing at least five days prior to the due date of the response and specific good cause must be demonstrated. In addition, the Office of the General Counsel ordinarily will not give extensions beyond 20 days.

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

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify in writing either the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. Id. The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

The General Election in the state of Colorado was held on November 3, 1992. Pursuant to the Act, the Respondents

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were required to notify the Commission, in writing, of all contributions of \$1,000 or more received from October 15 through October 31, 1992, within 48 hours of their receipt. A review of the Committee's 1992 30 Day Post-General Report identified 79 contributions received between October 15 and October 31, 1992, of \$1,000 or more totaling \$124,491.12. The Committee did not submit 48 Hour Notices for these contributions. A list of these contributions is attached.

Therefore, there is reason to believe that Coloradans for Considine, Inc., and Marjory B. Saunders, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A) by failing to report campaign contributions of \$1,000 or more, received after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before the general election, within 48 hours of receipt of the contributions.

Dear Mr. McDonald,

Upon receipt of your letter, I immediately proceeded to review and search through all the campaign committee files in storage, with regards to the computer printouts, computer contribution input batches, faxed 48-hour notice reports, verification of faxed copies from Washington, bank campaign deposit slips and other reports submitted during the last month of the 1992 Senate Election. Because it was always our intention to follow all the rules and regulations, I was completely surprised to find that we had actually omitted these contributions from our 48-hour reports. I then set about finding out how this could have happened and was able to find the reason for all errors which the remainder of this letter and the attached documentation will address.

I have categorized and sorted the list of contributors omitted from our 48-hour notice reports by date, amount and type of error. After a thorough analysis and frequent communication with the campaign staff, I was able to find the actual reasons for 100% of the listed contributors being omitted from our faxed 48-hour notice reports.

The enclosed documentation highlights the error reason for each contribution not reported on our faxed 48-hour notice reports in summary form, and in detailed analysis from each day showing contributors name and amount which was unknowingly omitted. As you review the enclosed summary and detailed analysis of errors of omission, we sincerely hope you fully understand that at no time did we willingly or knowingly attempt to hide or delay the contributor's names or amounts from the Federal Election Commission. I would also like to point out that during the campaign all of our reports were filed in a timely and accurate basis.

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Mr. Danny L. McDonald

I agree that all the omitted contributions listed are valid and I take full responsibility for the error occurrence under my "watch". I have willingly and enthusiastically volunteered my time and efforts to this Senate Campaign as Treasurer because I believe in the election process. I am not now and was not then a paid employee and although I am well trained in accounting, I was totally new to election procedures and had a lot to learn.

Our campaign staff was using a new computer software system that experienced numerous and sporadic problems. In retrospect we now find that these two computer software program logic errors went unnoticed; the reports were printed but the command function logic for --greater than or equal to-- in respect to both the amount and the date did not always function properly. If the computer related logic problems had not occurred, 80% of the total amount would not have been omitted on our faxed 48-hour notice reports. Approximately 17% of the errors were due to my misinterpretation of the 48-hour period prior to election rule, and the remaining 3% due to clerical errors unknowingly made.

It is my sincere hope that you and/or the commission can appreciate that the omitted contributors were not intentional nor knowingly made by me or anyone on our campaign staff. I sincerely regret that we did not catch the errors at the time of reporting.

If you have any questions, please advise. Thank you for your consideration of this matter.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

On January 13, 1994, the Commission found reason to believe that Coloradans for Considine, Inc., and Marjory B. Saunders, as treasurer, ("Committee" or "Respondents") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A) for failure to file 79 of 168 48 Hour notifications ("48 Hour Notices") for contributions totaling \$124,491.12 during the 1992 general election for the U.S. Senate.¹ On that same date, the Commission approved a conciliation agreement calling for a civil penalty

II. ANALYSIS

The Committee responded promptly to the Commission's

1. Terry Considine lost the general election with 45% of the

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reason to believe finding and indicated that the failure to file 48 Hour Notices was due primarily to a problem with its new computer software. Attachment 1. The Treasurer, who was experienced in accounting but new to campaign finance, explained that "[i]n retrospect we now find that these two computer software program logic errors went unnoticed; the reports were printed but the command function logic for --greater than or equal to-- in respect to both the amount and the date did not always function properly." Attachment 1 at 2. Thus, the computer did not select contributions greater than \$1,000 and greater than October 26, 1992. As a consequence, the Committee did not file 48 Hour Notices for contributions over \$1,000 on October 15, 16, 19, 21, 13, and 26. Attachment 1 at 4. It also did not file 48 Hour Notices for contributions on October 28, 1992 because of a problem with the date logic. Attachment 1 at 6. In a telephone conversation with staff of this Office, the Treasurer indicated that the Committee experienced a variety of difficulties with its software and that the Committee had made service calls several times to have various problems fixed. Because the software had been serviced, the Committee thought that the system was fully and dependably operational. The Committee's explanation of computer software problems is in accord with this Office's independent analysis of the pattern of missing 48 Hour Notices.

