

## PALE-FLOWERED POLYSTACHYA

*Polystachya concreta* (Jacq.) Garay & Sweet

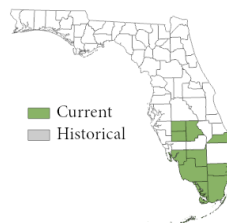
**Synonyms:** none

**Family:** Orchidaceae (orchid)

**FNAI Ranks:** G3G5/S3

**Legal Status:** US-none FL-Endangered

**Wetland Status:** US-none+ FL-UPL

**Field Description:** Epiphytic orchid, cespitose with thickened stem bases. Flowers are produced on simple racemes or in racemose panicles. The non-resupinate flowers are yellow to pale green with a white lip.

**Similar Species:** This orchid is distinguished by its epiphytic growth, yellowish flowers, and lack of pseudobulbs.

**Related Rare Species:** None.

**Habitat:** Cypress swamps, hammocks, and mangroves; epiphytic.

**Best Survey Season:** Fall-winter; August to December.

**Range-wide Distribution:** Pantropical. In Florida, restricted to the southern peninsula north to Hardee and Polk counties.

**Conservation Status:** Listed state-endangered, this species is vouchered for 10 counties in south Florida.

**Protection and Management:** Protect from poaching.
