In 2011, Dominique Michel invited artists and friends to get involved in the *J'appuie Dodo* campaign in support of the future Integrated Cancer Centre at the Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont, where she was successfully treated for cancer. The objective: To raise \$12M. Six years later, she proudly declared, "Mission accomplished!"

Publicity campaign, media interviews, sale of promotional items, her presence at benefit events, personal requests... True to her nature, Dodo gave 120% to help those suffering from cancer. By these actions, she enabled the HMR Foundation and its hospital to shine on every stage.

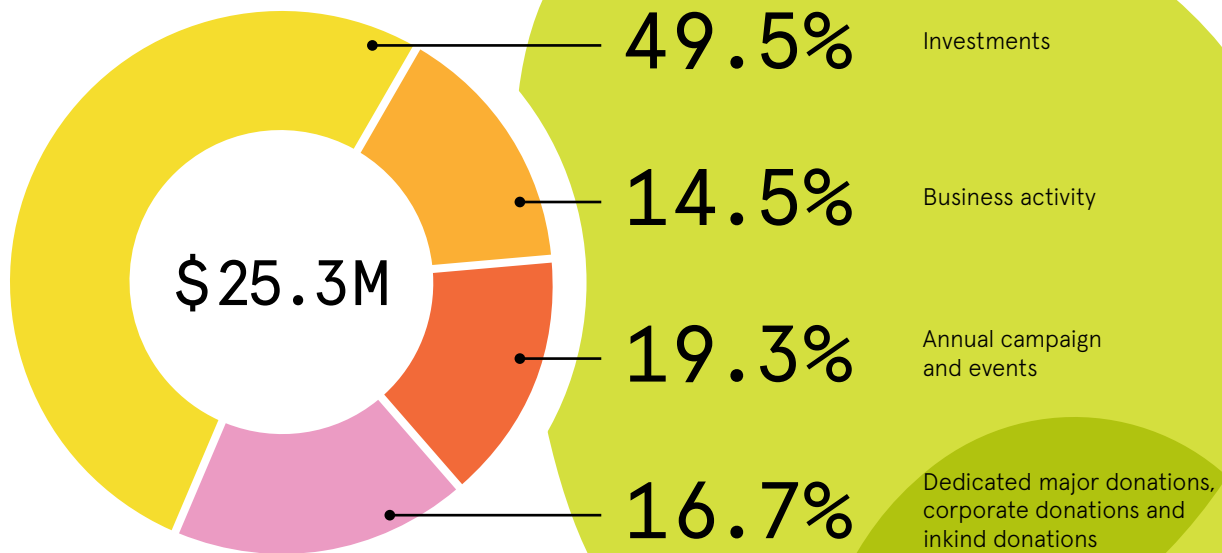

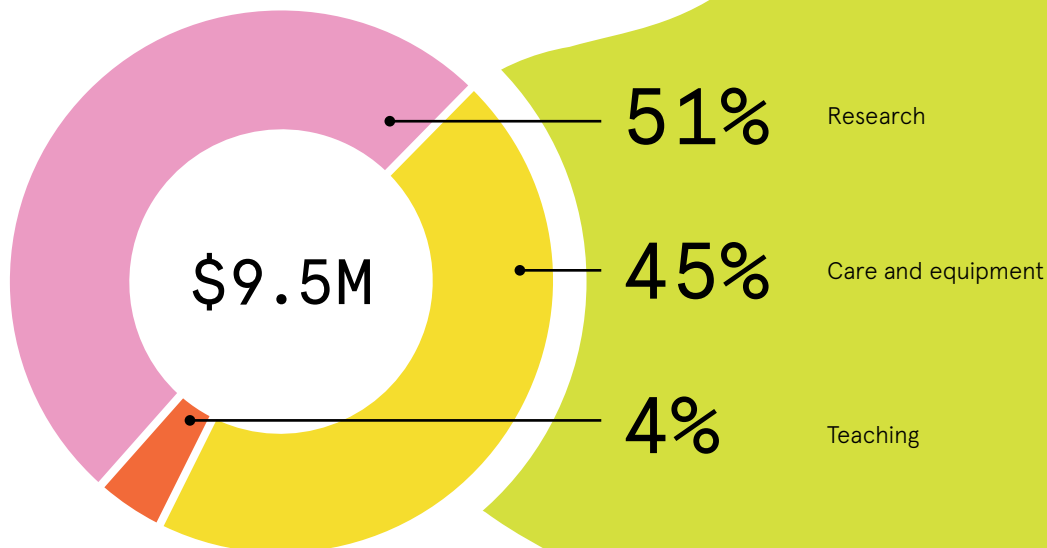
# Financial Statements

## Thanks to the Foundation, the Oncology Outpatient Clinic Has New Treatment Chairs



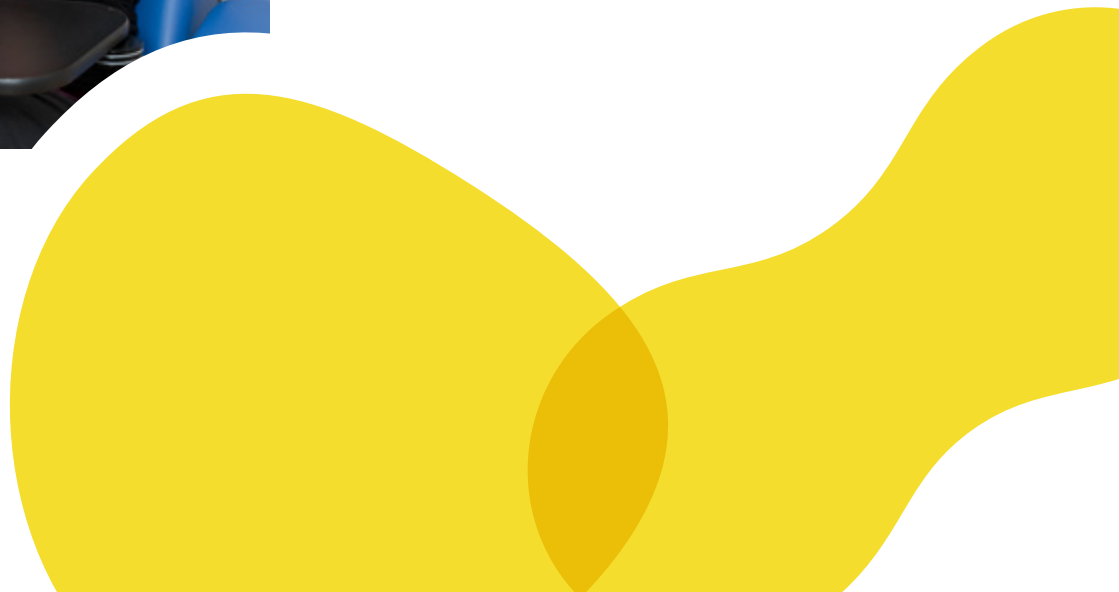
Every day, the HMR Oncology Outpatient Clinic welcomes some one hundred patients for treatments relating to their condition, including chemotherapy that sometimes lasts up to eight hours. In order to improve patient comfort, the HMR Foundation (FHMR) launched an appeal for donations to buy new treatment chairs.

Hundreds of donors spontaneously responded to this campaign. The FHMR also benefited from the immense generosity of the Fondation D'Amours, which donated an outstanding \$200,000. In total, the HMR Foundation was able to buy 45 treatment chairs. These chairs greatly improve the comfort of patients undergoing treatment over long periods.



In fact, it is this very concrete experience that inspired the Fondation D'Amours: The mother of the D'Amours family was treated for cancer at the HMR for six long years. Her daughter Julie explains: "The extraordinary oncology team cared for her, never gave up, supported her and was at her side the whole time. For our mother, the medical team played a very important role throughout her stay." The D'Amours family became painfully aware of how urgently these chairs were needed.

# \$29,444

### Taking special care of our youngest patients

The Neonatal and Pediatrics departments acquired an array of equipment that will help provide the best possible care to the little patients at the HMR and to their family. Whether it is for early detection of newborn hyperbilirubinemia, commonly referred to as jaundice, and heart disease, to enhance treatment accuracy for preemies or to foster the well-being and development of young patients during their hospital stay, the HMR is better and better equipped for this type of patient. Funding from the Foundation has enabled the acquisition of cutting-edge equipment required for resuscitation of babies, of machines that facilitate better monitoring of pregnant women, of comfort items for babies and their mother and of distracting or stimulating toys that help consultations run more smoothly.

