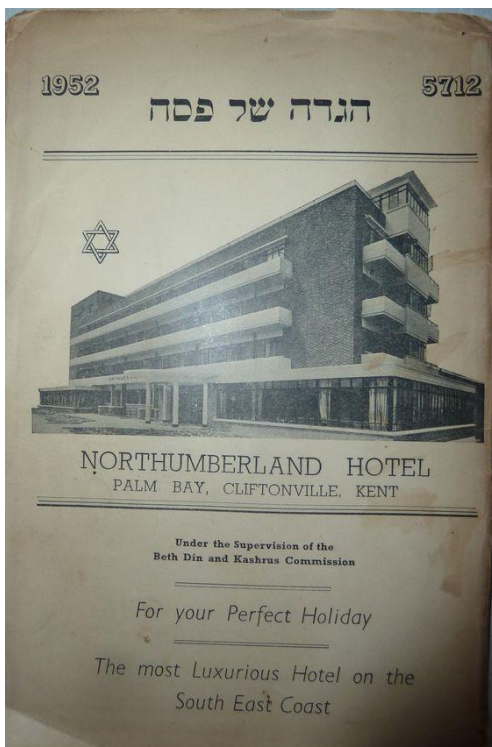

On the front cover it says in Hebrew "25 years in jail. Don't PASS OVER our brother Jonathan Pollard". He was finally freed in 2015. There is a lengthy introduction about Pollard. On each page, there is a small picture of him with the words in Hebrew "Don't PASS OVER our brother Jonathan Pollard". The entire Haggadah is in Hebrew with a Hebrew commentary. 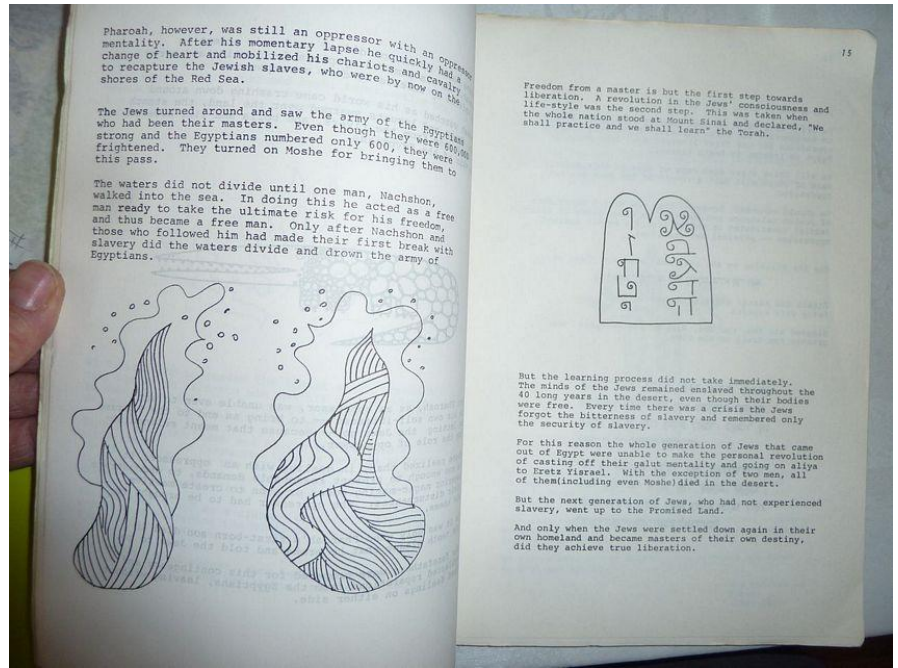

