## Rainbow Parrot Fish (Scarus guacamaia)

#### Instant ID

- Large, oval-shaped fish with a squared tail
- Teeth fused into a beak with two plates on each jaw
- Orange-brown head and bright green rear body
- Can grow up to four feet long


### **Native Niches**

- Inhabits coral reefs, mangroves and seagrass beds
- Prefers shallow waters at depths of 9-75 feet
- Found in reefs across the western Atlantic Ocean

# Rainbow Parrot Fish (Scarus guacamaia)

## **Favorite Foods**

- Primarily feeds on algae at the bottom of the ocean
- Uses beak to scrape plants and algae off corals

## **Critter Characteristics**

- Can live up to seven years
- Largest plant-eating fish in the Atlantic Ocean
- Requires both mangroves and coral reefs to complete its life cycle
- Waste can form white clouds in the water