# \$4,390

### Purchase of a phototherapy lamp for the treatment of neonatal hyperbilirubinemia

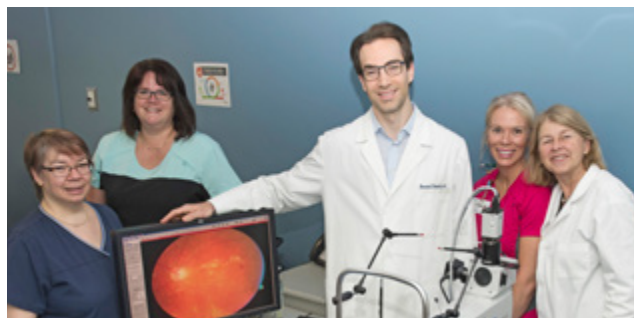
It has been demonstrated that the blue light emitted by the NeoBlue lamp is vastly superior to traditional lighting to treat hyperbilirubinemia in babies. This acquisition will help reduce the length of their hospital stay and avoid the complications linked to this condition. Not only is this tool essential to provide quality care to newborns, it is also the result of the inspiring story of 17-year-old Anne-Sophie Roy. This teenager felt very strongly about carrying out a meaningful project so she raised nearly the entire amount required to buy the equipment.

### Technology in the service of our patients: Telescreening for macular degeneration

The number of requests to retinologists is constantly on the rise as is their workload. For patients suffering from macular degeneration, the implementation of software capable of remote diagnostics is a real breakthrough. It now enables nurses to quickly identify cases requiring emergency



consultation while helping to reduce wait times and improve patient follow-up. This evolution only confirms the HMR's status as a leader in the field of ophthalmology, as this practice is unique in Canada.

### The CROIRE Fund: Renewal for the body, mind and soul of cancer patients

The CROIRE Fund offers activities that act as a complement to the traditional medical treatment provided to those affected by cancer. The CROIRE Fund's mission is to help men and women who are emotionally as well as physically depleted experience their new reality in a better way. In 2017, more than 800 people benefited from a whole range of free activities, workshops and conferences focusing on well-being, self-confidence and fulfilment.



#### Smiling at life

Don't they say laughter is the best medicine? Participants at the CROIRE Fund laughter yoga workshops are testing this theory. Massage sessions are also offered to patients during their treatment. These are moments of well-being and sheer happiness to awaken their zest for life and reduce the effects of anxiety.



#### Being true to oneself and to those around us

Whether the topic is nutrition, relationships or sexuality, the CROIRE Fund offers a multitude of conferences on themes that affect the everyday life of people suffering from cancer and of those around them. With support from professionals in the field, they are able to manage their new reality with greater serenity.



#### The art of healing or healing through art

At the CROIRE Fund, participants are full partners of their healing process and they are invited to let all of their emotions out during creative workshops. Available to discover: The mandala, a form of colouring that promotes relaxation, singing with the CROIRE choir that performs several times a year and integral Tai Chi, a mix of martial arts and meditation. The only condition to participate in these activities? You must agree to jump in with both feet!

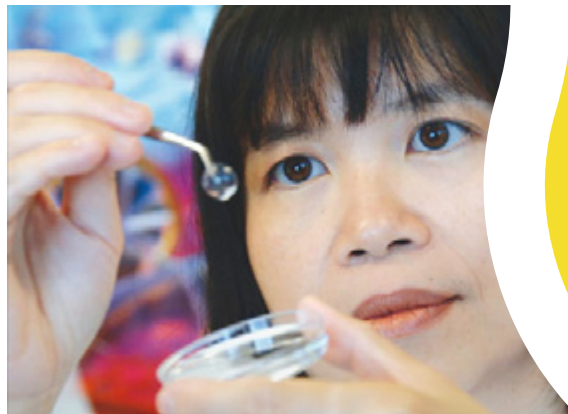

# \$5,000,000

### Creation of the Caroline Durand Chair in Cellular Therapy for Eye Diseases

The product of a fruitful collaboration between the HMR Foundation, the Université de Montréal Faculty of Medicine, the Caroline Durand Foundation and the Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont, the Caroline Durand Chair in Cellular Therapy for Eye Diseases was launched on September 12, 2017. In total, the value of the chair is \$5M and \$4.25M of the capital has been donated by the Caroline Durand Foundation with another \$750,000 provided by the HMR Foundation.