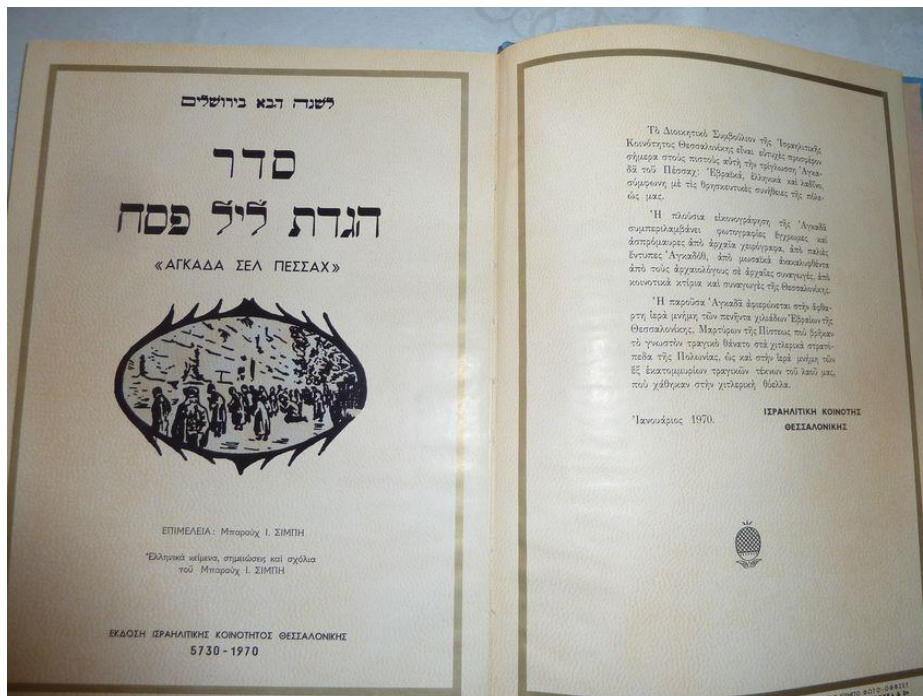

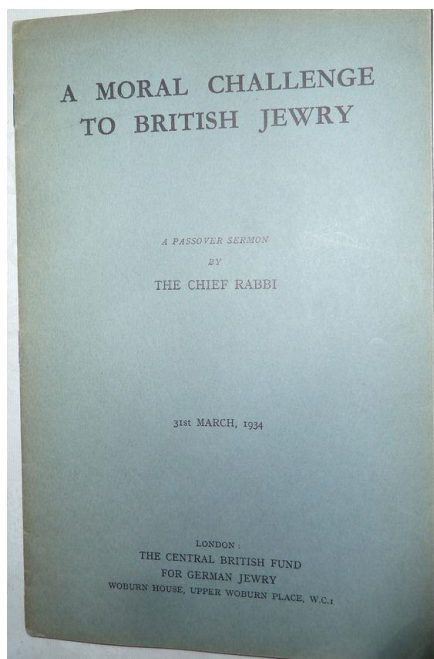

Kaczerginski was a Yiddish writer and cultural activist, known mostly for his involvement in the 'Paper Brigade', a group in the Vilnius Ghetto devoted to save the collections of YIVO - see David Fishman - The Book Smugglers. Kaczerginski was involved in communist groups for which he served a term in Polish prison before the war. His song 'Barikadn' ('Barricades'), which he wrote in his teen years became extremely popular. During the Soviet occupation of Vilnius he became disillusioned with communism. 'Between the Hammer and the Sickle' describes his experiences under the Soviet power. [ref: 11010]

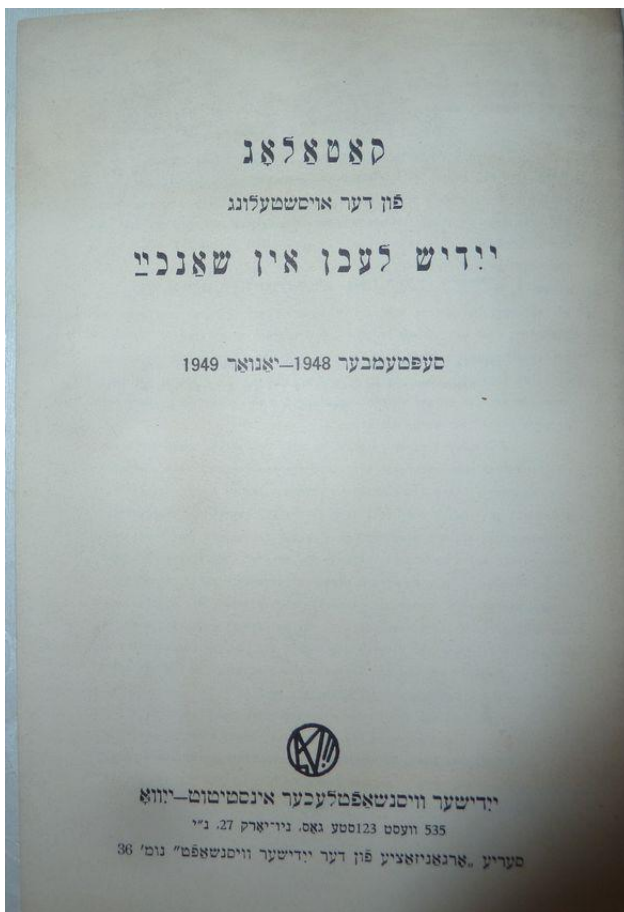