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In addition to the computer-caused problems, the Committee failed to file 48 Hour Notices for several other reasons. The Treasurer states that she made a mistake in not counting the weekend as reporting days. She explained that she is accustomed to business practices where Saturday and Sunday do not count as business days. Her explanation credibly explains the Committee's failure to file on October 30, 1992. Attachment 1 at 7. One other missing notice is attributed to clerical error: a contribution of \$1,000 was deposited as "\$100;" the bank corrected the amount; and then the Committee changed its account books but inadvertently failed to file a 48 Hour Notice. Attachment 1 at 8-9. Finally, the Committee failed to report two contributions from principal campaign committees because the computer was not programmed to identify such committees; as a result, the contributions were entered by hand and "omitted unknowingly from the 48 Hour Notice reports." Attachment 1 at 5.

This Office is satisfied that the Committee's failure to file 48 Hour Notices was not knowing and wilfull and that the Committee has taken remedial steps to insure that the errors do not recur.



2. Approve the appropriate letter, as recommended in the General Counsel's Report dated April 1, 1994.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter was initiated by the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities. The Commission found reason to believe that Coloradans for Considine, Inc., and Marjory B. Saunders, as treasurer ("Respondents"), violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and the Respondents, having participated in informal methods of conciliation, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe, do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondents and the subject matter of this proceeding, and this agreement has the effect of an agreement entered pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(A)(i).

II. Respondents have had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondents enter voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

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IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

1. Coloradans for Considine, Inc. is a political committee within the meaning of 2 U.S.C. § 431(4), and is the authorized principal campaign committee for Terrence M. Considine's senate campaign.

2. Marjory B. Saunders is the treasurer of Coloradans for Considine, Inc.

3. The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"), requires principal campaign committees of candidates for federal office to notify in writing either the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the U.S. House of Representatives or the Commission, as appropriate, and the Secretary of State, of each contribution totaling \$1,000 or more, received by any authorized committee of the candidate after the 20th day but more than 48 hours before any election. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A). The Act further requires notification to be made within 48 hours after the receipt of the contribution and to include the name of the candidate and office sought, the date of receipt, the amount of the contribution, and the identification of the contributor. Id. The notification of these contributions shall be in addition to all other reporting requirements. 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(B).

4. During the period of October 15 through October 31, 1992, among the contributions that the Respondents received were 79 contributions of \$1,000 or more

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totaling \$124,491.12. Respondents did not submit 48 Hour Notices for these contributions.

V. The Respondents failed to report campaign contributions of \$1,000 or more received after the 20th day, but more than 48 hours before the general election, within 48 hours of receipt of the contributions, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(6)(A).

VI. Respondents will pay a civil penalty to the Federal Election Commission in the amount of Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000), pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(A). The civil penalty will be paid as follows: \$6,000 at the time of submission of this agreement, and then in four equal installments of \$2,500 due on or before the last business day of each of the months of April, May, June, and July 1994.

VII. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

VIII. This agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

IX. This Conciliation Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties on the matters raised herein, and no other statement, promise, or agreement, either written

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or oral, made by either party or by agents of either party, that is not contained in this written agreement shall be enforceable.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S QUARTERLY REPORT

I. INTRODUCTION

This report is the second Enforcement Priority System Quarterly Report. The purpose of this Quarterly Report is to recommend that the Commission no longer pursue the identified lower priority and stale cases.

II. CASES RECOMMENDED FOR CLOSING

A. Cases Not Warranting Further Pursuit Relative to Other Cases Pending Before the Commission

A critical component of the Priority System is identifying those pending cases that do not warrant the further expenditure of resources. Each incoming matter is evaluated using Commission approved criteria

By closing such cases the Commission is able to use its limited resources to focus on more important cases.

Having evaluated incoming matters, this Office has identified 16 cases which do not warrant further pursuit relative to the other pending cases.¹ A short

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description of each case and the factors leading to assignment of a relatively low priority and consequent recommendation not to pursue each case is attached to this report. See Attachments 1-16. For the Commission's convenience, the narratives for externally-generated matters are immediately followed by the complaint and response(s) and the narratives for internally-generated matters are immediately followed by the referral.

B. Stale Cases

Investigations are severely impeded and require relatively more resources when the activity and evidence are old.

Consequently, the Office of General Counsel recommends that the Commission focus its efforts on cases involving more recent activity. Such efforts will also generate more impact on the current electoral process and are a more efficient allocation of our limited resources. To this end, this Office has identified 42 cases that

do not warrant further investment of significant Commission resources.² Since the recommendation not to pursue the identified cases is based on staleness, this Office has not prepared separate