The HMR is the only hospital in Canada to possess the expertise and the infrastructure to explore the possibilities offered by the prodigious cellular therapy and stem cells to “repair” eyes.



The directors of the Caroline Durand Foundation felt especially compelled by the numerous clinical applications offered by cellular therapy for a large number of ocular diseases.

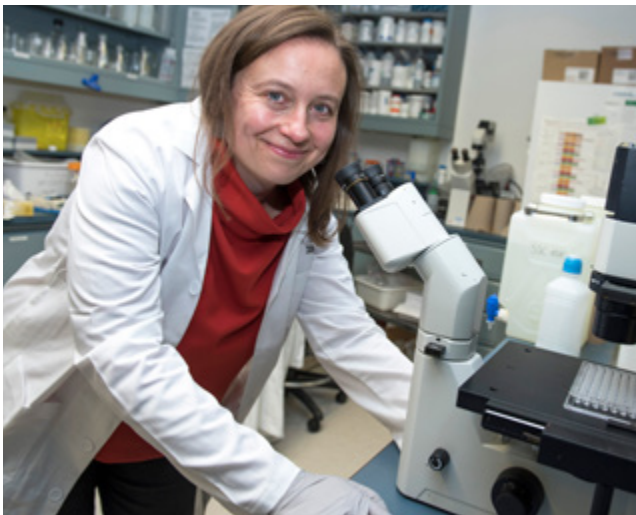
The holder of the chair, Doctor May Griffith, has unparalleled expertise in cellular therapy and is recognized worldwide for her fundamental research in ophthalmology. She has put forward a unique and extremely promising technique as part of her clinical applications, making these innovative treatments available to a greater number of patients. The work done by her team of investigators focuses on the discovery of the innumerable regenerative properties of stem cells produced by bone marrow and their ability to impact healing of eye diseases, namely diseases of the retina, glaucoma and other inflammatory diseases.

## IMMUNOLOGY

### \$100,000

#### Diabetes: Promising discoveries

Imagine that your daily survival depends on measuring your blood sugar levels by pricking the tip of your finger three to ten times a day (and sometimes during the night) in addition to injecting yourself with insulin. Now imagine that you don't have to worry about that anymore... This is the glimmer of hope foreseen by Dr. Sylvie Lesage's team of researchers as they study an innovative therapeutic approach to treat type 1 diabetes. The goal of the study is to harness a type of cells that would help prevent the disease. By restoring these cells, which are associated with susceptibility for diabetes when present in a too small number, it would be possible to develop preventive cellular therapies. Thanks to a generous donation from the Liana's Dream Foundation and to the proximity of the Centre of Excellence for Cellular Therapy (CECT), established at the HMR in 2013, Dr. Lesage's work could lead to clinical trials by the year 2020.

