
Save the Date

Recent Events: March

On March 29th, we were pleased to host our new sponsor, Aon Reed Stenhouse, in their first presentation to our Chapter. Aon is a leading global provider of risk management services, insurance and reinsurance brokerage, and human capital consulting. While it would certainly be easy to expect a presentation about insurance from and insurance provider, AON demonstrated that they are about much more than that with their presentation.

Most entertaining was a dramatic video demonstrating disaster preparedness gone wrong. This was followed by examples of historical disaster case studies that involved Exxon Valdez, BP, Union Carbide and Maple Leaf Foods. An insightful analysis of the impact of disasters on the share price of companies that did recover and did not recover was

also presented.

One of the most important points of the presentation was that attempting to predict what to prepare for is futile as the list is too long and many disasters are "not on the list". Better simply just to prepare for the unexpected.


