Plant facts

- Size 2-3m
- Uses Butterfly attracting.
Perfect for small gardens
- Position Full sun, semi shade
in a moist location
- Care Tip prune when young
to encourage dense growth. Don't spray
with pesticides as it will kill the caterpillars.

Little Evodia

The Little Evodia is a sought-after shrub producing a spectacular display of pink flowers covering the trunk and branches. The glossy green foliage is aromatic, releasing a pleasant citrus scent when crushed. Large green fruits appear after flowering, these too are aromatic. This pretty shrub is a food plant, attracting the caterpillar of the Ulysses Butterfly and small birds, including honeyeaters. The Little Evodia is closely related to the Corkwood (Melicope elleryana).