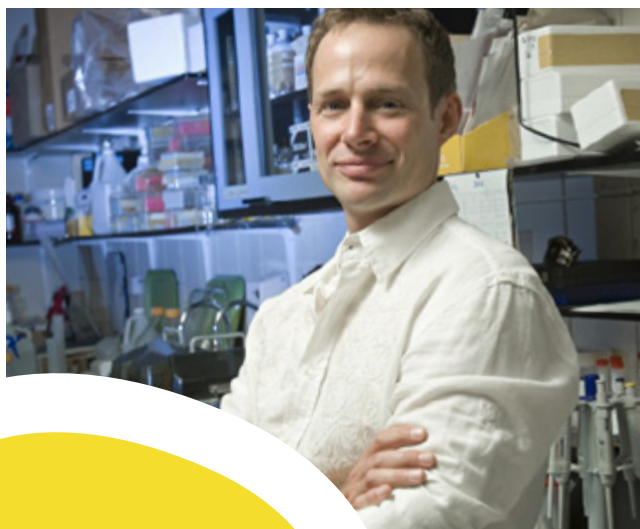


## IMMUNOLOGY-ONCOLOGY

### \$50,000

#### Leukemia: Innovative treatments thanks to cellular immunotherapy

Although it is encouraging to see that we are beating more and more blood cancers thanks to traditional chemotherapy and radiation therapy treatments, leukemias and lymphomas are still responsible for far too many deaths in children and young adults. For those cases that are resistant to the usual treatments, cellular immunotherapy is a promising solution that has already been successful at the HMR. Thanks to the support of the Cole Foundation, which granted \$50,000 for research in the field, Dr. Heather Melichar and her team are working on increasing the efficacy and sustainability of these avant-garde treatments. Their goal is to improve the treatment options available to patients as of today. The potential of this research is even greater as it will not only impact blood cancer treatments but other cancers as well, namely those affecting the lungs and kidneys.



## OPHTHALMOLOGY

# \$20,000

### Eye diseases: Unprecedented advances

Age-related macular degeneration (AMD) affects the central part of the retina, which is essential to our vision. Although this disease is the primary cause of vision loss in people over 50, Dr. Gilbert Bernier's research is paving the way for new therapeutic solutions to restore eyesight. His work has led to the creation of an innovative technology that helps generate photoreceptors from human stem cells. This is an exceptional breakthrough as it will help counter the phenomenon responsible for AMD: Irreversible destruction of cells that play a crucial role in the retina. Thanks to these discoveries, patients suffering from incurable degenerative diseases such as AMD, or Stargardt disease and pigmentary retinopathy, now have renewed hope of a cure.



## RESEARCH CENTRE

# \$906,490

### Medical breakthroughs within reach of our researchers thanks to ongoing support

The HMR Foundation supports the HMR Research Centre to foster daily medical breakthroughs at the Centre, whose work is renowned throughout Québec and around the world. In 2017, the financial assistance provided by the Foundation enabled the Research Centre to recruit high-level researchers as well as awarding substantial research grants, buying state-of-the-art equipment and updating laboratories and technical platforms. In addition, our support of the CellCAN network helps maintain the HMR's status as a world leader in cellular therapy, while enabling researchers to translate scientific breakthroughs into new and innovative therapies that are available to patients.

### \$39,666

#### Hematology Personnel Development Fund: Fostering excellence

Believing in its importance and faced with the need for exceptional leadership in the field, in 2011, the HMR created an endowment fund to finance the professional development of hematology personnel. Once again this year, the Fund helped support excellence in the areas of clinical and laboratory hematology through educational activities and grants awarded to residents who wish to pursue complementary specialization. In 2017, the fourth Symposium on Hematology organized by the HMR gathered over 160 medical technologists from all over the province while the lunch and learn sessions welcomed over 200 hematology laboratory professionals. Furthermore, the Fund also contributed to an immunotherapy fellowship for Dr. Caroline Letendre, who will be joining the HMR medical team in the summer of 2018.



## GENERAL ORTHOPEDICS

### \$15,000

#### Professional development for the treatment of musculoskeletal pathologies: Well-renowned expertise at the HMR

People with hemophilia who suffer from bleeding disorders affecting the joints have a greatly reduced quality of life. Because the disease is so rare and the treatment so complex, patients must be cared for by a multidisciplinary team of specialists composed of orthopedic surgeons, hematologists, nurses and physiotherapists. To date, the HMR is the only adult centre in Québec with a team specialized in the treatment of people with hemophilia. Thanks to support from the Foundation, the multidisciplinary team continues to fulfil its mission of training, research and excellence in care to improve the quality of life of patients suffering from coagulation disorders.

## GRANTS AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

### \$315,606

Every year, the Foundation contributes to training and ongoing professional development of HMR health care staff. In 2017, more than 400 professionals from various departments attended professional development programs and the Foundation awarded 20 grants, ranging from \$500 to \$38,000.

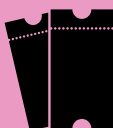

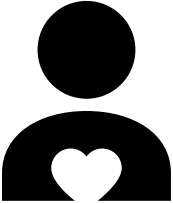
